### COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

#### **I. OVERVIEW**

The Committee on Transportation, Infrastructure, Lands, Border Protection, Veterans' Affairs and Procurement convened a public hearing on February 12, 2015 at 9:00a.m. in *I Liheslaturan Guahan* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of the appointment Ms. Katherine C. Sgro to serve as a Member of the A. B. Won Pat International Airport Authority Board of Directors, whose appointment history is as follows:

- Appointment by Eddie Baza Calvo, *Governor*, On January 26, 2015
- Appointment packet forwarded to *I Liheslaturan Guahan* on January 26, 2015
- Appointment packet forwarded to this committee for public consideration on January 27, 2015.

#### **Public Notice Requirements**

Public Hearing notices were disseminated via email to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on Thursday, February 5, 2015 (5-Day Notice) and again on Tuesday, February 10, 2015 (48-Hour Notice).

#### **II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION**

**Chairman Ada:** Calls on the individuals to approach the table to give their testimony.

**Marcos Fong**, *UOG Board of Regents* (oral testimony) Testified in favor of Ms Sgro's confirmation. His most direct interaction with Ms. Sgro is at the University of Guam Board of Regents where she served as the chairperson at the time. She was serious in vetting the academic programs, tenure applications and any personal matters that came up in the committee. He believed that her leadership in the committee contributed to the quality of education at the university. She subsequently served as the vice chair of the Board of Regents which, Mr. Fong is currently on and filling her position as vice chair.

**Rudy Matanane**, *Mayor of Yigo* (oral testimony). Testified in favor of Ms Sgro's confirmation.

**Chairman Ada**: Is glad that Mr. Martinez gave a really good testimony from management personal from the Guam Airport Authority. He then asks the senators who are present, if they have any questions for this panel and then calls on Ms. Kathy Sgro to give her testimony.

**Katherine Sgro**, *Executive Vice President, Payless Supermarkets* (written testimony) please see attached.

**Sen. San Nicholas**: He likes how Ms. Sgro is involved in the community and able to think outside of the box. He notices the progression of Payless company around the island. Sen. San Nicholas was the chairman of the committee during the 32<sup>nd</sup> Guam Legislature and was involved in confirming some of the members who sit on the board. He believes Ms. Sgro will be an excellent compliment to the board. He appreciate the fact that she attended all those investment conferences and how to manage money.

**Sen. Underwood**: Talks about Ms. Sgro's experiences in the private sector as well as her services to the University of Guam. She asks what are some lessons that she had learn from the University of Guam that Ms. Sgro can bring to the Airport as they are two different entities.

**Ms. Sgro**: Describes that the university is a unique community and has a lot of moving parts. While there she faced challenges of finding financial resources and having to come to the legislature to campaign for what they felt would help sustain the university. One thing that intrigued her was how the faculty, administration, and the Board of Regents made a collaborative effort to get a national stamp of accreditation for the university. WASC accreditation team commented on how impressed they were with the boards' knowledge in regards to policies. Ms. Sgro would like to take that same mindset of a collaborative effort to the Guam Airport Authority.

**Sen. Aguon**: Applauds the governor for recommending you to the board. He believes there is something very special in a unique individual who strives to keep reaching out for more and it says a lot about your character as an individual. He thanks and supports her nomination.

**Sen. Morrison**: Thanks Ms. Sgro for her services she provides to the community like feeding the hungry for example and supports her nomination.

**Chairman Ada**: Has one question about the comments made when on one hand you can be a kind person, but on the other hand you can be a lioness and asked her to explain.

**Ms. Sgro:** She believes in the connectivity in the company or entity. It just doesn't make sense to have policy and procedures in place, if you don't have that connect to your employees and customers. She has no problem in recusing herself in situations where there may be a conflict of interest or addressing situations which may not adhere to the policies and procedures. She believes there has to be a good balance in running an organization.

**Chairman Ada:** Explains that Ms. Sgro's appointment comes at a good time, because the airport is going through a very large capital improvement project and supports her confirmation.

### **III. Findings and Recommendations**

The Committee on Transportation, Infrastructure, Lands, Border Protection, Veterans' Affairs and Procurement hereby favorably reports out the appointment of Ms. Katherine C. Sgro to serve as a Member of the A. B. Won Pat International Airport Authority Board of Directors with the recommendation **To Do Confirm**.
