COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Transportation, Infrastructure, Lands, Border Protection, Veterans' Affairs and Procurement convened a public hearing on September 29, 2016 at 1:00 p.m. in *I Liheslaturan Guahan's* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of the appointment of Mr. Hardy Tan I. Vy to serve as a member of the Guam Land Use Commission, whose appointment history is as follows:

- Appointed by *Governor* Eddie Baza Calvo on June 28, 2016
- Appointment packet forwarded to *I Liheslaturan Guahan* on June 28, 2016
- Appointment packet forwarded to this committee for public consideration on June 29, 2016

Public Notice Requirements

Public Hearing notices were disseminated via email to all Senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on September 21, 2016 and again on September 26, 2016. Publication was conducted in the ***Guam Daily Post***, a newspaper of general circulation, fulfilling the 5-Day Notice and 48 Hour Notice of the Open Government Law requirements respectively.

The confirmation hearing for Mr. Hardy Tan I. Vy commenced at 1:00 p.m.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

Chairperson Ada calls those who have signed up to give oral testimony.

Michael Borja, *Executive Secretary, Guam Land Use Commission*: Stated that he is in support of Mr. Hardy Tan I. Vy to sit on the Guam Land Use Commission. He went on to explain that Mr. Vy comes with great experiences and wanting to make Guam a better place. While the appointee is young, he has the experience in both retail, wholesale and connections to the construction industry as a supplier. Hardy is born and raised on Guam, and he and his family are active community members. He ends by asking the body to look favorable on the nomination.

John Arroyo, *Chairman, Guam Land Use Commission*: Started by saying he is in support of the nomination of Mr. Hardy Tan I. Vy. He stated he has only met Mr. Vy a few times and is impressed. He thinks he will be a positive influence on the commission. And as Mr. Borja has pointed out he is young and still has some learning to do, as far as the land use is concerned. He is dedicated, willing to learn and wants to do what is best for the island. Mr. Arroyo further explains that given his age and background, he will bring a fresh perspective that will be embraced. Which will provide a different point of view, especially when looking at issues that

are now current and modern, most especially the sign variances and new methods of marketing and promoting. His input will complement those on the commission and will work cohesively and continue the great working relationship. He ended by stating he endorses the nominee.

Chairperson Ada calls upon the nominee.

Hardy Tan I. Vy, *Appointee*: Started by stating his name, his birth place and that he is a product of Guam's school system and the University of Guam, and is now a functioning member of society. He is partially of Chamorro descent but his heart wholly identifies with Pacific Islanders. After he lived in Japan and China, his soul was convinced that Guam was home. So long as the island can maintain its blessed allure he will live out the rest of his years here and die here, god willing. God willing that will not be until after he instills the ideology of respecting our islands natural environment and doing one's part in preserving or enhancing the beauty of our island home and ensuring that Guam's economy and sustainability is the priority of my children and my children's children after.

He decided long ago that he will teach the islands future to symbiotically live and work with each other, only then can they move forward. That is the future intent for him but before that point, he must do his part to see the island develop responsibly and sustainably towards community standards. While ensuring that this progress doesn't violate the principles he holds dearly.

He stands before the committee humbly accepting the nomination from the Governor, which allows him the opportunity to do just that. This passion is deeply rooted in him after growing up on Guam. From a youngster to his teenage years that was not much drastic change within a 15-year span. Then somehow between 2008 to 2012, he returned to realize that there was many change in those 4 years he was gone, then the 15 years of growing up. That change was fascinating and the history of Guam is headed for some great changes.

He admitted he is stepping out of his comfort zone and diving head first into something he is not entirely familiar with however he is eager to learn and gain firsthand experience of the planning process in regards to how precious land on Guam is used and fulfill a civic duty to contribute on the development of our island home. He is aware of the development and progress is not for everyone who is content with the way of life that they have. He is also aware that people are slightly daunted when they hear "development in progress" starting to materialize in municipalities they have lived in for so long. But he feels that as long as collective decisions result in an improved quality of live for a large part of the citizens that will be directly affected by these changes. There will eventually be faith in the decisions integrity. He will strive to look for solutions that benefit the greater good along with thorough research, civil discussion and compliance with the laws in place. He ends by saying he believes it is important that citizens and government work together to reach the common goal to improve the quality of life and watch the island prosper for the future generation to come.

Chairperson Ada: Stated that he has read through the appointment packets. He stated that he has met with Mr. Vy and despite his age he brings a lot to the table. And appreciates the

appointees' acceptance of the Governors nominations. He went on to say that the appointee would be a contributor to the commission.

Senator Muña Barnes: Asked the appointee where he sees the island in the next decade as it relates to development and preservation of land?

Mr. Vy: Responded that it would depend on the geo-political system around Asia. Those issues would affect the island as far as infrastructure and depending on if the buildup will come with the pressures from Asia. He stated he is unsure of where the island will be but hopes for the future our agriculture will be developed so the island can be more sustainable.

Senator Muña Barnes: Stated she looked at the people in the audience and see friends and family accompanying him here. She went on to say for her, the balance needs to be brought together, to be able to talk to the people and even as oversight chair of the mayors, they need to be included. They are the 24/7 responders of what happens in the village. Most importantly making sure that the infrastructure is in place to sustain the island. She ended by stating the appointee has her vote.

Chairperson Ada: Stated that there is a lot of movement in the community about land use and development in the various municipalities. There have been two ideas that have come forth, one is the broad control of what development goes on in the municipality goes to the municipal planning council and the mayor's office. It's for them to decide whether the development will occur in that village or not, which would do away with the Guam Land Use Commission. The other approach put forward is a compromise to the other very extreme idea. The compromise idea is to stand up a hybrid land use commission, which will then have on it 4 elected mayors to decide the fate of a project giving more input to the municipality. He then asked for the appointees thought on the different approaches?

Mr. Vy: Responded that they would have to comply with whichever bill is passed. He understanding is that it is a bill that is being discussed now.

Chairperson Ada: Stated that the ideas are 2 bills that have been introduced, one provides a compromise and keeps the Governor's appointed commissioners. But at certain times that commission will get expanded by 4 elected members, for certain land use applications.

Mr. Vy: Stated he is comfortable with what the Legislature decides. At the end of the day if the MPC doesn't get pushed through, they are still the voice and are powerful to consider.

Chairperson Ada: Thanked and showed appreciation to the appointee for taking the time to prepare.

Chairperson Ada then adjourned the confirmation hearing for **Mr. Hardy Tan I. Vy.**

1. Buenas Dias Chairman Ada. I am Adrian Gogue, resident of
Ordot-Chalan Pago, and a member of Save Southern Guam,
(SSG) Inc.

2. I have reviewed the nomination packages for Dr. dela
Pena and Mr. Vy and attended the public hearing for their
nominations at the Guam Legislature on 29 September 2016.
Ergo, SSG, Inc. provides the following for your
consideration:

- a) SSG, Inc. concurs with Dr. dela Pena's nomination and
confirmation to the Guam Land Use Commission. Dr.
dela Pena's professional experience as an architect,
natural resource manager, community base planner,
environmental impact assessment manager, and work in
preservation and conservation will serve to benefit
the people of Guam as a Guam Land Use Commissioner.
- b) SSG, Inc. does not concur with Mr. Vy's nomination
and recommends rejecting his nomination and
confirmation to the Guam Land Use Commission based on
the following:
 - 1) Mr. Vy did not provide any experience or expertise
in his nomination package other than as Marketing
Manager, Benson Guam Ent.

During Bill 318-33's public hearing in June 2016,
the Director of Land Management, Chairman of the
Guam Land Use Commission, and Commissioners of the
Guam Land Use Commission all testified against Bill
318-33, which will give the village Municipal
Planning Councils (MPCs) authority to approve
projects in their municipality, because the MPC
lacks the experience and technical expertise in land
use planning. The Director of Land Management
stated, "The bill is flawed and empowers a group of

people to make important decisions completely out of their subject matter expertise.”

- 2) Guam is at a critical point to develop the Southern Development Master Plan. Mr. Vy lacks the experience and technical expertise to serve as a commissioner on the Guam Land Use Commission and discuss and make decisions per 18 GAR-LAND MANAGEMENT, §3119.

“Order of Business. At the regular meetings of the Commission, the following shall be the order of business:

“...(3) Consideration of zoning applications for changes or variances as outlined in the Zoning Law;

(4) Consideration of subdivision matters as outlined in the Subdivision Law;

(5) Consideration of master plan features requiring detailed discussion;”

- 3) The Director of Land Management, Chairman of the Guam Land Use Commission, and Commissioners of the Guam Land Use Commission further stated in June 2016, “The Commissioners are nominated by the Governor and vetted and confirmed by the Legislature.”

Based on the criteria and testimonials the Director, Chairman, and Commissioners boldly stated, Mr. Vy’s nomination package should be rejected and his confirmation should not be reported out of committee for a vote on the Legislature floor.
