COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Rules, Federal, Foreign and Micronesian Affairs; Human and Natural Resources, Election Reform, and Capitol District convened a public hearing on Monday, November 28, 2016 at 12:30 P.M. in the Public Hearing Room of I Liheslaturan Guåhan. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of on the appointment of Mr. Terrence M. Brooks to serve as a Member of the Guam Environmental Protection Agency Board, Length of Term: Three (3) Years [Term: November 29, 2016 to November 28, 2019] whose appointment history is as follows:

- Appointed by Governor Eddie Baza Calvo on November 14, 2016;
- Appointment packet forwarded to I Liheslatura on November 15, 2016;
- Packet forwarded to this committee for public consideration on November 16, 2016.

Public Notice Requirements

Notices were disseminated via e-mail and facsimile to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on November 17, 2016 (5-Day Notice), and again on November 22, 2016 (48-Hour Notice), thereby meeting the noticing requirements of the Open Government Law. II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

1. Mr. Terrence M. Brooks, Member, Guam Environmental Protection Agency Board, provided oral and written testimony in support of his appointment.

Chairman Rory J. Respicio called the public hearing on the appointment of Mr. Terrence M. Brooks to serve as a Member of the Guam Environmental Protection Agency Board, Length of Term: Three (3) Years [Term: November 29, 2016 to November 28, 2019] to order at 12:35 P.M.

Chairman Senator Rory J. Respicio called the nominee to testify.

Mr. Terrence M. Brooks

Thank you Chairman Respicio and Speaker Won Pat. It is an honor to be here before you today. As you know, I am here today to seek my third term with the GEPA Board. Formally, I spent 20 years in the Public Utilities Commission. I think that giving back to the community is a very big part of living here. It's been an honor to do so over the years. I think the Agency is starting to do some really good things now. According to the Administrator, they are working on hiring six new personnel that will go a long way to increase environmental monitoring; they are getting an attorney to work on the statutes and regulations, many of which are up to 25 years old and they are working on other areas such as the vehicle emission standards by generating field inspections and safe drinking water. I think these hires are going to go a long way toward making the agency more effective, more efficient and self-sustaining.

Speaker Judith T. Won Pat

Serving on the Board, have you seen or proposed any changes?

Mr. Brooks

Changes are mostly from the outside. Change in laws for example a recent bill regarding the recycling revolving fund. But to my understanding, that is something that is going to the solid waste authority so its not really an EPA issue or won't be one soon. However there are concerns there might not be enough money left in the RRF because of some other laws that were passed.

Chairman Respicio

I support the lifeline rate for residents having trash pickup service but my concern was to use the RRF up to \$750,000 per year to increase the participation of the solid waste program that is not consistent with the spirit and intent of the RRF, which was created to provide for recycling initiatives. The bill is still in Committee and the author agreed to have a round table with EPA and Solid Waste Authority so that's where that is at. There have been issues with the RRF and we have a couple bills on the agenda that will make EPA have their own checking account, separate and apart from the General Fund but we've seen some cash transfers out of the account along with posting all transactions on their website to provide for transparency and greater accountability.

Mr. Brooks

That would be a great help. We hired a PIO recently so that would help with keeping our website up-to-date.

Chairman Respicio thanked the nominee for testifying and the Speaker present at the hearing.

No further testimony being offered, Chairman Respicio then declared the appointment of Mr. Terrence M. Brooks to serve as a Member of the Guam Environmental Protection Agency Board, Length of Term: Three (3) Years [Term: November 29, 2016 to November 28, 2019] was duly heard.


