





#### **Committee Report Digest**

#### I. <u>OVERVIEW</u>

The Committee on Higher Education, Culture, Public Library, and Women's Affairs convened a public hearing on Tuesday, November 24, 2015 at 3:00 p.m. in *I Liheslatura*'s Public Hearing Room. On the agenda was the consideration on the appointment of Dr. Hyo Sang Ji; Member, University of Guam Board of Regents

All legal requirements for public notices were met, with requests for publication sent to all media and all Senators; 5 day notice was sent on November 17, 2015 and the 48 hour notice was sent on November 22, 2015 via email. Copies of the hearing notices are appended to the report.

#### II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

**Speaker Won Pat Ed.D.** announced that testimonies will be heard concerning the appointment of Dr. Hyo Sang Ji as member, University of Guam Board of Regents. Speaker Won Pat Ed.D. mentioned that proper and adequate notices were given: a 5 day notice was sent on November 17, 2015 and a 48 hour notice was sent on November 22, 2015.

**President Underwood** is in full support of the nomination of Dr. Hyo Sang Ji; his written testimony is appended to the committee report.

**Speaker Won Pat Ed.D.** acknowledged the presence of Senator N.B. Underwood, Vice Chairperson of the Committee.

**Speaker Won Pat Ed.D.** called up Mr. Daniel O'Connor, Mrs. Stella Ji, Ms. Waibel, Mr. Chris Felix and mentioned to all who came up to testify to state their name, organization and if they support of the nominee.

Mr. Daniel O'Connor mentioned that he is a pilot for United Airlines and that he grew up on Guam. Mr. O'Connor mentioned that one of his oldest friends is Dr. Hyo Sang Ji or "PJ." Mr. O' Connor and Dr. Hyo Sang Ji attended Bishop Baumgartner Memorial Catholic School in the 7<sup>th</sup> grade, were classmates in high school, and attended college at University of California, Berkeley. Mr. O'Connor mentioned that Dr. Hyo Sang Ji is a close friend, and he feels like he will be a wonderful asset to the University of Guam Board of Regents. Mr. O'Connor mentioned that Dr. Hyo Sang Ji discussed ideas, but like people with ideas or most ideas you would have to find funding and then make policies and to find the people behind it. Mr. O'Connor mentioned that there are a lot of great people working with the regents and he stands together in endorsing Dr. Hyo Sang Ji to be a regent.

Mrs. Stella Ji greeted with a "good afternoon," and mentioned that she is not in any organization. Mrs. Ji is the wife of Dr. Ji, and she is here to support and hopes Dr. Hyo Sang Ji will bring something new to the table at UOG. Mrs. Ji mentioned that Dr. Hyo Sang Ji is a big proponent of higher education. She wished that Dr. Hyo Sang Ji will bring his vision and ideas. She also mentioned that they met in the Philippines while Dr. Hyo Sang Ji was in the Peace Corps and have 4 kids together. Mrs. Ji is in full support and mentioned that Dr. Hyo Sang Ji is a good person who wants to serve the community.

Ms. Melissa Waibel thanked Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D. and Senator N.B. Underwood for the opportunity to speak on behalf of Dr. Ji. She has known Dr. Hyo Sang Ji since 2011 as his employer and coworker. Ms. Melissa Waibel mentioned that Dr. Hyo Sang Ji is highly passionate about serving and supporting this community. Ms. Melissa Waibel mentioned that Dr. Hyo Sang Ji first contacted her while she was still in the mainland; to figure out how to get back to Guam and be of use to showcase his talents in the population where he believes is his home. Ms. Melissa Waibel mentioned that Dr. Hyo Sang Ji is constantly trying to find ways to volunteer his time and services and talents to others by teaching life support for free. Ms. Melissa trained himself in (PALS) mentioned that Dr. Hyo Sang Ji also Pediatric Advanced Life Support, to employees and to others as well. Ms. Melissa Waibel stated that Dr. Hyo Sang Ji also went into the public school system to: support school teachers, get students in medicine, and encourage students to pursue education so that they may attend a university here or elsewhere. Ms. Melissa Waibel stated that knowing full well, the more education you have, that is something no one can take from you; the more knowledge you have

the more you can provide to others. Ms. Melissa Waibel also mentioned that you have to put yourself out there, and Dr. Ji has done that with the board of regents, he is really anxious for this even before now. Ms. Melissa Waibel stated that Dr. Ji will bring a lot of energy, being a big proponent in finding new ideas to better benefit those who are on island. Ms. Melissa Waibel is in full support and mentioned that Dr. Ji has the willingness to serve others and is not in it for financial gain in any way shape of form. Lastly, Ms. Melissa Waibel mentioned that he is truly driven by what he can give others, and it is with great pleasure knowing and working with him.

Speaker Won Pat Ed.D. called forth Mr. Chris Felix.

Mr. Chris Felix mentioned that he has no experience working with Dr. Hyo Sang Ji, but he looks forward to be working with Dr. Hyo Sang Ji. He mentioned that Dr. Hyo Sang Ji will be a true asset to the Board of Regents and to the University.

**Speaker Won Pat Ed.D** called up Mr. Elvin Chang, Ms. Maria Flor, and mentioned that Dr. Lee Carter signed up in support of Dr. Hyo Sang Ji.

Mr. Elvin Chang thanked Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D. and Senator N.B. Underwood for the opportunity and mentioned that he is in support of the appointment of Dr. Hyo Sang Ji. Mr. Chang feels that the Board of Regents with a diversified background, will benefit us a lot; especially with Dr. Hyo Sang Ji's background in public health and medicine field. Mr. Chang also added that this will help with nursing programs and our students' health at stake; Dr. Hyo Sang Ji's expertise will help the board and the university. He lastly mentioned that he is in support of the appointment of Dr. Hyo Sang Ji.

Ms. Maria Flor thanked Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D. and Senator N.B. Underwood for the opportunity. She mentioned that it is a pleasure to testify in support of the appointment of Dr. Hyo Sang Ji. She mentioned that she did not know Dr. Hyo Sang Ji very well but they met about 10 to12 years ago, where he left a lasting impression. She stated that her husband was medevac to Manila where they spent 2 months there; it was a very trying time and that one day she was there in her husband's room and all of a sudden a gentleman came into her room and he introduced himself as a medical student, Mr. Ji. Ms. Maria Flor mentioned that it was very touching for her that Dr. Hyo Sang Ji took the time to see what he can do. Ms. Maria Flor mentioned that Dr. Hyo Sang Ji told her he is from Guam and that they lived in the same neighborhood, but then parted ways, and then she did not hear from him again until he applied to be a member. Ms. Maria Flor mentioned that Dr. Hyo Sang Ji will be a great asset to the board because he shows a lot of compassion and the willingness to serve. Ms. Maria Flor mentioned Dr. Hyo Sang Ji will make a good board member.

**Dr. Hyo Sang Ji** mentioned that President Underwood stated a lot about his credentials but he would like to reiterate his background. Dr. Hyo Sang Ji stated that he was born in Korea, moved to Guam since he was 1 to 2 years old. Dr. Hyo Sang Ji mentioned that he and his family left Guam to go to California for schooling, because residency in state was cheaper. Dr. Hyo Sang Ji

stated, "This is where I met my wife 'Stells' or Stella and we've been together for about 19 years." He mentioned that he did his residency in Buffalo, New York, and finished in 2011 and came straight home. Dr. Hyo Sang Ji mentioned that he has always been a proponent of higher education. He also asked his second oldest daughter what she wanted to do, so he mentioned that the University of Guam is great place, and she did attend the University of Guam for 2 years and she did wonderfully well. Moreover Dr. Hyo Sang Ji mentioned they did not have the program at the University of Guam so she followed suit with the off island program, and now she is at the University of Hawaii still doing well, majoring in Architecture just about to graduate. Dr. Hyo Sang Ji is very proud of his daughter because she started at the University of Guam. Dr. Hyo Sang Ji mentioned that he always talks to kids, high school kids to tell them why highschool is very important. He also mentioned that he just got out of the Jose Rios Middle School professional day in which he asked to speak to kids. Dr. Hyo Sang Ji was asked, "Why to go to college?" His answer, "The main reason is for better critical thinking."

**Dr. Hyo Sang Ji** mentioned that he is a very big proponent of higher education, and UOG is one of the cheapest universities of all the universities in the United States. He stated, "I'm a big proponent and very eager to be part of the board. It is a civil duty to be part of the community for some outreach programs and get them going. Someone like Senator Dennis G. Rodriguez Jr., he is a good friend of mine, I approached him several times for outreach for basic life support programs in our community and mayors offices." He mentioned that he is very eager to be part of the University of Guam Board of Regents and hopes to do a good job.

**Speaker Won Pat Ed.D** thanked Dr. Sang Ji for accepting the nomination. Speaker Won Pat Ed.D And mentioned that she is very happy to have someone like Dr. Sang Ji's with an extensive background and passion to come back to Guam to serve the people of Guam.

**Senator N.B. Underwood** echoed her gratitude to first come back to Guam and to encourage our young kids to go to college. Senator N.B. Underwood stated, "Although it seems rushed, but I am about to perform a marriage, and the couple is waiting." Senator N.B. Underwood asked this question, "As a University of Guam Board of Regent, how do you perceive your role is in relation to administration at the University of Guam?"

**Dr. Hyo Sang Ji** replied, "I know I am young and new to this whole process, but I am here for 6 years, Im feeling after the first year, fill out some things, what my role will actually be, and I have a lot of ideas. There is going to be a process that I am going to have to go through. I want to learn as much as I want to give, I want to learn. With the President Underwood and all the Board of Regents here, I know they will guide me in the right direction in having all these things in order, will allow me to go through. I want all these plans done, I want to get my feet wet first and see where I fit in."

Speaker Won Pat Ed.D mentioned that Dr. Hyo Sang Ji has members of the board or regents who have been there, Mr. Chris Felix has 4 more to go. You have all these individuals to guide

you through. Speaker Won Pat Ed.D. also mentioned that many people come into the board with many ideas, but sometimes you have to step back, and find out how the university is doing, where they are going, and their goals we don't want to side track from going to good to great and pursuing the campaign of the natural choice. Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D. mentioned that she appreciates Dr. Hyo Sang Ji participating at schools for career days and being a big proponent of education.

Speaker Won Pat Ed.D mentioned that because you come from St. Lukes in the Philippines where they have a lot of nursing schools; we have a small nursing school in which you get a cadre of students that will move a long by this semester, students will have to miss a semester or wait a whole year, and it is discouraging for nursing students. I have heard of students going offisland to pursue education, because they are unable here. So I am hoping that with your experience at St. Lukes and other nursing programs, and with our nursing program, that you may be able to assist in that area, whether it's going to be in terms of exchange programs with other nursing hospitals, or resident expert for a semester or two, you will use that personal experience, in the growth and development of nursing school at UOG.

**Speaker Won Pat Ed.D** mentioned because of your profession, there is a big issue on the islands, the Micronesians islands. There is an association called PIHOA Pacific Island Health Organizations Association which a group based on the islands. There is some communication or agreements where we can have the university have a presence in all of these islands. Like UC Davis in California, they are beating our university, by having their students attend the university, or to do distance learning. I would like UOG to be the pearl of the Pacific like in the past, we had a lot of our leaders graduate from the University of Guam.

**Dr. Ji-** that is what I keep telling our kids, that we have a great school.

**Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D.** mentioned that she is hoping the 3 board members can take this to the board meeting to expand outside of the University to house campus and actually go out. I like the idea that you're coming in with all these ideas. That your ideas will come to fruition and we will see great things for the university. I was surprised when I got your packet because you are going to be really busy.

**Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D.** thanked Dr. Hyo Sang Ji and his wife for allowing to serve in this board, giving back to the community and most importantly giving back to the University of Guam.

Dr. Hyo Sang Ji replied Guam is home.

**Speaker Won Pat Ed.D** mentioned that she is very proud and that the packet will be ready for the confirmation hearing and Congratulations in advance.

**Speaker Won Pat Ed.D** is in full support of the confirmation hearing and concluded the public hearing at 3:50 p.m. and also mentioned if there are additional letters of support to email it to speaker@judiwonpat.com or hand delivered at 155 Hesler Place Hagatna Guam, 96910. 




