## COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

### I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Transportation, Infrastructure, Lands, Border Protection, Veterans' Affairs and Procurement convened a public hearing on July 13, 2015 at 1:00 p.m. in *I Liheslaturan Guahan* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of the appointment of Mr. Martin J. Gerber to serve as a Member of the A. B. Won Pat International Airport Authority Board of Directors, whose appointment history is as follows:

- Appointment by Eddie Baza Calvo, Governor, On May 13, 2015
- Appointment packet forwarded to I Liheslaturan Guahan on May 18, 2015
- Appointment packet forwarded to this committee for public consideration on May 19, 2015.

Public Hearing notices were disseminated via email to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on Monday, July 6, 2015 (5-Day Notice) and again on Thursday, July 9, 2015 (48-Hour Notice).

The confirmation hearing for Mr. Gerber commenced at 1:00 p.m.

## II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

Chairman Ada calls on the individuals to approach the table to give their testimony.

**Dave Alcorn** (oral testimony): Mr. Alcorn gives his support for Mr. Martin J. Gerber. He says that he felt it important to tell the committee what he knows of the individual. Mr. Gerber has been a 25-year friend, he is one of those friends you have coffee with and share information with. He says that over the span of their friendship he has found Mr. Gerber to go from very humble beginnings to this real-estate moguf. He then says that Mr. Gerber has 12 years experience on the Airport Board of Directors and that has great value to the airport and the

community. A board member is seen as a business partner, it is percentages and decisions you make to move it forward. That is to include things on the radar that are unforeseen.

He goes on to say that Mr. Gerber has been instrumental on the Airport Board, as his testimony will speak for himself. It is important that this venue will allow for helpful dialogue and insight to questions that the panel may have. He then says that he has watched the venue before and has been a little concerned that things don't move quickly enough. A board member is an elected thing personally, when you decide you'll go to work, but you don't get paid, it takes away from regular business activity, and that is what is not evaluated in all agencies. He finishes by saying that it is a lot of work and time spent and that he fully supports Mr. Gerber and his renomination.

**Senator Aguon:** He thanks Mr. Alcorn for his support of the appointee. He continues by saying in defense for the institution of the legislative body and the confirmation process, one of the responsibilities that they have is questioning the qualifications initially and the second is the suitability of that individual to serve at that capacity. Whether it is conflict of interest and getting reassurance at the confirmation hearing that the individual will remove himself/herself form deliberation. If it goes beyond that, he then says in defense for the legislature and any individual that may have not gotten sufficient support, it is perhaps information that was being circulated and was not clarified or members of the body just felt at that time the individual may not have been suitable to serve in that capacity.

Senator Aguon goes on to say that he brings the issue up because there was an individual who did not garnish sufficient support a few legislatures back. There were comments made that if this individual was not appointed that particular board, he would have been more than suitable for any other board in the Government of Guam. He says that he had to make that statement in defense of the institution itself, not any particular Senator's voting but understanding the process and deliberation they take on ensuring and assuring the people of Guam that these individuals will always have the best interest of the organization and the people of Guam. He then finishes by saying that Mr. Alcorn's testimony endorsing the individuals is reflective of that.

Chairperson Ada then calls the appointee for his testimony.

**Martin J. Gerber**, *Appointee* (written testimony): Mr. Gerber reads his testimony.

Chairperson Ada opens the panel for questions.

**Senator Respicio:** He goes on to echo the Chairperson's sentiments in thanking Mr. Gerber for accepting the Governor's appointment to the GIAA Board of Directors. He then thanks Mr. Gerber for his 15 years of service on the board and finishes by saying he is in support of his confirmation.

**Senator Aguon:** He starts by thanking Mr. Gerber for accepting the opportunity to serve in the same capacity. He states that Mr. Gerber has taken the airport through great strides in the course of his service. He then goes on to echo what Mr. Alcorn has said, he hit on an important point, time is taken from his personal business and given to the people of Guam. That is an important factor when it comes to public service. Senator Aguon says for him to give as much time to the GIAA Board of Directors and

still be committed to running a successful business, he commends him and thanks Mr. Gerber for his service.

**Senator V. Anthony Ada:** He starts by thanking him for accepting the Governor's re-nomination. He says that he was looking at the attendance report and says this is a great guidance for all boards to follow and submit to the Legislature when they come up for re-confirmation. Senator Ada says it is important to know that board members are attending the meetings, so they know what is going on and the people know that they are attending. He ends by saying Mr. Gerber has his support.

**Senator Torres:** She starts by saying that Mr. Gerber is one of the most senior members of the board. She then asks him, with his 15 years of service on the board, at what percentile is the airport on the pay scale?

**Mr. Gerber:** He responds by saying the airport is at the 15 percentile.

**Senator Torres:** She then says in looking at the staffing levels, there are clearly competitive wages; she gives the Executive Director as an example. There have been some difficulties with the expansion office and whether the office still has its stance. She continues with asking Mr. Gerber if the board is now at a point where they can transition to where more of the experts are on permanent salary positions and the expansion office is just an example. She asks Mr. Gerber is that is something that he would be amenable to?

**Mr. Gerber:** He responds by saying they should analyze or take a look at the consultants in the expansion office and where we can get the people to fit into positions with a higher pay that would attract such individuals.

**Senator Torres:** She goes on to say that one of the strengths of the airport and the testament to why he is important in the composite of the board, is having that institutional knowledge. She goes on to say that maybe its time to move away from contractors, within reason and entrust that to permanent staff. This is an opportunity with permanent fixes coming into play, with the opening of the second runway and expansion of the runway. The airport will now be utilizing its space and is one of the shining agencies of the government. She ends by thanking him for his commitment to the airport and accepting the renomination.

**Senator Barnes:** She starts by thanking the Governor for the nomination and Mr. Gerber for his continued service to the GIAA Board of Directors. She then thanks Mr. Sobti for being in the audience and showing support and to the spouses as well. Senator Barnes then thanks Mr. Gerber for his contributions both to the airport board and to the community. She then thanks him for the not stopping his support for the airport. The immigration line could be an issue of discussion but she then says that she knows that is an issue that is being looked at by the airport. For her to wait in line, it took 20 minutes, she then asked Mr. Gerber if that issue could again be looked at. She ends by saying Mr. Gerber has her full support.

**Vice-Speaker Cruz:** He starts by mentioning that the immigration line being long was an issue that he has as well and was glad to hear that TSA would be moving to the back of the house. He then makes references to other airports that are able to process more people per hour. To take longer than 28 minutes

to get through the line at the airport just gives a bad first impression. Vice-Speaker then makes a reference about the bathrooms being atrocious and the Board members enduring his early morning and late night calls. He mentions that he was glad to hear in Mr. Gerber's testimony that, that issue is being addressed. He then mentions another issue that should be address in the audit, which the auditor stated that they were not able to access conflict of interest statements and procedures. He then asks that the issue be addressed as soon as possible.

**Senator Blas:** He starts by saying he is glad the Governor saw fit to re-appoint Mr. Gerber and is confident in his ability to serve. Senator Blas then asks the question, what does he see as something that can be done quickly, efficiently and inexpensively to improve the service here on Guam?

**Mr. Gerber:** He mentions there are a number of ongoing projects and he thinks it will answer many of the problems that he has seen. He gives an example of the cleanliness and functions of the restrooms. Mr. Gerber then says that the other thing he would like to take care of is the immigration line, he mentions that the issue has been ongoing on many different levels. The hospitability program, which assists travelers who are non-English speaking to fill out forms, will help move the line quicker.

Chairperson Ada: He starts by saying he does recognize and commend all the improvements being made to the airport facilities itself and attracting different international airlines. However, he mentions that he finds it ironic that they are able to attract and accommodate all these different airlines, but a company like Star Alliance, who is looking to setup shop can't get what they need. He then goes to say that he is happy that capital improvements are being done to the airport, because first impressions are very important. However, once outside the facilities, the impressions are busses lining up, exhaust fumes everywhere, it is one of those things where all these things are done but it is the little things that take it down. Chairperson Ada then asks for comments on the domestic airline that is trying to setup shop and on the ground transportation.

**Mr. Gerber:** He responds by saying the domestic airline, there is a project to build an inter-island passenger facility, which will be adjacent to the old terminal. The reason is that certain inspections are not required and allows for a more efficient travel. He then goes into Star Alliance saying, he has heard they are trying to do business on Guam but is unsure of the specifics. However, Mr. Gerber says that in discussions with other airlines, that if they can come to Guam, they could possible service Guam, Saipan, Rota and Tinian. He then says the board is trying to attract airlines to service that route.

He continues that the ground transportation, the issue has been brought to management's attention. Mr. Gerber says that being at other airports, the ground transportation seems to flow easier and a solution is being drafted to fix that issue. He goes on to say whether it is moving the buses to a different area, to allow for better traffic flow, it depends on management's response.

**Senator Torres:** She mentions that the garage expansion is to compensate for the ground transportation services. However, that is based on the expansion, if it has not changed. She goes on to mention that the signage for the airport is inadequate, and that she has mentioned that to DPW at their budget hearing. There have been complaints about improper signage from Marine Drive and people getting lost going to the airport. She then says that DPW said they would look into the matter but that she would like the Board to look into that, if that the airport could front the cost for those entrance routes. She asks that the matter get looked at and perhaps be a contribution to the island from the airport.

Chairperson Ada: He goes on to say that the latest issue of bonds for the facilities was possible and was the first one since Duty Free had come in. So it has been some time since capital has been put in to upgrade the facility. However he says the airport still owns a lot of the real estate up there and he had asked for a copy of the master plan, he then asks Mr. Gerber to elaborate on that. So what is the airport looking at in terms of developing that real estate? He goes to say that he has heard arguments on the law about the determination of need and the 5-year restriction is a real obstacle. He ends by asking what he foresees the airport doing with all that real estate.

**Mr. Gerber:** He responds that FAA has invested into property west of the intergraded air cargo facility for more attraction and for aeronautical uses, if not that it would go to non-aeronautical uses. He goes to say that the homes in that area have been removed, so the property is about ready for development. It may be more warehouses but there has been talk about a hotel. He then goes on to say that as far as the requirements, he sees no problem with it. Land for aeronautical use can perhaps develop something that would make it easier, since the uses have already been identified, similar to the utilities. He ends by saying that other than that the requirements are sufficient and should not hamper the airport's development.

**Chairperson Ada**: He asks Mr. Gerber if the existing law that requires legislative approval for long-term leases is an obstacle?

**Mr. Gerber:** He responds, no sir.

Chairperson Ada ends the confirmation hearing for Mr. Gerber.



Hafa Adai Senator Ada:

Thank you to the Committee on Transportation for this hearing on my re-appointment to the A. B. Won Pat International Airport Authority, Guam (GIAA) Board of Directors.

As an active board member for the past fifteen years, the Airport has certainly been challenging and eventful. During my tenure with the Board over \$300 million in improvements has been invested into the Main Terminal, the airfield and taxiways and adjoining airport properties. I have personally evolved with airport development and currently serve as Vice Chairman of the Board and the Chairman on the Capital Improvement Program subcommittee.

Currently, the Airport has embarked on a \$169M capital improvement program funded by our 2013 General Revenue Bonds. Under this program over 20 primary and secondary priority projects are in varying stages of construction. Of particular significance is the International Arrivals Corridor which would address the unfunded mandate imposed by TSA post 9-11 which forced us to cut our concourse in half to ensure international arrivals are separated from TSA screened passengers. I am particularly anxious to see this project through, having started on the Board in 2001, while TSA imposed the separation of passengers requirement.

I am also very focused on a project high on the list of customer service priorities - the complete renovation and upgrade of terminal restrooms. Renovation to restrooms has begun on six sets of restrooms on the public and secured areas of the terminal.

In terms of the Airport's Master Plan during my tenure with the Board, I have been very focused on safety and security, and adding value to operating at the Airport and surrounding areas. We've seen development in the Airport's Tiyan Business and











Industrial Park, with the investment of over \$30M in private construction for DHL, Triple B, CTSI, the Guam International Integrated Cargo Building, and the MSA Warehouses. We've hurdled through FAA regulations in regard to properties required for the Tiyan parkway and successfully worked with DPW and their federal counterparts, the Federal Highway Agency to open Phase I.

We're well into regaining terminal space in our ticket counter lobbies with the inline baggage system that would transfer TSA inspection equipment to the back of the house.

We have extended our runways, now have a parallel taxiway and look forward to the official opening of our primary extended runway on July 27, 2015.

Also of significance is the terminal repainting project due for completion in two months. This is the first substantial painting project since the terminal expansion completion in 1996, nearly 20 years ago.

I have had many a good experience during my terms on the GIAA Board. Serving the people of Guam in this capacity has been an immense honor; one that I would like to continue with my reappointment to the GIAA Board of Directors.




