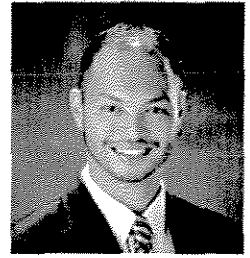

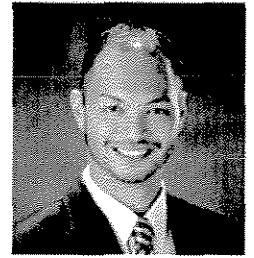

COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

The nomination of Richard W. Hamlin to serve as a Member of the Alcohol Beverage Control Board, for a term of two (2) years, was made by Governor Edward J.B. Calvo on October 5, 2015. The nomination package was received by the Office of Speaker Judith T. Won Pat, Ed.D., on October 7, 2015, and was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development on October 8, 2015.

The Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development held a public hearing on November 25, 2015, in *I Liheslatura's* Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the hearing agenda was the nomination of Mr. Hamlin. The hearing convened at 2:06 p.m. and was adjourned at 2:40 p.m.

Public Hearing notices were disseminated via electronic mail to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on November 17, 2015, and again on November 23, 2015. Notice was also posted on *I Liheslatura's* website beginning on November 17, 2015.

II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Vice Chairwoman Mary Torres convened the hearing on the nomination of Mr. Richard Hamlin. She opened the floor for members of the public wishing to testify on the nomination.

Mr. Renie Llaneta testified in support of Mr. Hamlin's nomination. He stated that the addition of the nominee would give the Alcohol Beverage Control (ABC) Board full membership. Mr. Llaneta spoke to the character of the nominee and mentioned that Mr. Hamlin would help enhance the Board and its capabilities. He encouraged the Legislature to support the nomination.

Ms. Belinda Mejia spoke in favor of Mr. Hamlin's nomination. She stated that his experience as a lawyer would be a great asset to the Board. She mentioned that in the past the Board has experienced some difficulty with interpreting the legality of certain laws pertaining to the ABC laws. Ms. Mejia stated that having the nominee as part of the Board will help to better address legal inquiries that may arise during Board discussions and therefore avoid some unnecessary delays in operations. She stated that the Board has already begun to implement alcohol server program and is moving faster than previous years; the addition of a lawyer to the Board will be beneficial.

Senator Torres asked if Board has experienced difficulty meeting and if that has affected the Board's ability to conduct business.

Mr. Llaneta stated that the Board had experienced difficulty meeting quorum in the past but that is no longer the case as the members are working together to provide quorum for meetings to be held consistently. He stated that the current Board is focusing on ensuring that they help businesses and the government to run as smoothly as possible.

Ms. Mejia stated that the current Board is committed to ensuring that regular meetings are held that they have already scheduled their November and December meetings with the various holidays in mind.

Senator Torres thanked them for their diligence and work on behalf of the public. She then yielded the floor to other members wishing to speak.

Speaker Judith Won Pat asked what changes the Board is making with regards to the operations of ABC that Mr. Hamlin's legal background will assist with.

Ms. Mejia stated that Mr. Hamlin will assist greatly with any legal inquiries that arise from current statutes that the Board could not previously address without requesting the Director of the Department of Revenue and Taxation to seek legal guidance from the Attorney General's Office.

Mr. Llaneta described a scenario in which having an individual with a legal background on the Board would have helped in interpreting the law and what action the Board could have legally taken.

Speaker Won Pat cautioned that the Board must remain cognizant about what types of action they are able to legally take. She stated that if there is a need to change rules and regulations, there is already a process in law that must be followed.

Mr. Llaneta stated that Mr. Hamlin's experience as a lawyer will help streamline the process of having to request a legal opinion from the AGO every time the Board has a question.

Senator Torres thanked the Board members for their attendance and participation at the hearing. She then yielded the floor to the nominee.

Mr. Richard Hamlin explained his professional experience which included immigration and business law and how he would like to apply it toward serving on the ABC Board. He stated that he understands that many businesses are affected by the ABC laws and that he wants to help ensure that current statutes are applied in an equitable, transparent, and efficient manner.

Senator Torres stated that she believes that it is always good to have a board composed of individuals who possess expertise in different fields and that the nominee's legal background will benefit the ABC Board. She asked Mr. Hamlin about his thoughts on the current law which regulates the number of alcohol beverage licenses issued in a village with respect to that village's population according to the Census. Senator Torres specifically pointed to Tumon and Tamuning which have a large transient population that is not included in the Census count and how visitors greatly add to the number of individuals already living in that area.

Mr. Hamlin stated his belief that a disparity exists with regards to economic development between the villages especially with Tumon compared to other villages. He believes that a "one size fits all" rule generally makes for inequitable results for those that have to conform to the requirements. He believes that current statute should be revisited to take into account the differences between villages. Mr. Hamlin

did state that until changes are made to law, his duty on the Board will be to uphold the spirit of current statutes.

Vice Chairwoman Torres explained some of the reasons that she believes current laws exist. She said that there has to be a balance between not disrupting the way of life in certain villages and creating the most economically prosperous environment in others, all the while applying the same laws across the board. She commended the nominee for his understanding and sensitivity to both sides of the issue.

Speaker Won Pat stated that current law prohibits establishments that sell alcohol from being located within a certain distance from schools and churches. She asked the nominee if he knows if that statute is being enforced and what his thoughts are on expanding that law to include child care centers.

Mr. Hamlin stated that he was not up to date on all current enforcement measures by the Board. He mentioned that it is his understanding that the statute referred to by Speaker Won Pat had an exception contained in it about whether or not a business is disturbing the surrounding community. Mr. Hamlin explained that each situation would have to be examined on its own merit.

Senator Nerissa Underwood asked the nominee to explain more about himself.

Mr. Hamlin stated that he moved to Guam about a decade ago and joined a local law firm in which he specialized in immigration law. He said that he fell in love with the island and found it to be home. The nominee stated that Guam has a unique place in the international stage and should be the gateway of the US to Asia because of its proximity as the closest US jurisdiction. Mr. Hamlin spoke about the Trans Pacific Partnership and how it would be very beneficial for Guam.

Senator Underwood asked what he believed were a few of the top issues confronting the Board.

Mr. Hamlin stated that he believed that the Board must remain efficient, equitable, and expeditious with its duties and responsibilities. He also stated that he wants to help increase the public awareness and understanding of the ABC Board and its responsibilities. Mr. Hamlin mentioned that he wants to help ensure that any rules and regulations the Board implements are promulgated and given full statutory weight.

Vice Chairwoman Torres thanked Mr. Hamlin for his time and, in recognizing that no individuals were present to testify, adjourned the hearing.

III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development hereby reports out the nomination of Richard W. Hamlin to serve as a member of the Alcohol Beverage Control Board, for a term of two (2) years, with the recommendation TO CONFIRM.

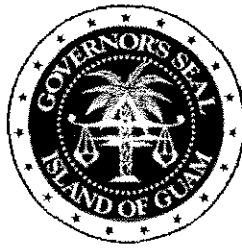

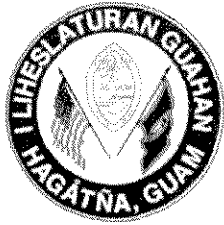

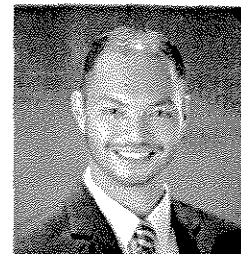
