

The Committee on Rules, Federal, Foreign and Micronesia Affairs; Human and Natural Resources, Election Reform, and Capitol District convened a public hearing on Tuesday, March 22, 2016 at 9:00 A.M. in the Public Hearing Room of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of on the appointment of **Mr. Robert A. Perron to serve as a Member of the Guam Environmental Protection Agency Board [Length of Term (3) Three Years]** whose appointment history is as follows:

Mrs. Ann Roth

Good morning Senators. I am here to support the nomination for reconfirmation for Robert Perron and Flori Sanchez. I've been on the Board for almost five years and they have been on much longer. They are totally knowledgeable as anyone can be working there. I want to encourage you to continue to support them.

Chairman Respicio

That you also for your service on the EPA Board.

Dr. Ron McNinch

Hafa Adai Senators. I've known Mr. Perron for over 15 years, he's a very fine gentleman, a wonderful community participant, has done very important things that directly support his role currently on the Board. I don't know Ms. Sanchez personally, but I've heard wonderful things about this Board and I believe she would be an excellent member. There is one other quick point I would like to mention, in addition to supporting both these candidates. Board work on Guam is extremely important. Often we don't appreciate the large amount of outside work these citizen volunteer boards do and I just want the

public to know that although they might not see the things Boards do, quiet often because there are quiet a number of Boards. GEPA Board takes it job seriously and I'm heartened that they are doing the work they do.

Mr. Jesse Cruz

Chairman Respicio stated that this is a reconfirmation to the Board.

Ms. Florida M. Sanchez

I have enjoyed being on the Board these many years. The main request I would ask of you is if you can continue to support the EPA Board and Agency, especially on their hiring needs. They need a lot of GovGuam to match the federal funds and positions. They are working diligently and it's tough. Most of them have dual roles. Anyway you can support them get more hires, that would be great.

Chairman Respicio said it was duly noted.

Mr. Robert A. Perron

Chairman Respicio stated they have been down this road many times. He along with his colleagues thanked them for their service to the EPA Board. He noted that it is certainly a difficult Board to be part of with the decisions they have to make. Also said that there was about a dozen of EPA of staff present in support of the appointments, which he said speaks volumes to the leadership the Board has for this Agency.

Senator V. Anthony Ada thanked the nominees to accepting the Governor's nomination to the EPA Board. He said that he looks forward to voting on their confirmation and they have his support.

Chairman Respicio said that the questions he had they can take up at a later time.

Senator Nerissa B. Underwood took the opportunity to thank both the nominees for their service for 13 years. She noted that it was dedication and passion and was certainly appreciative of that. She asked for the update for the asbestos in Layon Landfill.

Mr. Perron stated that he doesn't believe that has progressed. He said that the District Court asked some questions to the EPA Administrator that he believes someone in the Agency is preparing answers to so he thinks that's the next step for something to move forward.

Senator Underwood asked for some of their Board priorities.

The recycling fund.

Mr. Perron

The recycling programs are important, like Senator Respicio's recycling bills. The bottle bill which we are working on with Senator Barnes' Office. Also the military buildup is something important to keep an eye on. I try to attend the meetings that they are holding so we can manage on as well as solid waste.

Chairman Respicio thanked Mr. Perron and Ms. Sanchez for testifying and the senators present at the hearing.



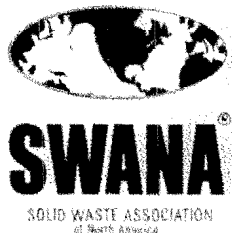


