SGRO, to serve as a Youth Member of the Guam Visitors Bureau Board of Directors, and whose appointment history is as follows:

- Appointed by I Maga'lahen Guåhan on January 9, 2015, to serve at the pleasure of the Governor;
- Appointment packet forwarded to I Liheslatura on January 14, 2015;
- Appointment packet forwarded to this committee for public consideration on Tuesday, February 24, 2015.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

This confirmation public hearing on the Committee of Municipal Affairs, Tourism, Housing and Historic Preservation has been called to order it's 9:04 am for the record and in accordance Pursuant to 5 GCA, Chapter 8, Subsection 8107 public hearing notices were sent out via email to all Senators and all

Ladies and gentlemen again this morning's agenda will consist of two items and the first one will be the appointment of Katarina R. Sgro who is the Youth Representative for the Guam Visitors Bureau's Board of Directors and right after that hopefully we won't take too long will be Bill 15-33 is introduced by myself which is 15-33 (COR) which is an Act to amend section 41006 or Article 10 chapter 4 of 12 GCA and to repeal section 41004A 4 and 5 of Article 10 Chapter 4 of Title 12 GCA. Ladies and gentleman this is relative to eliminating the requirement that the corporation appropriated fix amount of five hundred thousand of its annual operating revenue to ensure a reserved balance of the same and the beginning of each fiscal year and to amending the timing respecting the annual audit of the housing trust to coincide with that of the Guam Housing Corporation's annual audit as introduced by myself and we will go ahead and get started. I understand that there are several people who would like to provide oral testimony before we call up Miss Sgro up I would like to acknowledge the presence of our Chairman for GVB Mr. Mark Baldyga and also the General Manager Mr. Nate Denight. Good Morning. Thank you ladies and gentleman for being here. Sgro, Lea Quinitio and Andrea Araullo. Please you are more than welcome to sit up on the table. Please one on each side.

I have a lot of ideas.

Chairperson – you know what just saying that for the listening audience, I just want to say we can tap in to a lot of that creativity you have, and more importantly you're already doing it, and bringing it up to this level I think it's going to be amazing for the Guam Visitors Bureau. I want to tell you for the record that I will support your nomination, and I hope to get it on this next month's agenda so that we can have you actively make the official votes for the committee; and I will also note for the record that if anybody else wants to submit written testimony, they can do so by sending it to our address at 155 Hesler Place Hagatna, Guam, 96910 or they can fax us at 472-3400 or also send us a email through senator@tinamunabarnes.com; and earlier I gave a couple of other addresses through our office. With that, I'm going to say that the appointment of Miss Katarina Sgro has been publicly heard, and we'll go ahead and just take at least a minute just to reorganize for the next Bill coming up with Guam Housing Corporation; but thank everybody for being here.
