



Committee Report Digest

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Higher Education, Culture, Public Library, and Women's Affairs convened a public hearing on Monday August 31, 2015 at 2:00 p.m. in *I Liheslatura*'s Public Hearing Room. On the agenda was the consideration on the appointment of Rosemary A. Clement, Member, KGTF/PBS Board of Trustees which was referred to the Committee on Higher Education, Culture, Public Library, and Women's Affairs.

Public Notice Requirements

All legal requirements for public notices were met, with requests for publication sent to all media and all Senators; Five (5) day notice was sent on August 24 and 25, 2015 and the Forty-eight (48) hour notice was sent on August 28, 2015 via email. Copies of the hearing notices are appended to the report.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

Please note that Senator Nerissa Bretania Underwood, Ph.D. was the acting chairperson because Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D. was attending a briefing with Joint Guam Program Office (JGPO) concerning the Record of Decision (ROD).

Acting Chairperson Nerissa Bretania Underwood, Ph.D. mentioned that on the agenda today is the confirmation and appointment of Mrs. Rosemary A. Clement as a member of the KGTF/PBS Board of Trustees for a term of four (4) years.

Acting Chairperson Nerissa Bretania Underwood, Ph.D. also mentioned that a notice of this public hearing was sent on August 24, 2015 (5 day notice) and August 28, 2015, (48) hours notice to meet the public hearing reporting requirements.

Acting Chairperson Nerissa Bretania Underwood, Ph.D. asked Mr. Darryl Taggerty and Mrs. Rosemary Clement to testify.

Mr. Darryl Taggerty stated, "Good afternoon Senator Underwood, I am happy to see you here, and I am happy to be here." He mentioned that he is here to support the Governor's appointment of Mrs. Rosemary Clement to the KGTF PBS Board of Trustees. Mr. Taggerty stated, "She and I have been in conversation about public media for as long as I known her. And I was very happy to see that she is appointed to my board and I am looking forward to her serving. She is a very concerned citizen of the community and a dedicated educator. She is extremely well qualified to lend her sensibilities and sensitivities to the deliberations to the board and trustees. So I ask for favorable consideration for her appointment by this committee and also by the legislature. I will answer any questions about PBS Guam that you may have."

Mrs. Rosemary Clement mentioned that she has been a resident of Guam for over 31 years and a life time educator and a life time supporter of public television since 1970. She mentioned that she is honored to be chosen to be on the board and that she is devoted to public media in which she hopes to help Darryl and the rest of the board make the right decisions and make innovations.

Acting Chairperson Nerissa Bretania Underwood, Ph.D mentioned that she had a few questions. She stated, "Sesame Street is probably known by most of us as KGTF/PBS programming and has now involved over the years, along with other shows such as 'Cat in the Hat' and 'Curious George'---how do you think these shows help a child's development and growth?"

Mrs. Rosemary Clement mentioned well those shows that are mentioned are well known children's books and series of books, and they have some cache that children love and having it on television is another way of reinforcing reading the books, and that is of course my goal, is to get the children to read.

Acting Chairperson Nerissa Bretania Underwood, Ph.D asked Mrs. Clement, "One of the commitments of PBS is to provide educational assistance to teachers and the classrooms, and one of the programs on the PBS Guam website is the PBS Learningmedia, are you aware of this website-have you ever used it?"

Mrs. Rosemary Clement mentioned that she has been teaching part time at the adult education at the Guam Community College and several courses that she taught had excellent PBS program videos.

Acting Chairperson Nerissa Bretania Underwood, Ph.D mentioned that at one time her husband was teaching History of Guam, it was through KGTF and they had him live, and then it was broadcast, and that was how teachers took the class, so it was an advance.

Acting Chairperson Nerissa Bretania Underwood, Ph.D asked, "Over the years, PBS has been doing a tremendous job in expanding its viewing audience with PBS News Hours, Charlie

Rose, Austin City Limits, Frontline and the Downton Abbey—as a Trustee member, what would you do to advocate keeping these shows on the air on Guam?"

Mrs. Rosemary Clement mentioned more publicity; you hardly know what shows are on. More people will tune in to these shows if you advertise them more.

Acting Chairperson Nerissa Bretania Underwood, Ph.D asked, "With your background in education working at the Department of education and the Guam Community College, with your experience how can you contribute as a member?"

Mrs. Rosemary Clement replied that she would like to get more programs involving local people and our outer island people that are disenfranchised; She also mentioned that she was also involved in PBS with gifted elementary, read-a-thon, maybe we can do something like that with locally written things.

Acting Chairperson Nerissa Bretania Underwood, Ph.D asked, "As a member of the trustees, would you like to add to a list of priorities?"

Mrs. Rosemary Clement mentioned that she would like to help with fundraising, for years the wine tasting was a big social event, and she remembers one glass that said KGTF on them. One big event can really help getting money, something to get involved and that she went to KGTF to do some volunteer work. Some priorities she mentioned included publicity, fundraising, and getting the local population more involved.

Acting Nerissa Bretania Underwood, Ph.D acknowledged the presence of Senator Frank B. Aguon Jr. and Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D.

Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D. thanked Senator N.B. Underwood for conducting the public hearing, while she was attending the Record of Decision Briefing. Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D. mentioned that she knows the appointee for many years at the Guam Department of Education, and mentioned the appointees family members that have contributed so much to our community. Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D asked, "We know you're busy, do you have time to assist with the KGTF PBS Board of Trustees?

Mrs. Rosemary Clement mentioned that she has 6 grandchildren and she spends a lot of time babysitting. She is only teaching one class at the Guam Community College. She also mentioned that many of these young people at the Guam Community College are very gifted but they fell through the cracks. She mentioned that she does have the time, with the one class and babysitting.

Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D. asked, "Since you are familiar with public broadcasting, how can you help in terms of making the KGTF/PBS Board of Trustees advance?"

Mrs. Rosemary Clement mentioned more fundraising and making more contact with the minority of Guam.

Speaker Won Pat, Ed.D. thanked Mrs. Rosemary Clement for agreeing to help out with the KGTG/PBS Board of Trustees and mentioned that the Committee report will be reported out in time for session tomorrow.

Acting Chairperson Nerissa Bretania Underwood, Ph.D adjourned the public hearing at 2:41 p.m.

III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS.




