COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Municipal Affairs, Tourism, Housing and Historic Preservation convened a confirmation hearing on Wednesday, April 15, 2015 at 9:00 AM in I Liheslatura's Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of the appointment of JAMES P. VIERNES, to serve as the History Alternate Member, Guam Historic Preservation Review Board of Directors, and whose appointment history is as follows:

- Appointed by I Maga'lahen Guåhan on March 21, 2015, to serve for a term of four (4) years;
- Appointment packet forwarded to I Liheslatura on March 20, 2015;
- Appointment packet forwarded to this committee for public consideration on Wednesday, April 15, 2015.

Public Notice Requirements

Notices were disseminated via e-mail to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on Wednesday, April 8, 2015 (5-Day Notice), and again on Friday, April 10, 2015 (48-Hour Notice).

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

The public hearing was Called-to-Order at 9:07 a.m.

<u>Chairperson</u> – The committee on municipal affairs, tourism, housing, and historic preservation will now come to order. It is about 9:07 a.m. this morning. On the agenda this morning will be the appointment of James P. Viernes as the History Alternate Member for the Guam Historic Preservation Review Board of Directors and we will also be hearing Resolution 21-33 (COR) Relative to identifying a suitable lot to effectuate an

exchange of government-own property reserved for the Department of Public Health and Social Services for government-owned property owned by the Chamorro Land Trust Commission pursuant to Public Law No. 32-226. I am the sponsor of that Resolution and I want to note for the record that in accordance to 5 GCA, Chapter 8, Subsection 8107, notices of these two items were sent out to all the main media, broadcasting outlets, to all the Senators, meeting the 5 day notice requirement, which was April 8th; and then the 48 hour notice which was on Friday, April 10th satisfying the two day notice. If there are additional written testimonies from the listening audience, they have up to ten days to submit them after this public hearing and you can submit your written testimony to the office of Senator Tina Muna Barnes at 155 Hesler Place Hagatna, Guam 96910 or you can fax us at 472-3400 or via e-mail to senator@tinamunabarnes.com and if you should have any further questions you can call our office and contact my Chief of Staff, Stephanie Flores or Jeanenne Cordero at 472-3455 or 56. Ladies and gentlemen joining me here this morning are my colleagues to my left Senator Tony Ada and Senator Tom Ada. Thank you for joining us here this morning.

We will go ahead and get started and get the list of those wanting to speak on behalf of James P. Viernes. It's just James this morning. I do see that the Director of Guam Preservation Trust is here and I'll go ahead and call him up to the panel. I do know that he wants to speak on behalf of Mr. Viernes. I will also note for the record that in conversation; and I will disclose for the record, I was speaking to my twin sister; her name is Donna Muna Quinata who wanted to extend her support and wanted to be here for the public hearing but she's stuck in an Auto Spot Management Meeting right now, and she said "can you tell my God Brother that she wants to give her full support" so just know that she's not here right now, but she's here in spirit cause she's at that meeting. She said she will submit written testimony; so just for the record please identify yourself, where you're from, and if you support the appointment.

Joe Quinata- Buenas and Hafa Adai Chairwoman/Madam my name is Joe Quinata I am the Chief Program Officer of the Guam Preservation Trust and I'm here to testify in favor of James Viernes for two main reasons; one reason is that the trust has worked with Mr. Viernes in different capacities as a Historian and the second reason is the fact

that the trust is in dire need of Board Members and so we really would like to run this process through so that we can get the Board to start moving ahead.

<u>Chairperson</u>- Thank you; are there any questions for Mr. Quinata. Nothing? Okay with that being said, you're more than welcome to stay next to Dr. Viernes; if not Mr. Viernes you may go ahead and present your testimony.

<u>James P. Viernes</u> - Good morning Senators, thank you for taking the time to see to this confirmation hearing today. My name is James Perez Viernes I am a son of Santa Rita village, I am adjunct faculty at the University of Guam in the History and Chamorro studies programs, as well as the Division of English and Applied Linguistics. I'm also a Doctoral Candidate at the University of Hawaii at Manoa; Department of History, I'll be finishing that Degree in three weeks time as dissertation defense has been scheduled finally. So, with that being said thank you again for taking the time to hear my case. I was very honored to have been nominated for the seat of History Alternate for the Board of Directors of the Guam Preservation Trust. Primarily first and foremost because I very much admire the Trust and its mission, its particular approach to preservation here on Guam; I've actually been a recipient of a Trust Grant in the past and I very much value what the Trust does; and I'm also very much honored to receive that nomination because I've always considered myself a person of privilege, not necessarily material privilege but certainly in the sense of the education that I received having been able to access advanced education; I've always felt very privileged in that sense but also very obligated to this community here on Guam; to return to the island and try and give back some of what I've learned, some of what I've experienced; to contribute to the historical consciousness of this island; and that's primarily why I've tried to build a career at the University of Guam as part of an avenue to do that, but I do realize that there's a world outside of that Mangilao campus, outside of the classrooms, outside of our faculty offices, and so the Preservation Trust is one opportunity to again take the privilege that I've had and reciprocate that to the community so I very much look forward to a potential confirmation to that Board and I believe that I have very much to bring to that table in the way of perspective vision and again the education and experience that I've received.

<u>Chairperson</u> – Si Yuos Maase Mr. Viernes; and I'll go ahead and open it for comments or questions. Senator Tony Ada.

<u>Senator Tony Ada</u> – thank you Madam Chair, thank you Mr. Viernes for being here and also taking the appointment to the Board. I was looking at your resume and what an impressive resume; your community service outreach, all your involvement in the different organizations. The only question I really had was, you're currently a member of several organizations, an Advisor and Proctor on a task force. Being on the Board will you still be able to make the meetings and things like that and not foresee any problems with that?

<u>James Viernes</u> – I don't foresee any problems with that Senator. Actually one of the first questions I had when Mr. Quinata informed me of the nomination, was what are the expectations as far as my time and my emergent because I'm very much aware of my limitations as an individual and my existing commitments, and we've discussed that, and for myself as long as I'm very aware of what is on my plate and what is ahead then I make the time.

<u>Senator Tony Ada</u> – oh that's great. I have no further questions. You have my full support and you have my vote. Thank you Mr. Viernes.

Chairperson – Thank you Senator Tony Ada. Senator Tom Ada? Okay, for the record thank you Mr. Vierenes for taking the time to volunteer, cause you know this is a labor of love right, for the most part? But with all your credentials and the expertise that you have in this discipline and wanting to help out I extend my Un Dangkolo Na Si Yuus Maase; and now that I know that Donna won't make it here for that I will go ahead and let her know that I will commit to making it a point to put it on the session agenda. I know that as Guam Preservation Trust celebrates its 25th year here there's still a lot of work that needs to be done; we've got several huge projects that we've been working with, and that we'll continue to move forward like the akton tano project, and I just want to say that with your expertise and the discipline that you have that I want to say thank you, and I want to thank the Governor for his appointment. It's not very easy to get members and I want to ask you Mr. Quinata just because you said you need many

members, when Mr. Viernes gets on the Board will that at least fulfill the quorum or do you already have a quorum?

Joe Quinata – we already have a quorum right now but we do have a very busy Board.

<u>Chairperson</u> - So how many more would you need to fulfill all the different disciplines per the law?

Joe Quinata - We need three more; two for Archeology, and one for Architecture.

<u>Chairperson</u> - I will go ahead and extend the letter to the Administration, to the Governor's office, asking that they do their due diligence in looking for those volunteers, also just to help you out, because I know that you guys have a very busy schedule. I want to say thank you again. Thank you for your time, I really appreciate it and I'm going to say in advance, congratulations. So we do go into session at the end of the month, the week of the 27th. So I will definitely make it a point to have the committee prepare the reports. We'll open it until session week and hopefully if we get the written testimonies we'll go ahead and submit it to the packet.

<u>James P. Viernes</u> - On that note, on behalf of my colleagues and several people in the community, I do have to apologize I asked them not to attend because I did not want them to take leave of their duties from the government and so that is why they are not here but written testimony will be forthcoming.

<u>Chairperson</u> – thank you. The appointment of James P. Viernes for the History Alternate Member for the Guam Historic Preservation Review Board of Directors has been publicly heard. Next on the agenda we have Resolution No. 21-33 (COR).

The public hearing was adjourned at 11:25 a.m.







Thank you for this opportunity to submit testimony in support of Mr. James Viernes and his appointment to serve as the History Alternate Member to the Guam Historic Preservation Review Board of Directors. I believe the nominating committee has made an excellent choice in approaching Mr. Viernes for this important position.

My name is Dominica Tolentino, a lifelong resident of Guam, and current employee at the Guampedia Foundation, Inc., a local nonprofit organization that manages guampedia.com, an online encyclopedia about Guam history, culture and society. I have known Mr. Viernes since 2008 when we were graduate students at the University of Hawaii at Manoa. Mr. Viernes and I have similar academic and scholarly interests in Pacific history, Guam history, Chamorro people and culture, and other broad issues impacting the people and politics of the region. Mr. Viernes is in the final stages of completing his doctoral degree in Pacific History at the University of Hawaii—an admirable and significant accomplishment.

In the few years he has engaged in graduate studies, Mr. Viernes is already considered one of the most impressive up-and-coming scholars and researchers of Pacific history. His widely cited Master's thesis on the history of Sumay village documents the experiences of former residents as well as analyzes the local tensions and critical understandings of displacement, loyalty and American colonialism on Guam. It is a well-researched document that captures the largely hidden story of Chamorro experiences of pre-World War II Sumay, postwar land takings, and the creation of Santa Rita village. Indeed, Mr. Viernes continues to engage with the people and the story of Sumay, having produced a publication for them and participating in the annual "Back to Sumay" event at Naval Station. His PhD dissertation delves further into issues of gender and identity within the context of American colonialism on Guam. He has presented scholarly papers at a variety of history conferences and in fact, he will be a keynote speaker at the upcoming 3rd Marianas History Conference in September. He is also a co-organizer of the regional Pacific History Association conference for 2016.

In addition to his graduate work, Mr. Viernes has demonstrated a deep commitment to the study of Guam history and the passing on of that knowledge to future generations of students and scholars through his work as an adjunct faculty member at the University of Guam. For the past several years Mr. Viernes has been teaching courses in Guam history, Chamorro studies and English, and is also an editor of *Storyboard*, the university's publication of creative writing and art. Having been a Guam history instructor at UOG myself, I know that Mr. Viernes is an excellent teacher, able to use a variety of resources to make Guam history come alive for his students. He is a strong but impartial advocate for the people of Guam, and it shows in his approach to teaching and the positive responses he gets from students and colleagues alike.

I know Mr. Viernes best, though, through the work we have done together at Guampedia. I am the content editor for the guampedia.com website, where part of my job is to find writers and

reviewers for our various entries about Guam history and culture. Mr. Viernes has written several entries for our website since 2007, including entries on music artists of Guam, and more recently, the Chamorro quest for self-determination, civil rights and US citizenship. He is an excellent researcher and writer. He also has helped review numerous entries to ensure information on Guampedia is accurate and up-to-date. In fact, because of his position at the University, Mr. Viernes adds a level of professional and scholarly credibility to our work. I have always been impressed by his extensive knowledge of Guam and Pacific history, as well as his ability to make difficult topics easier to understand; his interdisciplinary approach and careful attention to detail in his research and writing, and his genuine and generous personality. He assists Guampedia whenever he can and our work together has led to many useful collaborations for promoting Guam history for our students.

Because of his educational background and expertise, I believe Mr. Viernes is a natural fit for the Board of Directors. I sincerely feel Mr. Viernes will bring new perspective and valuable insight to issues of cultural preservation and community outreach and education that will benefit the Board of Directors in their organizational plans and activities.
