#### II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

The Public Hearing was called to order at 9:03 a.m.

Senator Barnes: This public hearing by the committee on municipal affairs, tourism, housing, and historic preservation is now called to order it is about 9:03 in the morning for the record and in accordance to 5 GCA, Chapter 8, subsection 8107, notices were sent out via email to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on Tuesday November 3 3015 which adheres to the five day open government rule and the second day notice on Friday, November 6 for the 48 hour notice. Please note that written testimonies may be submitted up to 10 days after this public hearing. It's customarily done and that would be to the offices of senator of Tina Muña Barnes at 155 Hesler Place, Hagåtña Guam 96910 or you can send written testimony via facsimile at 472-3400 or via our email at senator@tinamunabarnes.com, furthermore, should you have any questions please do not hesitate to contact our office and 472-3455 or 56, Bernice Rivera, Alan Cepeda, or Jeanenne Cordero will be available. Ladies and Gentlemen we do have a full schedule this morning on the agenda.

We will hear several appointments and several bills and we will be listening, uh hearing the appointments of Joseph M. Leon Guerrero, Resident Manager of Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority Board of directors. The second appointment would be for the appointment of Annabelle M. Dancel member to the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority Board of directors and also to Mrs. Maria P. Dela Rosa member to the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal board of directors. Uh

In no particular order, I'm going to. We've got 1...2...3...4 bills on the agenda, Bill 203-33 COR is an act to add a new section 849.102 article 1 of chapter 8 1 GCA to dedicate and name the farmers market facility operated by the farmers' cooperative association of Guam inc. after its championing advocate and its leading legislative supporter for the establishment Speaker Vicente Ben C. Pangelinan Guam Farmers Market.

#### And um...

We also have Bill 186 an act to appropriate the funds from fiscal year 2014 Hotel Occupancy Tax Surplus Fund to the Guam Visitors Bureau for a pilot program to support the needs of a growing Korean visiting market.

We will also listen to bill 160-33 (COR) an act to add a new Article 9 to Chapter 63 Title 5 Guam Code Annotated, relative to the Guam Ocean and Fisheries Conservation Act of



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2015. To add a new Subsection (g) to Section 30101 to chapter 30 title 11 Guam Code Annotated relative to the establishment of the Marine Conservation Fee and to amend Section 30107 Chapter 30 Title 11 Guam Code Annotated relative to the deposit of fees into the Guam Ocean and Fisheries Conservation and Development Fund.

Ladies and gentlemen I will note for the record on this Bill 160-33 after working closely with the author of the legislation there will be a substituted version at the request of the Author. I will give him an opportunity to explain that bill, that substitution, and then open up for record additional testimony and maybe even a mark-up hearing if necessary but just know that the bill that will be heard today is based on the substituted version uh. We will give the opportunity for the legislature uh to put that online if anybody in the listening audience here and on. In their homes if they like to comment on that bill know that we will open up that per uh additional mark-up if necessary and give the author the uh time to detail the changes and what the bill is about. We will also be hearing the last on the agenda is uh 161-33 (COR) which is an act to repeal and reenact Section 1026 of Chapter 10 Title 1 Guam Code Annotated, relative establishing the Guam Liberation Fishing Event um ladies and gentlemen um we do have a full agenda if you would like to speak we do have a sign-in sheet outside please don't hesitate if you like to show your support but don't want to speak then just note that you were here so that we can append it to the committee report please do so by signing up and for who you're here for today go ahead and mark if you're support or not in support and then just if you don't want to speak just put that down.

Sound is not on, ok. If uh I'd also like to thank my colleagues for joining me to my immediate right my brother Senator Frank Blas. Good Morning thank you for joining me to his immediate right is Senator Jimmy Espaldon. To my left is minority leader Senator Tony Ada and to his left is Senator Brant McCreadie, thank you gentlemen for joining us this morning. With that being said we do have three appointments to the Guam Housing Urban Renewal Authority; Joseph M Leon Guerrero, Annabelle Dancel, and Marie P. Dela Rosa. I do have the sign-up sheets and maybe I can make this easier... is it working?

Ladies and gentlemen I bet your... I was just told by um committee members that the sound for the listening audience and for public broadcasting wasn't heard so I'm going to have to repeat. It was um. But did they get the information ok. Thank you. Well that sounds great um.



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So this is what I'll do this morning, I'm going to ask all those who wish to speak on behalf of the three members to come up at this time. I'll call up Mike Duenas, Albert Santos, and ... if you can go ahead and come up... uh mayor Rudy are you going to speak on one of the members for GHURA?

Mayor you're more than welcome to comment. I do apologize ladies and gentlemen I do have some mayors in the house. All the way down from Inarajan I have Mayor Doris Lujan Manana Si Yu'os, thank you for coming and also Mayor Rudy Mantanane from Yigo I do also have with us ladies and gentlemen the consul General to Palau here on Guam Consul General Vik April Si Yu'os Ma'åse. Thanks a lot for coming this morning. Mayor Doris are you here to speak on yes please come on up and if these two fine gentlemen don't mind I'm going to uh just um yield to the lady first if I may uh senator I mean senator I'm already speaking that to existence Mayor Doris Lujan from Inalahan manana Si Yu'os thank you for coming please go ahead and state your name for the record I'm going to have everybody state your name for the record why they're here, where they're from, if they are in support or not in support of the specific um uh whether appointment or bill they are speak about k?

Sigi pot fabot...

Mayor Doris Flores: Buenas yan hafa adai Madame chair and honorable senators for the record my name is Doris Flores Lujan Mayor of Inalahan I'm here to lend support of Marie P. Dela Rosa's confirmation to the board of directors with the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal thank you for allowing me the opportunity to testify. As a public servant for over 30 years for the department of parks and recreation Marie performed her duties with integrity and professionalism she continues to volunteer her services to our island community I am confident and have faith in Marie that she will carry out her roles and responsibilities as a board member, deciding to dedicate your life to public service is a choice and she is committed to create healthy and sustainable homes for our island residence. Madame Chair I humbly ask Mrs. Dela Rosa's nomination be favorably considered and confirm her as a board member Marie would be a valuable asset si Yu'os Ma'åse I also support the other two members.

Senator Barnes: You also support Annabelle Dancel and Mr. Joe Leon Guerrero right...

Mayor Doris Lujan: Yes



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<u>Senator Barnes:</u> Si yu'os maase uh mayor uh doris lujan um mayor uh rudy mantanane from yigo? Sigi pot fabot...

Mayor Doris Lujan: For the record I'm Mayor Rudy Mantane I'm here to support in favor of um Mrs. Marie Dela Rosa's uh nominee for um the GHURA board and I'm also here as Rudy Mantanane a friend of Marie and you know uh mayor this beautiful mayor right next to me Lujan from the beautiful village of Inarajan although Yigo's much more beautiful not enough water but is a lot of cocounut crab and deer up there so you know saying my support for Marie I've known Marie for over 20 years and I think her knowledge at the Department of Parks and Rec is just integral to uh give you know uh ideas and whatever is needed at GHURA housing as a board member and I know that you know GHURA has been doing a lot of good things for our villages and you know for everything else I think there's always room for improvement and I feel that Marie Dela Rosa's knowledge as far as uh the things that GHURA does for Guam is very much needed because she has a lot of knowledge with uh Parks and Rec and that's a lot of what we need you know. as my experience of Mayor of Yigo were always you know going to GHURA to try to find funding to improve the quality of life for our kids in Yigo and it's very much needed parks and everything that has to do with parks and the kids is very much needed up there in Yigo. I know that Marie with all her knowledge and working with Parks and Recreation can really help in the things that we really need in the villages and I also throw my support for the other two individuals that are up for nominations. Thank you very much senators. I'm sorry Madame uh that I did not address you and all the honorable senators here good morning and thank you for having us here for speaking on behalf of these people that you know want to take the challenge. Thank you very much.

<u>Senator Barnes:</u> You're very welcome Mayor Mantanane. Also joining me ladies and gentlemen is Honorable Speaker. Speaker Won Pat thank you for joining us and Senator Dennis Rodriguez. Thank you very much for joining us um Mr. Duenas please.

Michael Duenas: Good morning Madame Chair and members of the committee. My name is Michael Duenas I'm the executive director for Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority. I want to thank the committee for expediting this hearing process. We have a seven member board and at this point we have four vacancies we have not met. The board has not been able to meet from October through this month because we don't quorum. We're hoping that the um the three members before the legislature will



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be confirmed in time to allow us to have a board meeting on November 30<sup>th</sup> there are several items that um that require the board action that are time sensitive and that's why we're looking to trying to schedule a board meeting by November 30<sup>th</sup>. If the legislature is able to confirm before during the November session um I'm here also in support of all three of the nominees it is a challenge to find uh citizens out here who are willing to volunteer to serve on the various boards and commissions and I want to thank these three individuals and accepted the governors invitation to be on the GHURA board. Thank you Madame Chair.

Senator Barnes: You're very welcome Mr. Duenas. Mr. Santos

Albert Santos: Good morning Madame Chair and committee members again I appreciate allowing us here to testify in support of the three nominees. I do echo Mr. Duenas um again concern about the need to have our board in place. What's welcoming is that we have three diverse individuals that we're looking forward to being on our board and we certainly have a lot of new challenges ahead of us and with their background I'm sure they will be big assets in terms of guiding our way towards what we plan to do in the future. As Mr., the mayor from Yigo mentioned, we are deeply involved again in developing our community helping our youth and in fact we're doing a pretty big project in his village and hopefully we will get it done in March so we can celebrate that and certainly again as I mentioned the three members are welcome to our agency with the expertise and the background they have as well I can. I'm in full support of all three nominees.

Senator Barnes: Si Yu'os Ma'ase Mr. Santos. At this time does any of my colleagues have any comments or questions for these panel members? If not I'm going to ask if Mr. Duenas and Mr. Santos go ahead stay for the duration of the appointments at least in case there are any inquiries. Thank you Mayor Lujan and Mayor Mantanane for giving us the opportunity to um present your testimony in support of the GHURA members. Uh. In no particular order I will go ahead and call um before I call all the nominees up Mr. Solis, Henry Solis would you like to speak or here for support. Ok thank you. Um. Lourdes Paulino and Agusto Paulino Just here for support thank you very much. And Mannete Duenas support ok thank you. Uh John Dela Rosa here for support and John Calvo here for support or testimony, thank you. And Dorothy Sanchez here for support? Fully support, thank you. And that will be all three nominees for Marie Dela Rosa. Thank you, with that being said uh. I will have the three nominees. Mr. Joseph



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Leon Guerrero. Mrs. Marie Dela Rosa, and Ms. Annabelle Dancel. Please come up and present your testimony.

Mr. Leon Guerrero I know you were first on the Agenda, but if I may, can I yield to the women before you, thank you very much and at this time I would ask Mrs. Dela Rosa please read your testimony.

<u>Maria Dela Rosa:</u> (In audible). Right now, I feel very touch being here thinking about many memories with my husband Mr. Dela Rosa and I'm here hoping he will be here right next to me. I did ask him to come and support me. I miss him so much.

Senator Barnes: I know he's watching over us.

Hafa Adai Madame Chairman, my names Marie Paulino Dela Rosa I am humble at the opportunity to be here before you in my quest for confirmation and support for the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority. Currently, I'm working as supporting coordinator for commission on decolonization. I was born and raised on Guam as a Chamorro woman I carry the Chamorro spirit of generosity and willingness to help and serve in the years of government service. Volunteer work at the Guam Memorial Work Volunteers Association, the Rigalu Foundation, and the Movement and the Church. As a government of Guam employee I've worked the Department of Youth Affairs, I've worked with the federal grants applications at the Department of Parks and Recreation Resources Historic division. After retiring with 35 years of service raising two children I became an immediate caregiver for my late husband John Dela Rosa, after his passing I have continued to play an active role in my community to my willingness to help people and pay it forward. In granted the opportunity to serve our islands community my focus is in channeling the services for all GHURA residence, the manamko, and others displace of homelessness by adhering to GHURA's mission statement in strengthening the family and building communities' one project at a time. Si Yu'os Ma'ase Madame Chairman. Rest assured I have no current or potential business conflict of interest.

Senator Barnes: Si Yu'os Ma'ase Mrs. Dela Rosa. Um. Ms. Dancel

Annabelle M. Dancel: Good morning Madame Chair and the committees my name is Annabelle Dancel. I was born in the Philippines but I was raised here on Guam I was here 45 years now. I work for a private firm they call it McDonalds on Guam for over 35 years as a restaurant manager and finally retired last year and um I right now I'm busy



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doing community service, I'm involved in the Guam Memorial Hospital Volunteer, I'm involved with the Lions Club and all the Philippine Association of Guam and I was uh here for confirmation today as the Guam Directors of Guam GHURA. Thank you.

Senator Barnes: You're very welcome Ms. Dancel. Mr. Leon Guerrero.

Joseph M. Leon Guerrero: Thank you Madame Chairman. Good morning Senator Barnes and members Committee of Municipal Affairs Tourism and Historic Preservation. My name is Joseph Leon Guerrero, a resident in public housing for three years. I am here today to seek the approval of the 33rd Guam Legislature on my appointment as a resident member of Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority Board of Commissioners. I am humble at the opportunity to serve in this capacity as a trustee of the authority and strive for improvement to ensure that the authority is well maintained, financially secured, and operating at the best interest of those who serve current programs and services. In addition, I am supportive of the idea of establishing a resident advisory and board comprised of a representative from each public housing development as well as Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher Program. With this elected bodies we can work collectively on ways to address and continual needs of our stakeholders. I request you're approval of my nomination as member of GHURA board of commissioners. Thank you Madame Chairman.

<u>Senator Barnes:</u> Thank you Mr. Leon Guerrero. Ladies and gentlemen I do apologize, I did forget one gentlemen that I acknowledged earlier and I know that he has a letter endorsing one of our members. Consul General would you like to read it or are you hear for support. Support. I will append this to the committee report. Thank you sir. And at this time I also like to welcome and thank Senator Tommy Morrison of for uh joining us this morning at this time I will go ahead and start my brother and Speaker Won Pat do you have any questions or comments for the three appointed members to the GHURA board?

<u>Speaker Won Pat:</u> Thank you very much Madame Chair and just um excited to see of course these three individuals here and this hearing and testimony with sincerity with what it is that you want to do. I'm definitely, you know, really pleased to see that you truly are a reflection of our community and I think the fact that you're coming forward without any special interest or special agenda speaks very highly of you three so thank you very much for volunteering your time to be able to provide this type of service.



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Senator Barnes: Thank you. Brother Frank.

<u>Senator Frank Blas:</u> I to just want to say thank you very much for stepping forward and wanting to be a part of the board. It's an awesome responsibility especially with what you got to do. And um, I've gone through your packet and I've seen what you're able to provide. I thank you for your service.

**Senator Barnes:** Thank you.

<u>Senator Tony Ada:</u> Thank you Madame Chair just like to thank the three individuals that are here before us for their uh for accepting the governors invitation to be a part of this board of directos for Guam Housing and Urban Renwal Authority and I look forward tovoting on your confirmation and you have my full support. Thank you madame chair.

Senator Barnes: Thank you. Senator Brant McCreadie.

<u>Senator Brant McCreadie:</u> Thank you madame chair and I echo the sentiments of the previous speaker. Thank you for accepting the nominations from the Governor and uh I fully support the three of your nominations and I look forward to voting thank you.

Senator Barnes: Um Senator Dennis Rodriguez.

<u>Senator Dennis Rodriguez:</u> Thank you madame chair and again congratulations on your nominations. I know you all very well and I know the service the contribution you provide to the community and all in your different capacity now. And I know you are confident you will do the same as a board member. So thank you and congratulations

<u>Senator Barnes:</u> Senator Jimmy Espaldon. Comments, questions?

Senator Jimmy Espaldon: Thank you Madame Chair, I echo the same sentiments in terms of thanking you stepping up to the plate however I guess the comment I have is that your actually stepping into a very hot spot situation. I should say, I think everybody understands what has gone on and perhaps some of the criticism that the GHURA and the board has received in the recent past and of course we're dealing a lot with federal funds, we're doing a lot in policy in terms of how do we move forward with the housing situation the people live there the rules and regulations so in accepting it I hope, I guess remain confident that you go in with your eyes wide open to try to understand what the issues are, to really ask the tough questions to truly try to understand what the ramification may be on all of the decisions that you make in terms



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of not only helping the homeless but really in abiding by the regulations that govern a lot of the federal funding. So with that I want to congratulate you and uh but also offer you know that little bit of tidbit and advice to please be very mindful of all the eyes that will also be upon you but we thank you for your service. Thank you Madame Chair.

Senator Barnes: You're very welcome senator Espaldon. Senator Tommy.

<u>Senator Tommy Morrison:</u> Thank you Madame Chair and I want to congratulate on your appointment and I look forward to working with you and the hard working team at GHURA especially also want to thank Mrs. Dela Rosa I spent many years at DPR, thank you for your service up at the Department of Parks and recreation and also taking care of me up there. So I wish you all the best.

Senator Barnes: Si Yu'os Ma'åse senator Morrison, um, I just want to take this time right now as oversight chair housing to thank the three of you and the governor for appointing the three of you to this GHURA board. I want to share with you some notes about GHURA. I know that before some terms have expired I know that GHURA is one of the few boards that always, always had a quorum until the expiration of the previous members terms and the passing of the vice chair and I like at this time to at least extend my condolences to the family but more importantly to thank um Vice Chair Paulino, Lewis Paulino for the commitment and the hard work and the tireless nights that even amongst controversy this man continue to give from his heart and you know Mrs. Dela Rosa you talk about just coming here from the heart and not having any conflicts of interest that's what the board needs at this time. The vision that Mr. Paulino saw uh for many, many decades working closely with GHURA I know the opportunity to fill those shoes will be fitted very well because you folks have stepped up the plate and I know with your prior experience working with the community, working with the board, you both, I look at your resumes and I know that you both will give your very best. I know that Mr. Duenas and Mr. Santos are here on behalf of GHURA supporting this efforts. It hasn't been an easy journey this last couple of years but we know that uh with the full complement and the full boards complement as soon as we get these folks confirmed that we will continue to work closely tie up loose ends and continue to work the vision of what GHURA is to the listening audience out there. Yes GHURA is a 100% federally funded, we received grants from the federal government and we continue to move forward in providing the those in the indigent community housing for those who are homeless so again it is a my delightful honor and pleasure to thank you guys for



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stepping up to the plate and thanking the governor for bringing the appointments fast and you folks being here in the midst of a lot of hard work that needs to be done, extend my Si Yu'os Ma'ase so with that being I will call the appointments of Marie P. Dela Rosa, Annabelle M. Dancel, and Joseph M. Leon Guerrero the public hearing for the appointment to the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority Board of Directors publicly heard, again the record is open to the listening audience.
