## Committee Report Digest

### I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Higher Education, Culture, Public Library, and Women's Affairs convened a public hearing on Tuesday, February 2, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. On the agenda was the consideration on the Appointment of Gina Y. Ramos; Member, Guam Community College Board of Trustees.

#### Public Notice Requirements

All legal requirements for public notices were met, with requests for publication sent to all media and all Senators; 5 days notice was sent on January 26, 2016 and the 48 hours notice was sent on January 29, 2016 via email. Copies of the hearing notices are appended to the report.

### II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

#### **Speaker Won Pat Ed.D.**

Began by thanking Vice Chair of the Committee on Higher Education, Culture, Public Libraries, and Women's Affairs, Senator Nerissa Underwood; and fellow colleagues, Senator Brant

McCreadie; Senator Mary Torres for attending. Speaker Won Pat announced that the purpose of the hearing to hear two appointments – for Frank P. Arriola and Gina Y. Ramos to serve as members of the Guam Community College (GCC) Board of Regents Board of Trustees – and Bill 235-33 (LS), Relative to the operational start up costs for the Guam Museum; Bill 242-33 (COR), relative to interim admission, events, and membership fees for the Guam Museum; and Bill 245-33, relative to authorizing the Guam Public Library System to lease the portion of the building referred to as the “Internet Café” for the purpose of operating and managing a high quality and reasonably priced café.

After confirming that all notices of public hearing were sent out and after announcing that all testimonies may be sent via electronic mail or hand-delivered to her office, or hand delivered to Reproduction at the address of the Guam Legislature Building, Speaker began the hearing

**Mr. Eloy Hara**

Who read testimony for Ramos earlier at the Hearing, reiterated, again, that during the short time he’s served on the Board, Ramos has accomplished a lot during her terms of service, and that the love that she has for her work shows in her performance. Hara extended his full support.

**Deborah Bollinger**

Added that Ms. Ramos brings knowledge to the Board and many accomplishments, and she ended by expressing that she looks forward to working with her.

**Dr. Mary Okada**

Expressed her full support for Ms. Ramos as a member of the GCC Board of Trustees. Refer further to submitted written testimony for the reappointment of Ms. Gina Ramos.

**Mr. Frank Arriola**

Expressed his support for Mr. Ramos’ reappointment. He testified that Ms. Ramos has been a mentor to other members of the Board and is a huge asset to the Board as well.

**Ms. Gina Ramos**

Thanked the Senators on the panel, stating that serving on the board has been a privilege and a pleasure. Refer further to submitted written testimony for the reappointment of Ms. Gina Ramos.

**Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D.** Thanked Ramos and posed the same question that she did to Arriola; the question of why another third term.

**Ms. Gina Ramos**

Stated that she believes that everyone in the community should have access to an education – and that is the reason why she continues to want to serve on the Board of Trustees.

**Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D.**

Asked Dr. Okada of the attendance of both Arriola and Ramos.

**Dr. Okada**

Responded that both Arriola and Ramos attend the meetings, as well as numerous trainings and activities in addition to that. She explained further than the trustees are constantly informed of what GCC is doing in the community, as they must. Okada stated that the trustees participate in any way they can and are able.

**Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D.** Inquired of the concept of implementing free tuition at the community colleges.

**Ms. Gina Ramos**

Responded that while no policy initiatives have been put forward, the Board has discussed it and would support it as long as a funding mechanism was in place.

**Mr. Frank Arriola**

Reiterated the Board's support and added that the only challenge in implementing free tuition was funding. While the current program would provide 50% federal funding, the remaining 50% would be provided locally, putting an additional burden on the general fund. Furthermore, Arriola stated, Guam being an insular area versus a state would delay what is being implemented nationally. However, he stated that the Board has been ready to handle free tuition and is in support.

**Senator Tony Ada**

Extended his strong support for the appointees.

**Speaker Won Pat Ed.D** is in full support of the confirmation hearing and concluded the public hearing at 10:23 a.m. and also mentioned if there are additional letters of support to email it to [fbtorres@judiwonpat.com](mailto:fbtorres@judiwonpat.com). 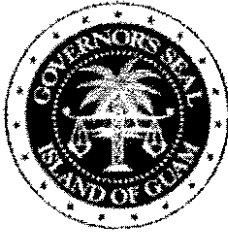




