COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

The nomination of Renie A. Llaneta to serve as a member to the Alcohol Beverage Control Board, for a term of two (2) years, was made by Governor Edward J.B. Calvo on October 10, 2016. The nomination package was received by the Office of Speaker Judith T. Won Pat, Ed.D., on October 11, 2016, and was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development on October 12, 2016.

The Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development held a legislative hearing on November 7, 2016, in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the agenda was the nomination of Mr. Llaneta. The hearing convened at 9:11 a.m. and was adjourned at 10:33 a.m.

II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

**Please note that the dialogue which took place included Mr. Renie Llaneta, Ms. Belinda Mejia, and Ms. Geraldine Leon Guerrero, all nominees to the Alcohol Beverage Control Board.*

Chairman Michael San Nicolas convened the hearing on the nominations of Mr. Renie Llaneta, Ms. Belinda Mejia, and Ms. Geraldine Leon Guerrero. He yielded the floor to Mr. Llaneta and Ms. Mejia, in their capacities as current members, for opening statements.

Mr. Llaneta spoke about his experience serving on the Board as a member and as chairman. He stated that the biggest achievement of the Board was the implementation of the Alcohol Server Training Program.

Ms. Mejia spoke about her experience on the Board. She mentioned that they have worked hard to ensure quorum. She agreed with Mr. Llaneta that the implementation of the Alcohol Server Training Program was the greatest accomplishment.

Chairman San Nicolas asked about the enforcement challenges for the Board.

Mr. Llaneta stated the problem has always been the shortage of personnel and that the focus was mainly on administrative duties and not enforcement. He mentioned that the Department of Revenue and Taxation recently hired additional employees. Mr. Llaneta stated that the current staff is inadequate to properly enforce the regulations. He recommended that more visibility would help encourage businesses to follow the rules and regulations

Ms. Mejia stated that the Board only has three inspectors who have no government-issued mobile telephones and vehicles which makes it difficult to do proper inspections during the necessary times of the day.

Chairman San Nicolas mentioned that he introduced a bill to create volunteer inspectors to help ease the burden on current inspection needs.

Ms. Leon Guerrero spoke about her involvement in community organizations and the experience she has gained through that service. She stated that skills learned will be a benefit to her service on the Board.

Chairman San Nicolas stated that Ms. Leon Guerrero's experience will be an asset to the Board and thanked her for accepting the nomination.

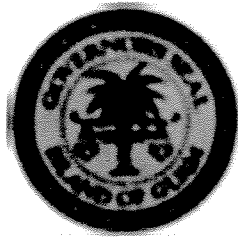
Vice Speaker Benjamin Cruz stated that he is hopeful that the Board will work diligently to ensure that "after hours" consumption of alcohol is addressed and the law is heavily enforced.

Mr. Llaneta stated that board members have personally experienced establishments serving alcohol illegally. He mentioned that he believes current penalties are not harsh enough.

Chairman San Nicolas stated that he is hopeful to see visibility heightened and the implementation of more enforcement measures. He proceeded to dismiss the panel as a whole to allow members of the public to provide testimony on each of the nominees individually. It is noted that no other individuals testified on Mr. Llaneta's nomination.

III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development hereby reports out the nomination of Renie Llaneta to serve as a member of the Alcohol Beverage Control Board, for a term of two (2) years, with the recommendation TO CONFIRM.



Renie “Rey” Llaneta *Biography*

Rey was born in Manila, Philippines, and relocated to Guam, a United States Territory, when he was 4½ years old. He was educated in Guam from elementary to college.

While in high school he received two impressive nation-wide recognition awards: *Who’s Who Among American High School Students* (1979-1980), and the *Society of Distinguished American Students* (1979-1980). As a college student at the University of Guam, he received nation-wide recognition for his academic and civic achievements in *Who’s Who Among Students in American Universities and Colleges*, successively (1982 to 1983 and 1983 to 1984).

In 1984, Rey graduated from the University of Guam (deans list) and received a commission as Second Lieutenant, United States Army, through the Reserve Officers Training Corps (ROTC) program and was assigned to the elite 529th Military Police Company (Honor Guard). It was during this assignment that Rey once again received national recognition for his outstanding achievements through the *Outstanding Young Men of America Award* (1987) and subsequent recognition later in his military career by the *International Who’s Who of Professionals* (1996).

From 1996-1999, Rey worked as a civilian *Programs Administrator* with the U.S. Navy Fleet and Family Service Center in Guam. After only three years, Rey once again earned special recognition for his “outstanding” accomplishments; a prestigious U.S. Navy civilian medal—the *U.S. Navy Meritorious Civilian Service Award*—the third highest national award that can be given to a U.S. Navy federal civilian employee “for outstanding performance”! This award has been given to less than .001% of all U.S. Navy civilian employees.

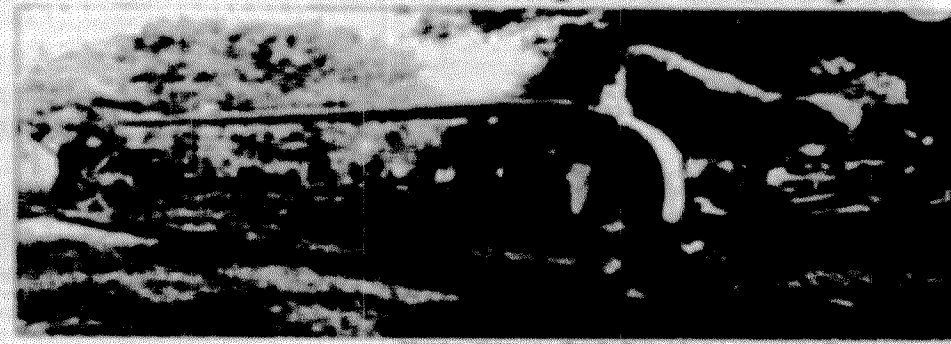
