- Appointed by Governor Edward J.B. Calvo on September 13, 2016.
- Appointment packet forwarded to *I Liheslatura* on September 14, 2016;
- Appointment packet forwarded to this committee for public consideration on September 15, 2016.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

The public hearing was Called-to-Order at 2:05PM.

The Executive Appointment of Ms. Nadine T. Cepeda as a Member of the Guam Board of Allied Health Examiners, Licensed Mental Health Counselor; and

Executive Appointment of Mr. Ray Tajalle as a Member of the Guam Board of Allied Health Examiner Physician Assistant Representative.

We also her on **Bill No.385-33 (COR)** - An act to add a new article 7, § 77701-77710, to division 2 of chapter 77, title 12, Guam Code Annotated, relative to establishing the Guam Multi-Purpose Community Stadium Complex Commission.



I would like to recognize the author of that legislation thank you for being here Senator Mary Torres go ahead and start in the appointments and I would like to call those who had sign up to testifies in favor of Ms. Nadine Cepeda, Mr. Vincent Pereda, Ms. Liza Baza, Ms. Jamie Pangelinan, and Ms. Evageline Cepeda, Who ever wishes to go first.

Rodriguez, Jr. – Thank you very much Evangeline I should say tha, were done I think she said everything that she needs to say so thank you very much Vangie so before that I just want to recognize former vise speaker Mr. Ted Nelson thank you very much sir for being here also I want to recognize Mrs. Serafina Cepeda thank you very much for being a mother of Ms. Nadine.

Vincent Pereda – Thank you Senator I think I don't need to testifies because she said it all but I would like to give a few comment to my whole testimony. My name is Vincent Pereda I currently serve as a Board Member of Guam Board of Allied Health and im also the Secretary of the Board I serve down this board ever since of being appointed by Gov. Felix Camacho and I serve continuously on these board over the past several years when the passage of public law 32-054 these unable the license profession to expand its discipline to wear these and now there's three types of counselor we have License Professional Counselors, License Mental Health Counselors, and License Marriage and Family Therapy's and now with these also the law provide and two additional members of these board and I've been here to remember the concealing profession for several years its been choir a very typical choir the counselor represent the largest discipline of Guam Board of Allied Health Examiner we license twelve professional disciplines witch the LPC concealing license insurance represent about the eighty people who we license in annual basis I mean semiannual basis currently this is the year that we renew the licenses for the next two years and being the only board member that's licensing I had to work tediously in renewing what the probably come up over seventy licenses so I kindly welcome Nadine's addition to the board and I can tell you she will be put to work as soon as she report I've known Nadine ever since she works in mental health and I follow her carrier from mental health to superior court while works prefer as a contract counselor and also now in the department of education I've know her to be a councilmen professional who tediously work at her job working in her client invidious capacities because of her professionalism I have no dough that she will be a Guam Board of Allied Health and I strongly indorse her candidacy. Ovita Perez - Good afternoon congratulation and thank you for serving us again the election is over so congratulation again. Written testimony.

Rodriguez, Jr. – Thank you very much, other anyone else who wish to testify on Ms. Cepeda's confirmation if not I'm going to call Ms. Cepeda, thank you very much and good afternoon thank you for being here Congratulation on your appointment to the Guam Board of Allied Health Examiners this is a big board and your collage you would know it's a lot of issues not just the discipline but in your discipline a lot of difference discipline so I really look forward to you serving on that board and I'm giving opportunity now to make a statement and all that.

Nadine T. Cepeda – Thank you honorable chairperson Senator Rodriguez and honorable Senator Mary Torres this is my opportunity I am very committed to giving back to our community there's an diary need that we still not enough we are the largest 70 plus therapy's in clear now in my private practice I have to turn the people away just because I need to provide quality care one of my things that I bring to the department of education is a background being in 15 years at behavioral health that I am now building capacity and stunning initiative called school base behavior health there's clearly need and not enough people in these area to help our people here, I am not saying that our community is unhealthy but we all can be healthier and that's start what we need so we always continue work on myself so I can't teach somebody if I'm not practicing what I teach and so still in my life commitments and being involved in all these organization coz I feel that I can be all change and we talk about therapy's that what it is it change I want to start to myself to make that change and so I'm actually taking interns from the masters program or actually school counselors because we don't have enough to work under my licensure clean provide clinical supervision working closely and Annie's is no longer clinical administrator and she was my actually works many years and learned a lot under her I actually



now spit it out under her capacity under working very closely because you may not know is one of every five students is actually have symptoms or have a mental illness, clearly that's alarming so alarming that their going to come to School to learn their coming with all kinds of an emotional and social issues that come in and academics will be secondary and you would think academics they would come in and think so the works begins its building and pounding and pounding one day at the time. But I know change can happen so part of these is an opportunity and also make a change, your right these board is going to be the system I mean its really the system but I'm young and I'm again (audible) I'm hoping that I can do the best and you think I do I will always be committed and so I would like to make a change so thank you.

Senator Dennis G. Rodriguez, Jr. – Thank you very much Senator Torres you have any questions?

Senator Marry Torres – Ms. Cepeda your record is very admirable but I think what is equally admirable is the support that you brought with you today and I rarely participated in the public hearing were it was delight to listen to your family members speak of you the way they did and makes me wish that I had a sister for its like issue, but I'm a you talk about quality care and I think that very critical and I want to ask you what you think about these notion that been circulating and discuss on the several occasion with regard to the licensure professional who would not graduate from the accredited in US Institution or who currently hold the licenses and other than US jurisdiction I ask these question because we have a shortage witch is professionals in Guam and we also rely in very much care in outside Guam with our closes neighbors Philippines for examples so we are utilizing insurance money to funds those treatments but what is your thoughts upon the inclusion to professional to practice on Guam and be license on Guam who are other that from US accredited schools or who currently hold non US board certifications.

Nadine T. Cepeda – You know I think that really (inaudible), however I just came back my mom has been going true medical issues and truthfully its not to put anyone down because we all do the school I really strongly hold if we go true it the standard it place that standards and the standards is you have to meet the requirements so when you kind of comparing it to the different country its kind of difficult even with the course work the type of training so I know I'm going to speak because I'm not a medical doctor nor or I'm misleading to anybody misinforming but part of that standard is giving the practice let's just say of being an empty position like the psychiatrist you would have to do the (inaudible) research so that school in the Philippine and then part of the standard is they have to do a residency in soil and that truly I always say that education is the frame work that the trainee makes the difference and with that training you can do a lot, because you can do academically you can be academically outstanding and performs A's but you cannot translated into application and that's what you treat people so I'm going to be very careful and you ask me then not just my opinion to having people in the different country and the US that standard and there's always a shortage of Nurses, Doctors, OTPT there is the national shortage when it comes to the medical and knowing that people, I think when they you



put standards that everything to make sure that their meeting the standards so that's my comments about that.

Senator Mary Torres – And I appreciate your honesty, Thank you.

Senator Dennis G. Rodriguez, Jr. – Thank you very much Senator, again congratulation but we wanted to schedule earlier but you're off island right? But were going to ensure that these will be part of the agenda next week section could you confirmed so we could start working on the board.

Nadine T. Cepeda – Ok thank you.

Senator Dennis G. Rodriguez, Jr. – But I do want to but I was speaking in the chair board a few weeks ago and one of the things I've been trying to do was really kind of reform and how we can help the board even more you know there it's like I said there a lot of discipline on these board but with you addition to the board hopefully we can get some new thoughts and there let see if how can move these so it can be more efficient specially with the licensing office I know that the board and the social work has already looking at and doing something different in terms of making the test online and working true that the process and one of the examiners the allied health board of examiners there is something that would be able to address as well, so I look forward to working with you.




