The Committee on Rules, Federal, Foreign and Micronesian Affairs; Human and Natural Resources, Election Reform, and Capitol District convened a public hearing on Friday, November 18, 2016 at 9:00 A.M. in the Public Hearing Room of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of on the appointment of **Mr. John T. Calvo to serve as a Member of the** *Hagåtña* **Restoration and Redevelopment Authority**, **Board of Commissioners** [Length of Term (5) Five Years] whose appointment history is as follows:

- Appointed by Governor Eddie Baza Calvo on October 14, 2016;
- Appointment packet forwarded to I Liheslatura on October 14, 2016;
- Packet forwarded to this committee for public consideration on October 18, 2016.





Subject: Reconfirmation Testimony on John T. Calvo As a Member of the Hagåtña Restoration and Redevelopment Authority (HRRA) Board of Commissioners

Buenas yan Hafa Adai Chairman and Committee Members. Due to an immediate concern with my Guam business enterprise, I am currently off-island on East Timor resolving an issue that requires my personal attention. Therefore, I apologize but provide this written testimony on my behalf.

Over five (5) years ago, I was appointed and confirmed to the HRRA Board of Commissioners as a member and subsequently as Chairman of the Board. Upon review of what was required for the restoration and redevelopment of the City of Hagåtña, the outstanding tasks were formidable and daunting but not insurmountable. During my tenure, we worked towards ensuring a full seven (7) member HRRA Board of Commissioners was available for quorum to addressed the requisite tasks of completing and providing a Hagåtña Masterplan along with its regulatory components. This required a review by the Attorney General on the validity of the previous Hagåtña Masterplan contract, however, the contract was considered terminated due to lack of previous HRRA Board action. Nevertheless, the HRRA Board of Commissioners continued working towards the end-state of providing a feasible and sustainable Hagåtña Masterplan without encumbering the government's general fund. Provided are some of the successes that the HRRA Board of Commissioners have collaborated while working towards the HRRA vision of "a vibrant Hagåtña as the center of cultural, civic, political, sports, and economic vitality for Guam and the Western Pacific."

- A Memorandum of Agreement between HRRA and GEDA to fund the Hagåtña Masterplan and its subsequent components.
- Contracting to Complete the Hagåtña Masterplan with Matrix Design Group Inc.
- Engaging the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers on hydrology actions that includes the Hagåtña River and the Hagåtña Bay coastal shoreline area.
- Collaboration on the indispensable inclusion of the Mayor of Hagåtña and the *I Liheslaturan Guahån* representative to become a part of the HRRA Board of Commissioners.
- Collaboration on the development and completion of the Guam Museum.
- Collaboration on the removal of the old DOA Building.

- Collaboration on the revitalization of the Paseo de Susana area including the Chamorro Village expansion; the Paseo Viewing Platform; the Paseo Recreation Center Renovation;
- Collaboration on the Chamorro Village-Skinner Plaza Pedestrian Cross-walk installation.
- Direction and guidance to the HRRA Contractor Matrix Design Group, Inc. This includes approved but not implemented projects and providing focused Hagåtña Development Districts to ensure that Hagåtña would continue to be developed as a Guam micro-destination for place-based heritage attractions through historical event-place-period tourism, development of historic cultural corridors, and the restoration and maintenance of Hagåtña historical and cultural sites.

However, there are still projects pending. Those are pending projects are:

- Continued engagement with the ACOE on hydrology actions to stimulate economic development & growth by channeling the Hagåtña River and providing coastal shoreline protection measures.
- Complete the Hagåtña Masterplan along with the Zoning Code & Standards of Development regulation and the supporting Implementation & Sustainability Plans.
- Prepare for & implement the four (4) District Economic Development Plans for Hagåtña City Center District; Hagåtña River-walk District; Hagåtña Bay Waterfront District; and the West Hagåtña Residential District.
- Settle HRRA's dedicated funding source.
