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## COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

### **I. OVERVIEW**

The nomination of Kathrine B. Kakigi to serve as the Classified Government of Guam Employee Member to the Guam Banking and Insurance Board was made by Governor Edward J.B. Calvo on February 16, 2015. The nomination packet was received by the Office of Speaker Judith T. Won Pat, Ed.D., on February 20, 2015, and was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development on February 23, 2015.

The Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development held a public hearing on March 12, 2015, in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the hearing agenda was the nomination of Kathrine B. Kakigi to serve as the Classified Government of Guam Employee Member to the Guam Banking and Insurance Board. The hearing convened at 10:01 a.m. and was recessed at 11:57 a.m. The hearing reconvened at 2:03 p.m. and was adjourned at 5:35 p.m.

## II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

**Chairman Michael San Nicolas:** Okay, we are kind of pressed for time because of the Congressional Address this evening and we have other people who are going to be testifying, so let's expedite a little bit. **Mr. Art Illagan:** Thank you Senators, my name is Art Illagan and I'm the Insurance and Banking Commissioner for the Government of Guam, Rev and Tax. I am here in support of Kathrine Kakigi's nomination for Board Member of the Insurance and Banking Board. I have known Kathy for several years. She's a CPA and that's what we need on our Board. And my recommendation is to approve her nomination. That's it.

**Chairman Michael San Nicolas:** Thank you Mr. Illagan. Ms. Kakigi, if you can join us up here please. Just state your name for the record and you may begin anytime.

**Kathrine Kakigi:** My name is Kathrine Kakigi. I am an employee of the Department of Administration. Anything else?

**Chairman Michael San Nicolas:** Any kind of testimony you would like to offer with respect as to why you would like to serve on the Insurance and Banking Commission?

**Mr. Art Illagan:** Can I just say, this position...there is nine board members in the Banking Insurance Board. There's three bankers, three insurance personnel, one lawyer, one government employee, and myself. And that's what Kathy is here to fulfill, that position.

**Chairman Michael San Nicolas:** Okay.

**Kathrine Kakigi:** Okay, I would like to state that I am a long time government employee. That I have always been passionate about assisting our island. My...and it shows in our roots. My parents worked for the Department of Administration. My sister is now the senior vice president of UOG. My other sister is a teacher. And I also teach part time at the University of Guam. So, we're all a bunch of educators. And I'd like to...My strengths as far as a board member is a passion to help this island. And this is my, you know, this is my island. And my passion to protect the interest of our government. I have twenty years of experience in Government of Guam. And I've seen our government doing so many during the past few administrations. I've seen our finances going down. I've seen it improving and I'd like to see it continue that way and by being on the board for the Banking and Insurance Commission, I think I am excited and I think that it is an opportunity for me to protect the interest of the Government of Guam. So I humbly request your approval to have me on this Board. I feel blessed to be asked. Thank you.

**Chairman Michael San Nicolas:** Thank you very much Ms. Kakigi. Do any of my colleagues have questions for Ms. Kakigi or Mr. Illagan? Senator Ada.

**Senator Anthony Ada:** Thank you Mr. Chair. Kathy, you know you've done...we've met on many occasions.

**Kathrine Kakigi:** Yes.

**Senator Anthony Ada:** And it was a real pleasure to see you...

**Kathrine Kakigi:** Oh, thank you.

**Senator Anthony Ada:** ...Every time we met. And adding this to the work that you are currently doing, do you think that you'll still be able to juggle at home...

**Kathrine Kakigi:** Yes, I had a, didn't, when they first requested for me to be on the Board, I said, this was Friday, so I said let me digest it over the weekend because you know my job can be very stressful. You can all see my. And plus, you know, I do teach part time at the University, so at the same time I don't want to sacrifice the quality of work that I perform at the Department of Administration. No, but I did talk to Art and he did say they meet once every quarter. Maybe, if it was a more frequent meetings that were occurring, I would humbly just turn it down, you know, decline it. But I am confident that I will have the time to do the best that I could to represent the Government of Guam.

**Senator Anthony Ada:** Well, that's great to know. I looking forward to voting on you, your confirmation and you have my full support. Thank you Kathy.

**Kathrine Kakigi:** Thank you.

**Chairman Michael San Nicolas:** If no other senators have, I have no comments either Ms. Kakigi. Thank you very much for being willing to serve the people of Guam in this capacity.

**Kathrine Kakigi:** Alright.

**Chairman Michael San Nicolas:** The Insurance and Banking Commission is always a very interesting place to work with because you see a lot of our big financial industries in there

**Kathrine Kakigi:** That's right.

**Chairman Michael San Nicolas:** And with your expertise, I know you'd be able to contribute nicely as our government representative. So thank you for being willing in this responsibility.

**Kathrine Kakigi:** Thank you and I look forward to it. Thank you senators.

**Chairman Michael San Nicolas:** Alright. Thank you so much for making the time.

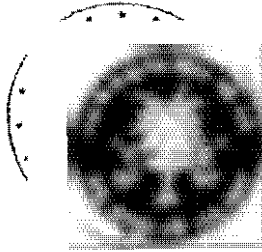

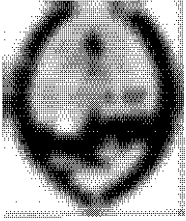
