COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

The nomination of John Rupley to serve as a Member of the Department of Parks and Recreation Board of Commissioners, for a term of four (4) years, was made by Governor Edward J.B. Calvo on May 11, 2015. The nomination package was received by the Office of Speaker Judith T. Won Pat, Ed.D., on May 12, 2015, and was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development on May 13, 2015.

The Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development held a public hearing on June 3, 2015, in *I Liheslatura*'s Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the hearing agenda was the nomination of John Rupley to serve as a Member of the Department of Parks and Recreation Board of Commissioners. The hearing convened at 2:00 p.m. and was adjourned at 2:43 p.m.

Public Hearing notices were disseminated via electronic mail to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on May 27, 2015, and again on June 1, 2015. Notice was also posted on *I Liheslatura*'s website beginning on May 27, 2015.

II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Chairman Michael San Nicolas convened the hearing on the nomination of Mr. John Rupley. The Chairman called Mr. Raymond Blas to present his testimony.

Mr. Raymond Blas read his written testimony in support of the nominee. He spoke about Mr. Rupley's experience as a current board member. He mentioned the improvement of Department policies and its accomplishments.

Mr. John Rupley spoke about his experience on the Board and stressed the importance of having a full Board. He spoke about the importance of taking care of our island's parks because those are the places our tourists see when they visit. Mr. Rupley stated that he is committed to ensuring that parks are taken care of and properly maintained.

Chairman San Nicolas opened the floor to other Senators for questions and comments.

Senator V. Anthony Ada thanked the nominee for accepting the Governor's nomination. He expressed support for the nominee.

Chairman San Nicolas stated that several members of the community inquired about the ability of private businesses to set up operations in government facilities and parks. He asked Mr. Rupley to explain the process that a business must go through to obtain authorization to set up an establishment on or in government property.

Mr. Rupley stated that each request goes before the Board and Department on a case by case basis. He stated that he supports both small businesses and ways to integrate their services at the parks. Mr. Rupley mentioned that the Board members meet and speak with prospective vendor before approving any agreement they may enter into with the Department.

Chairman San Nicolas asked if the Board has developed or considered developing a plan or list of parks that they are interested in obtaining proposals for. He stated that with a listing, the Department could send out a request for proposals to the general public and generate more interest from prospective vendors or businesses which may not currently be present.

Mr. Rupley answered that any such plan or listing has not yet been presented to the Board. He reassured the Committee that the Board is committed to looking at every proposal that is presented to them. Mr. Rupley stated that he will present that inquiry to the Director and other Board members so they have a better understanding of the inventory available. He wants to ensure that the entire process is fair and standard for everyone.

Chairman San Nicolas agreed with Mr. Rupley. He stated that any steps we take to ensure that we are helping small businesses grow are beneficial for our local residents and for tourism. He encouraged the Department and the Board to develop standard operating procedures for presenting this to the public so that greater interest and competition may be generated.

Mr. Rupley stated that he will bring the issue up at the next Board meeting and have Mr. Blas begin the work on developing a listing.

Chairman San Nicolas thanked Mr. Rupley and indicated his support for his nomination.

Senator Mary Torres stated that it might be advantageous for the Department to incorporate certain "themes" to each park based on the respective village in which it is located. She mentioned her experiences in the U.S. mainland and how many of the national parks integrated characteristics associated with the specific area in which it is located. She suggested that the Department and Board collaborate with the Guam Visitors Bureau and the Mayors' Council of Guam to incorporate a theme so that each park will be different from one another. In doing so, Senator Torres stated that she believed that this would enhance a visitor's experience at the particular park.

Mr. Rupley responded to Senator Torres by stating that the idea she mentioned has been discussed. However, he stated that they anticipate difficulty getting all the relevant stakeholders to meet. He stated that there will be maintenance and security issues that have to be dealt with. Mr. Rupley reinforced the importance of keeping the parks clean and well-maintained further stating that visitors come for the "sun, sand, and coconut trees." However, he did mention that any plan is worth trying.

Chariman San Nicolas thanked the both Mr. Blas and Mr. Rupley for their attendance.






