COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Transportation, Infrastructure, Lands, Border Protection, Veterans' Affairs and Procurement convened a public hearing on January 26, 2016 at 9:00a.m. in *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of the appointment **Mr. Michael A. Pangelinan** to serve as a *Community At-large Member* of the **Public Utilities Commission**, whose appointment history is as follows:

- Appointment by Eddie Baza Calvo, *Governor*, On December 21, 2015;
- Appointment packet forwarded to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* on December 22, 2015;
- Appointment packet forwarded to this committee for public consideration on December 31, 2015.

Public Notice Requirements

Public Hearing notices were disseminated via email to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on Tuesday, January 19, 2016 (5-Day Notice) and again on Friday, January 22, 2016 (48-Hour Notice).

The public hearing was Called-to-Order at 9:00am.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

Chairman Ada: Calls the public hearing to order at 9:00am and points out that Mr. Pangelinan has completed serving 9 years in the PUC and he's up for re-appointment. He then calls forward Mr. Fred Horecky and Mr. Michael A. Pangelinan to provide their testimonies.

Frederick Horecky, Legal Counsel for PUC Member (written and oral testimony): He starts by saying that Mr. Pangelinan is a valuable asset to PUC especially with his expertise in contract reviews regarding procurement matters. He explains that Mr. Pangelinan looks at contracts with the utility agencies and reviews its function for compliance with procurement laws for ensuring the provisions protect the interest of the people of Guam. Mr. Horecky believes Mr. Pangelinan has been very helpful with issues that arise under contracts and as well as he makes sure that the PUC is in compliance with procurement laws. Mr. Pangelinan has been very aware about rate matters to make sure it is reasonable and justified in particular to bond issuances. Mr. Horecky urges the senators to confirm his appointment because the PUC needs him on the commission.

Michael A. Pangelinan, *appointee and member of PUC* (Oral testimony):

He starts off by requesting to serve on the PUC and is his second nomination for reappointment. He still has a lot to learn about rate-making and regulations. Mr. Pangelinan believes it is difficult to find people that would want to take the task of sitting on the PUC because of the technical industry materials that need to be digested as well the decisions that have to be made in changing rates. He feels no matter what decisions are made in regards to rate changes it will always upset some segment of the community. Mr. Pangelinan says he is a fair-minded person and tries to look at all sides of an issue before a decision is made when it comes to rates. His experience and educational background allows him to contribute to the PUC. The PUC allows him to advance his technical knowledge in utility rates and operations. Whenever he is asked by the island leaders to serve the community, if possible he always agreed to do it.

Chairman Ada: He has reviewed the PUC minutes in the last 6 years and found that Mr. Pangelinan has an 88% attendance rate (absent 10 out of a total of 75 meetings). Chairman Ada also noted that Mr. Pangelinan had to recuse himself from 4 meetings because of a conflict of interest. He asked Mr. Pangelinan does he anticipate recusing himself more often given that his law firm has grown .

Mr. Pangelinan: He says that is correct in regards to recusing himself about 4 times when there was a conflict between his law firm and the PUC. Mr. Pangelinan does not think he will be having to recuse himself any more frequently than he has in the past. One reason for this he is no longer legal counsel for GEDA. He explains the only conflicts that will arise if any, is from the telecommunications side, which he is still legal counsel for. Mr. Pangelinan feels the conflict of interest with his law firm will not increase, but if anything will more than likely remain the same.

Chairman Ada: He explained to Mr. Pangelinan that his term expired on November 2015, but is able to still sit on the commission due to the 90 days plus 3 legislative day statute. That will take you up to about May of 2016 according Chairman Ada. He anticipates reporting out Mr. Pangelinan's nomination on the February 2016 session.

Senator Aguon: He would like to thank Mr. Pangelinan for wanting to continue to serve the community. Senator Aguon asked Mr. Pangelinan what is his position in regards to the collaboration between GPA and private business partners when it comes to renewable energy.

Mr. Pangelinan: He believes that promoting and increasing the availability of renewable energies and getting the community to rally behind it, is a very important goal. The relationship between GPA and renewable energy businesses can have its growing pains at times because of GPA's infrastructure can not fully accommodate the new technology. Right now there dealing with the net metering system and determining what is the long-term plans. The commission has had a year or two of building the industry of net metering. He explains that just more recently

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new technology has been developed to make consumer appliances and electrical devices more efficient is out there in the market. It is being installed and the question is are the smart meters capable of calculating the credit that should be paid to the costumers. This is something that GPA has to be able to adjust and adapt to according to Mr. Pangelinan.

Senator Aguon: He appreciates Mr. Pangelinan's perspective on this subject. He has seen a tremendous growth in the renewable energy with the private sector partners and the Guam Power Authority. The other issue he would like to bring up is there an ongoing effort in terms of GPA acquiring extra support from the federal government when it comes to the military build up.

Mr. Pangelinan: He doesn't recall any discussion about acquiring federal funds, but there have been discussions on improving the power system to deal with some of the recent problems such as the loss of capacity. They just had a workshop where GPA rolled out their plans to rehabilitate some power plants that have been moth balled over the past several years in Dededo and Yigo according to Mr. Pangelinan.

Senator Aguon: He brings up the issue only because if there is an incremental impact to the community due to the military build up then it shall be incorporated into the equation. He was wondering if the PUC has acquired federal funding for the marines relocating to Guam. He would like to close by thanking Mr. Pangelinan for all his hard work and he has his support.

Senator Barnes: She thanks Mr. Pangelinan for his service to the PUC and has her support for his reappointment.

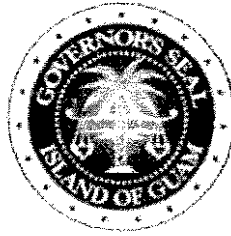
Chairman Ada: Closes out Mr. Pangelinan's confirmation hearing as being dully heard.

Dear Chairman Ada:

I am submitting this written testimony in support of the reappointment of Michael A. Pangelinan as a Commissioner to the Public Utilities Commission [PUC].

Mr. Pangelinan began his service as a Commissioner on December 23, 2008. He has now been reappointed again to serve for a second term.

As Legal Counsel to the Commission, I have had the opportunity and pleasure to work closely with Mr. Pangelinan regarding Commission matters over the past six years. Mr. Pangelinan has carried out his duties with the Commission with dedication and attentiveness. He is a hardworking Commissioner. He has faithfully attended Commission meetings and has participated in Commission workshops.

Mr. Pangelinan has served as a Commissioner representing the Community at Large. As a practicing attorney, Mr. Pangelinan brings a particularly useful perspective to Commission proceedings. He is very familiar with Government of Guam procurement and contracting procedures. Under its contract review function, the PUC is required to review the prudence and necessity of larger contract expenditures by the utilities.

During Commission meetings, Commissioner Pangelinan has made valuable contributions concerning contract provisions of the utility contracts and compliance with procurement requirements. He has brought the same level of scrutiny to the PUC's own

internal hiring of consultants to ensure that it complies with all statutory and procurement requirements.

He has also carefully scrutinized whether utility expenditures are necessary and in the interest of ratepayers. With respect to bond funds, he has questioned whether the utilities need the full amounts requested, in light of the fact that bond funds for some projects go unspent for a number of years.

Commissioner Pangelinan has carried out his PUC duties in a committed and devoted manner. Despite being a busy professional, he has worked diligently on an ongoing basis to address pending PUC matters and to ensure that the Commission's work is done in a timely manner. Mr. Pangelinan's reappointment to the Commission is essential to ensure that the Commission continues to effectively set rates and carry out its utility regulatory functions. I urge the members of the Committee to support the reappointment of Mr. Pangelinan as a Commissioner to the Public Utilities Commission. Thank you for your consideration of this testimony.
