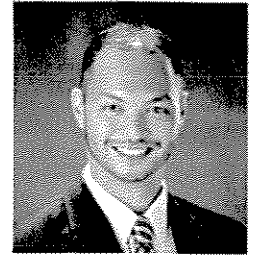

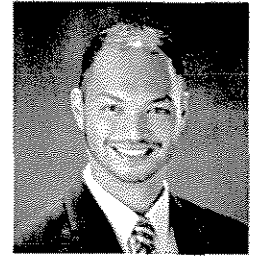

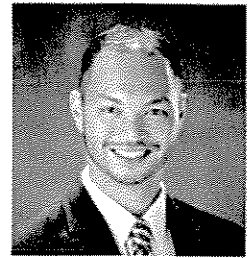

COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

The nomination of Frank L.G. Lujan, Jr., as the Chief Technology Officer of the Office of Technology, to serve at the pleasure of *I Maga'låhi*, was made by Governor Edward J.B. Calvo on August 13, 2015. The nomination package was received by the Office of Speaker Judith T. Won Pat, Ed.D., on September 8, 2015, and was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development on September 9, 2015.

The Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development held a public hearing on October 1, 2015, in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room on the nomination of Frank L.G. Lujan, Jr., to serve as the Chief Technology Officer of the Office of Technology. The hearing convened at 2:01 p.m. and was adjourned at 2:40 p.m.

II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Chairman Michael San Nicolas convened the hearing on the nomination of Mr. Frank Lujan. Before hearing from the nominee, he called the first panel to provide testimony.

Mr. Dan Tydingco spoke in favor of the nomination. He mentioned that he has known Mr. Lujan for many years. He stated that the position is very important for the operations of the government and that the nominee possesses the necessary skills for the job. Mr. Tydingco stated that the nominee has invaluable public and private sector experience, and also has the temperament to handle the responsibilities of the position. He urged the Legislature to confirm Mr. Lujan.

Mr. Ken Platt explained his role in the information technology capabilities of the government. He spoke in favor of the nomination stating that it is critical to have Mr. Lujan in the position. He said that he believes that the nominee is organized and able to effectively prioritize the responsibilities of the office.

Mr. Joe Quinata spoke in favor of the nomination. He stated that Mr. Lujan has the knowledge needed for the Office of Technology and has a vision to use technology as a means to improve government efficiency and service.

Mr. Frank Tenorio read from a prepared statement (*please see attachment*) in support of the nomination. He spoke about Mr. Lujan's educational experience in computer science and how his knowledge would benefit the government. He further highlighted the nominee's participation in community organizations especially his involvement with the Catholic Church.

Chairman San Nicolas called Mr. Lujan to provide a statement on his nomination.

Mr. Frank Lujan thanked the Committee for allowing him to come before them and explain his capabilities to do the job. He said that he has a vision to leverage technology in order to benefit the government and people of Guam. If allowed to serve as Chief Technology Officer, he hopes to provide the leadership to move the technological capabilities of the government forward.

Chairman San Nicolas explained that he met previously with Mr. Lujan and they discussed his business interests as indicated in his official nomination packet. He assured the Committee that Mr. Lujan agreed to divest the interests in pursuit of the position he is seeking. Chairman San Nicolas stated that it is a testament to his commitment to the position and dedication to the people of Guam. He further mentioned that the nominee possesses impressive knowledge and expertise, and has built strong and extensive professional history in the area of technology. Chairman San Nicolas proceeded to read Mr. Lujan's educational and work history noting that he has dedicated his entire professional life to the area of technology. He stated his support for the nomination.

Senator Mary Torres commended the nominee for his qualifications and past work involvement with the government. She asked that if he is confirmed, if he would be able to assist

with making government procurement and other operations more efficient possibly pushing to invest more funding and resources.

Mr. Lujan stated that government procurement faces many obstacles. He stated that there has been considerable technological investment made with regards to the government's current procurement process but that much of the improvements should be made to the human resources side. The nominee stated that more participation is needed in planning and moving forward.

Senator Torres stated that she was reassured that Mr. Lujan is going into this position knowing where the operational strengths are in the government and committing to using those existing strengths to make improvements.

Mr. Lujan stated that the government's existing skillset, although dedicated and skilled, are also stressed because of a shortage of manpower. He stated that comparable areas, with similar technological needs to Guam, all have more employees and staff handling the duties.

Senator Torres asked about the technological literacy of the government of Guam workforce.

Mr. Lujan stated that most government employees understand the basic skills of technology.

Vice Speaker Benjamin Cruz asked if Mr. Lujan has already formulated a plan for the Office of Technology.

Mr. Lujan stated that he has not formulated any specific plans. He said that he is familiarizing himself with the staff and the policies and processes currently in place. He wants to work with the existing staff to formulate plans and goals for the office.

Senator Tommy Morrison spoke about the importance of the Office of Technology. He asked the nominee if he has an adequate amount of time before the Fiscal Year 2017 budget discussions begin to prepare and justify a budget for the Office of Technology.

Mr. Lujan stated that he has preliminary plans for the Office and that he will be properly prepared by the time of budget discussions.

Senator Tina Muna Barnes spoke favorably of Mr. Lujan's qualifications and expressed hope that his involvement in the community would continue even after his confirmation. She expressed support for his nomination.

Senator Nerissa Underwood commended the Mr. Lujan's credentials. She stated the importance of technology for the operations of the government and the need to ensure that the Office of Technology can keep up with all the different technological needs of the various government agencies.

Chairman San Nicolas outlined some technological needs that he feels need to be implemented within the government. He stated the need for a uniform electronic communications protocol so that official correspondence amongst government entities can be done electronically; a data

backup protocol so that electronically stored information remains safe and recoverable if lost; and a unified financial management system so that all entities can be uniform throughout the government of Guam. Chairman San Nicolas thanked the nominee for his willingness to work collaboratively in formulating a plan for the Office of Technology. Noting that there was no other business, he adjourned the hearing.

III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development hereby reports out the nomination of Frank L.G. Lujan, Jr. to serve as Chief Technology Officer, Office of Technology, serving at the pleasure of *I Maga'låhi*, with the recommendation TO CONFIRM.

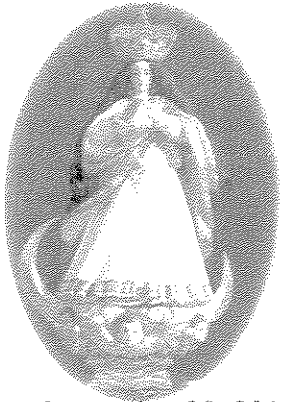

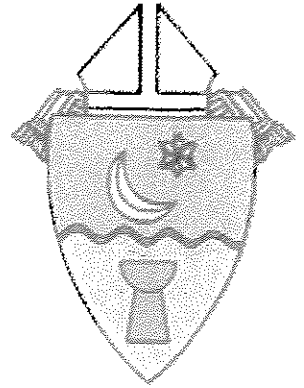
