COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. <u>OVERVIEW</u>

The Committee on Rules, Federal, Foreign and Micronesian Affairs; Human and Natural Resources, Election Reform, and Capitol District convened a public hearing on Tuesday, April 7, 2015 at 9:00 A.M. in the Public Hearing Room of *I Liheslaturan Guāhan*. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of the appointment of **Mr. Steven Carrara to serve as a Member of the Guam Environmental Protection Agency Board [Length of Term: Three (3) Years]** whose appointment history is as follows:

- Appointed by Governor Eddie Baza Calvo on March 4, 2015;
- Appointment packet forwarded to I Liheslatura on March 5, 2015;
- Packet forwarded to this committee for public consideration on March 9, 2015.

Public Notice Requirements

Notices were disseminated via e-mail and facsimile to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on March 30, 2015 (5-Day Notice), and again on April 2, 2015 (48-Hour Notice), thereby meeting the noticing requirements of the Open Government Law. Notices were also transmitted to various stakeholders.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

- 1. Mr. Robert Perron, Chairman, Guam Environmental Protection Agency Board, In Support of the Appointment.
- 2. Mr. Steven Carrara, Appointee, Member of the Guam Environmental Protection Agency, In Support of the Appointment.

Senator Rory J. Respicio called the public hearing for the reappointment of Mr. Steven Carrara to serve as a Member of the Guam Environmental Protection Agency (GEPA) Board to order at 9:00 A.M. and invited the panel to testify.

Senator Respicio called appointee up, Mr. Steven Carrara. Senator Respicio noted that the appointee is currently serving under the GEPA Board and that this was a re-appointment. He noted his appreciation for her to continue to serve on the Board. He then gave the nominee the opportunity to provide testimony before the Committee.

Mr. Robert Perron

I am the current Chairman of the GEPA Board. It is a pleasure for me to be here and speak in support of the re-appointment of Mr. Steven Carrara. Mr. Carrara has been a vital member to the Board and has contributed greatly to Board decisions and to the direction of the agency. He has freely given his time, experience and expertise in support GEPA and its mission. I sincerely hope you see fit to confirm Mr. Carrara's appointment to the Board where he serves effectively. Thank you.

Mr. Steven Carrara

It is an honor and a privilege to be re-nominated to the Board. I've enjoyed my experience with the Board and I hope that I provided some assistance to the Board. EPA has a very important mission on Guam that I believe in and I am happy to serve on the Board and thank you for the opportunity to come down here.

Chairman Respicio

Thank you. It means a lot to not only have the Governor's continued confidence in you by re-appointing you to the same GEPA Board. I want to thank you for your service. Nothing has come up regarding your service at GEPA, only positive feedback. I thank you and hope you have smooth sailing throughout the confirmation process. I would like to offer my support in your confirmation.

Senator James V. Espaldon

Steve, What do you see as perhaps one of the bigger issues with GEPA. We know that the military buildup will be ramping up soon and the record of decision will be coming up. Could you give me some thoughts about what you were thinking about?

Mr. Carrara

We've had some interesting hearings from the past couple of years that I've served on the Board. There was the Baza Gardens situation and we decided on that. There are many issues coming up. We were just talking about disposals, it's not necessarily a legal issue, but it's a problem that needs to be addressed. The Community is addressing it and ways to foster community involvement. Another issue is the permitting of landfills

landfills and they are not easy issues to decide because there is no easy answer. We need to encourage licensing effective management and I'm there to study the issues and provide guidance to support the agency.

Senator Espaldon

I know you have been on the Board for the past three years and I know the Board has done a good job. I definitely support your nomination on this one and with your legal background; it would bring a good and solid perspective. Most times the environmental laws are dictated by federal laws and that is why I think your place on this Board is definitely important. You have my support Mr. Carrara.

Mr. Carrara

I appreciate your support.

Chairman Respicio

Can you give the Committee an idea of how often you meet and the kind of decisions you have to deliberate on and its far reaching implications on our island's environment?

Mr. Carrara

Well we meet once a month on, I believe it's the last Thursday of the month and we meet at 4 o'clock and we go till it continues. The length of the meetings depends on whether or not there is a hearing that is set for the board members to consider because once EPA makes a decision the decisions can be appealed to the board of directors. So sometimes there are fact finding hearings and that could go on.

Chairman Respicio

But when you are in an administrative hearing, those things are outside of the regular monthly meetings and those instances are very time consuming, I imagine.

Mr. Carrara

Yes, very much so, so what we do scheduling wise and we are always available. Sometimes there are conferences we attend locally. U.S. EPA has various events during the year that we attend and one thing that we've been pushing and I have been really trying to push is getting U.S. EPA funds an attorney position so we are working with the Attorney Generals to get a full time staffer at EPA because that would really help the Board.

Chairman Respicio

Just as a quick update, we are waiting on the report that the public auditor's are conducting right now regarding the Recycling Revolving Fund (RRF). Several months ago she's committed to looking into that and your Administrator has been very cooperative. There are things that have been used regarding the expenditures of that fund, which I've questioned and I'm looking to the OPA to resolve it.

Mr. Robert Perron

I believe Senator it was to do with the conference that was held out here. That was used to bring in some outside speakers and some professionals in the Zero-waste community because the main thing that the conference talked about was Zero-waste and the road to Zero-waste.

Chairman Respicio

I would never question the benefit of the conference and how productive or effective it was, but it's just the use of those funds so we know going forward, whether or not there are those kinds of parameters. The exclusion was off-island travel, so maybe someone thought, they're coming on island, maybe it's counted, but it's still travel. You want to give us a quick update one the tire shredder because that's something that the EPA has been working on, something that's important for the community to be aware of.

Mr. Perron

Sure Senator, Guahan Waste Recycling brought in a tire shredder and got it up and running in permitted around the first of the year and to date, we've shredded about 15-20,000 tires to be shipped out to Japan, primarily, for use as fuel in a waste energy facility there. We're also supplying some to Black Construction for their landfill closure project. So they're using some shredded tire for that, which if we can find local use for the shredded tire, it becomes much more cost effective to deal with that waste because the shipping is so expensive. As an example, right now when we shipped our first two load to Japan, it cost us a \$163 a ton to ship it and we received \$90 a ton. So minus \$73 a ton on it, so local use are really much better for us if we can identify other local ways to use that product and we're looking for ways. But yes, it's been successful, you know we're reducing the stock piles that are around the island so it's going well for us.

Chairman Respicio

And so when we pay our fee for tire disposal the community can be assured that those tires are actually being properly disposed and not stockpiled.

Mr. Perron

Oh absolutely, in fact we don't stock pile anything on our site, when the tires come in, they are shredded that day and there's no tire storage on the site at all, except for the final product, the shredded tire. There might be a container or two there that are containerized, but nothing on the ground and there's no stockpiling of anything at our site.

Chairman Respicio

I also want to quickly congratulate the Board for believing in the philosophy that recycling works when the community supports it and when the community subsidizes it because in the recycling company, there's no money to be made as you just pointed out the lost that you're currently experiencing and the business side of you. But those efforts of you should certainly be supplemented by the recycling revolving fund and those fees that are generated. That's why want to protect the viability of those funds.

Mr. Perron

That is why there is a tire disposal fee to help subsidize that as well, but also for picking up tires in the jungle or that are laying around with no apparent owner, that is a good use of that revolving recycling fund to clean up those kinds of messes, I think. One thing I would recommend senators, is that you look at possibly legislation to require the tire shops to keep the tires when they replace the old ones with new tires, that the tire shop be required to not return the tire to the customer unless it is still useable. If there is a certain depth of tread and the tire is still viable, then you can return but if it's damaged or worn to the point of not being able to be used, it might good to have something in place.

Chairman Respicio

Because right now they have an option, if they do not have a deposit, they take the tires.

Mr. Perron

Yes, if they do not want to pay the \$4-5 fee to have the tire disposed of, they will say, "Oh I will take care of it. I am going to do something with it." The something usually is not something good: throw it in the nearest dumpster or throw it in the nearest open fields, so that might be something to consider.

Chairman Respicio

Is it something that your Board might be willing to take up as a discussion and pass a resolution so that we can have support?

Mr. Perron

Yes, I run tire shops so I have to recuse on that one internally. But again, there is no real profit to the tire shop to take them or not take them because whatever they receive, they pay to the recycling company.

Chairman Respicio thanked the panel for testifying and the senators present at the hearing.

No further testimony being offered, Chairman Respicio then declared that appointment for Mr. Steven Carrara to serve as a Member of the Guam Environmental Protection Agency Board was duly heard.
