COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. Overview

The Committee on Transportation, Infrastructure, Lands, Border Protection, Veterans' Affairs and Procurement convened a public hearing on April 17, 2015 at 9:00 a.m. in *I Liheslaturan Guahan* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of the appointment Mr. Lawrence Rivera to serve as a member of the Guam Land Use Commission, whose appointment history is as follows:

- Appointment by Eddie Baza Calvo, Governor, On April 7, 2015
- Appointment packet forwarded to I Liheslaturan Guahan on April 8, 2015
- Appointment packet forwarded to this committee for public consideration on April 8, 2015.

Public Notice Requirements

Public Hearing notices were disseminated via email to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on Monday, April 13, 2015 (5-Day Notice) and again on Wednesday, April 15, 2015 (48-Hour Notice).

The confirmation hearing for Mr. Lawrence Rivera commenced at 9:00 a.m.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

Chairman Ada: notes that the committee has received written testimony in favor of Mr. Rivera's confirmation from the Director of the Department of Land Management and recognizes two members of the Guam Land Use Commission, Ms. Tricee Limtiaco and Mr. John Arroyo.

Chairman Ada: calls those who have sign-up to give written testimony.

Tricee Limtiaco:, *Commissioner*, *Guam Land Use Commission* (oral testimony): She starts by staying she is currently a commissioner on the Guam Land Use Commission (GLUC) and has served on the commission for the last two years. She goes on to say in those two years she has worked closely with Mr. Rivera, who participates in all the meetings, whether it's technical meetings or the actual hearings. She says that Mr. Rivera conducts himself with the up-most

professionalism and has never shied away from making hard decisions. Ms. Limitaco says, she enjoys working with Mr. Rivera and has seen on some occasions, Mr. Rivera recuse himself from any issues that came before the commission. She finishes by saying she is there for support and hopes the committee will consider her reappointment.

Chairman Ada: Then calls on Mr. Rivera to give his testimony.

Mr. Lawrence Rivera, *appointee* (oral testimony): He states the reason why he is here today for his re-appointment to continue sitting on the GLUC. This would be Mr. Rivera's 4th public hearing for confirmation since April 2006 and most recent appointed in 2013 from Governor Calvo to be the Chairman of GLUC. He is here before the senators to serve as a commissioner again for the GLUC. Mr. Rivera tries his best to do a lot of work by reading binders and having open discussions with each other as well as working with the community. He humbly asks and for the senators support for his re-appointment.

Chairman Ada: He knows Mr. Rivera has been sitting on the board for quite awhile and most of his experience has been in the field of procurement as stated in his resume. Chairman Ada asks Mr. Rivera what does he bring to the GLUC.

Mr. Rivera: As for his experience, he did retire from the Government of Guam as the supply management administrator. He handled a lot of bids and proposals for professional services such as construction and architect engineers. His knowledge is not only in procurement, but as well as professional and institutional knowledge. Mr. River understands the GLUC rules and regulations through his years of experience with the commission. He works with public and private agencies, communities, and mayors offices when dealing with concerns by the public or community. Mr. Rivera has a feel for the people and takes into account the best decision for the people.

Senator Respicio: He starts by thanking Mr. Rivera for her continued willingness to serve the people in this capacity. He goes on to say that he wants to focus on the testimony written in support by the Director of the Department of Land Management. He says that Director Borja keened in on individual attributes and the strengths brought to the GLUC. The Director recognizes Mr. Rivera's ability to pay keen attention to detail, able to formulate appropriate responses to unique concerns, all with focused thought processes during deliberations of projects with intense levels of complexity. Mr. Borja also points out that Mr. Rivera is passionate. He is passionate to serve in this capacity as the commissioner. Senator Respicio asked Mr. Rivera if he can recall a particular experience where he had to make a difficult decision.

Mr. Rivera: There was a project where an individual built a duplex home and they wanted a boundary or a set back. The applicant was requesting to have the boundary of the property the wall of the duplex. The commission rejected or disapproved the request, because the commission found unacceptable. Mr. Rivera explains that other instances are requesting commercial buildings in a R1 Zone for a mom and pop store. He asked the applicant if they, can get support from the mayors counsel or apply under a conditional use. Mr. Rivera says the commission will go around and inspect those applicants who are under a conditional use permit to make sure they

are in compliance with the terms. The commission will approve their re-zoning application after about 10 years, once the applicant has shown truthfulness of the conditional use terms. Mr. Rivera and the commission rely on the position statement from other agencies, if they support the project.

Senator Rodriguez: He starts by congratulating Mr. Rivera on his reappointment and all the commission does for the community. He asked both Ms. Bathan and Mr. Rivera, how do they view the legislature's process doing spot zoning.

Mr. Rivera: He says the advantage of having spot zoning go through the process is it involves regulatory agencies which make up the application review committee as well as input from the public. This allows for recommendation for approval or disapproval by the committee. The GLUC do disapprove zoning projects especially when a commercial zone is requested in a community. Mr. Rivera explains that sometimes applicants will go to the legislature, because they were disapproved by the GLUC. He feels that it should go through the GLUC process.

Senator Morrison: He starts thanking Ms. Bathan for wanting to maintain the institutional knowledge at the GLUC. He goes on to say that he echoes the concerns made by Senator Rodriguez. He then says as the former Director at the Bureau of Statistics and Plans, he had to work closely with technical folks who sat on the application review committee. It was always a challenge even at that end, he says. He goes on to say that there was also a time when a recommendation was made to the body, from the GLUC to suspend applications that would come before the body and it was respected at that time. He then asks, should there be a mechanism in place that prior to any request at the Legislature, it must still go through the GLUC?

Mr. Rivera: He does feel it should go through the review committee. Mr. Rivera respects that and relies on a lot of decisions that has been made through those regulatory agencies. The pros and cons of the project is weighed when it goes through the process. It allows people to testify in support or not in regards to the project.

Senator Morrison: He goes on to say that he knows the ARC has been very cautious of the government land patterns and protecting our resources. He then says that when the requests come to his office, he asks them if they have first gone through the proper process. Senator Morrison says that he always sends them back because of his prior experience with the Bureau of Statistics and Plans. He understands there is a Northern and Central land use plan that is in place to be used as a guide for making decisions. Senator Morrison asked, if they are familiar with that plan.

Mr. Rivera: He is not familiar with this plan from the top of his head. He explains their Chief Planner would be the one familiar with it. The planner does the analysis and makes recommendations to the commission. According to Mr. Rivera the commission lacks a master plan and that it would be nice to have one.

Senator Morrison: Suggest working with Bureau of Statistics and Plans to view the plan, which is really a guideline to help with decision making. He pledges his full support for the nominee.

Chairman Ada: Chairman Ada calls this public hearing adjourned.

III. Findings and Recommendations

The Committee on Transportation, Infrastructure, Lands, Border Protection, Veterans' Affairs and Procurement hereby favorably reports out the appointment of **Mr. Lawrence Rivera** to serve as a Member of the Guam Land Use Commission with the recommendation to do confirm.






