Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of the appointment of THOMAS E.B. BORJA, to serve as a Member of the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority, Board of Commissioners and whose appointment history is as follows:

- Appointed by I Maga'lahen Guåhan on March 22, 2016 for a term length of Five
   (5) years
- Appointment packet forwarded to I Liheslatura on March 22, 2016;
- Appointment packet forwarded to this committee for public consideration on Tuesday, April 12, 2016.

### II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

The public hearing was Called-to-Order at 9:03 a.m.

<u>Chairperson:</u> Hafa adai and Mana' Si Yu'os everyone! This Public Hearing by the Committee on Municipal Affairs, Tourism, Housing and Historic Preservation is now called to order....it is now 9:03 a.m. For the record and in accordance to 5 GCA, Chapter 8, Subsection 8107, notices were sent out via email to all Senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on Tuesday, April 5, 2016 (5-Day Notice), and the second notice on Monday, April 11, 2016 (48-Hour Notice).

Ladies and gentlemen, on the agenda this morning is the appointment of Thomas E.B. Borja, Member, Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority (GHURA), Board of Commissioners.

Joining me here this morning ladies and gentlemen is the minority leader, Senator Tony Ada. Thank you for joining me here this morning Senator Ada.

I'd like to thank everyone for joining us this morning and I would like to call up the individuals that will be testifying on behalf of the appointee, Mr. Thomas E.B. Borja. The first panel is Mr. Duenas, Mr. Mike Borja and Mr. Sablan. Please come forward and thank you for joining us this morning.

Mr. David Sablan: For the record I am still the Chairman of the GHURA board, although my term has expired, the law states that I still serve until the Governor appoints another member or reappoints me for another term.

**Chairperson:** Thank you for always volunteering.

Mr. David Sablan: I could step down but I decided to continue to serve because we have a very small board right now. Currently on the board are 5 individuals, of which 4 is needed for a quorum. We've apprised the Governor of this and he's looking for individuals to appoint soon. Anyway, Madam Chair and Minority Leader Tony Ada, I am pleased to be here. My name is David Sablan, I am the current Chairman of the Board of Commissioners to testify in support of Mr. Thomas E.B. Borja. I know Mr. Borja before he married Therese. I read his resume and he is very well versed on the business area and he is certainly going to be an asset on the board of commissioners. He's very articulate and it will help with the discussion of issues. He is absolutely qualified to be on our board. He strikes me as a committed individual to help the community here on Guam. I hope that the Legislature would support his nomination to be on our board. Thank you!



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**Chairperson:** Thank you Mr. Sablan. Mr. Duenas?

Mr. Michael J. Duenas: Good morning Madam Chair and Senator Tony Ada. My name is Michael Duenas, I am the Executive Director of the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority. I want to thank you Madam Chair for always supporting us and in this case, promptly scheduling the confirmation hearing for Mr. Borja. Like Mr. Sablan mentioned earlier, we only have 5 individuals on the board, which can sometimes pose a problem with getting a quorum. We are working closely with the front office and we anticipate that 2 more nominees should be coming forth before the end of the month. I have had the opportunity review Mr. Borja's bio and I believe his business experience is something of value and it could be contributed to the quality of discussion during the board meetings. I look forward to his confirmation. Thank you!

Chairperson: You're welcome Mr. Duenas. Mr. Borja?

Mr. Mike Borja: Good morning Ms. Chairperson and Senator Ada. I'm Mike Borja and I'm here on a personal capacity to give my full hearted support for Thomas E.B. Borja, for full disclosure, he is my brother. I do know that Tom has the confidence and the ability to do the job that he is assigned to as one of the Commissioners with the GHURA Board of Commissioners. I do ask that this committee report him out immediately and favorably and that the Legislature confirm him right away as well. Thank you!

Chairperson: You are very welcome. Senator Ada, do you have any questions for this panel? I'd like to thank everyone here today to give oral testimony and support for Mr. Borja. I do want to say for the record Mr. Chair, through good times and bad times you've always worked closely with the family of Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority and you're one of the few boards that have always made it a point to have a quorum. I want to say thank you! I hope that the Governor that takes the time to reappoint all the members. Thank you for always being there for GHURA and working closely with Executive Director, Mr. Duenas. Don't give up on me. I will also send a letter to the Governor asking for a reappointment letter as well as additional appointees.

Mr. David Sablan: Thank you very much Madam Chair for all those compliments. It's because of your support that we've been able to move forward with a lot of issues that we could not move at the board level. This close working relationship with you and



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your office has really benefited our people with the housing industry. We've built a lot of homes for our community in the recent few years. We have a very strong commitment from our staff. They work very efficiently. We are looking at addressing the housing shortage on our island. We are very focused on that. We want to thank you for your strong support. We currently have 5 board members and with the addition of Mr. Borja, we will have 6. We try to have 2 board meetings a month to address pressing issues. Now with the budget coming up, we may have additional meetings. So, thank you once again Madam Chair and we look forward to Mr. Borja's confirmation.

<u>Chairperson:</u> You are so welcome and thank you for being here. If there's no one else to testify, I would like to call the appointee up please. Mr. Borja?

Mr. Thomas E.B. Borja: Good morning Madam Chairperson and Senator Ada, my name is Thomas E.B. Borja and I have been nominated to serve on the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority Board of Commissioners. I am a return resident of the island with over 30 years of experience in management and technology. I believe my experience provides me with useful capabilities to serve on the board in areas such as federal compliance, writing and reviewing RFP's, contract reviews and negotiations. I understand that GHURA is federally funded and has to comply with federal mandates and laws while providing needed care and services to Guam residents. I look forward to this opportunity to serve the community. Thank you!

Chairperson: Thank you very much. Senator Ada do you have any comments?

Senator V. Anthony Ada: Thank you Madam Chair and good morning Mr. Borja. Thank you first of all for accepting the Governor's nomination to the board of commissioners. I was looking over your packet and on the statement of financial interest, is tborja.com the only company you own?

Mr. Thomas E.B. Borja: Yes.

<u>Senator V. Anthony Ada:</u> Ok, I'm not sure if you saw it, but it states on the whole sheet owner, 100%.

Mr. Thomas E.B. Borja: Yes, it was a form issue.



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<u>Senator V. Anthony Ada:</u> Oh I see. What an impressive resume! I hope we can find other places that we could place you in. I know that being on the GHURA Board of Commissioners that you would be a valuable asset to them. I hope that you would be able to make your way in there and catch up on all the issues. I look forward to working with you and you have my full support. I will recommend that Madam Chair would be able to put in your committee report and have it ready for the April 20th session. Thank you!

<u>Chairperson:</u> I want to thank you Senator Ada for being here with me. I will make sure that it gets done. I want to thank you Mr. Borja for stepping up to the place for accepting the nomination to serve on the GHURA board. I will note for the record that there was a written testimony that came in and I will read it and append it to the committee report. It is from Mr. Joseph Tydingco, VP/Director of HR & Administration of the Community First Guam Federal Credit Union. Chairperson reads the testimony to the public. Copy of the testimony is appended to the committee report.

<u>Chairperson:</u> Like my colleague, I share the same sentiments, I am very impressed with your resume. I only have one question and that is: if you could offer a change or something within your expertise, to the GHURA board, what would that be?

Mr. Thomas E.B. Borja: Not specifically. The challenges relate to numerous things and with GHURA being federally funded we don't get enough money from the feds. The challenge for finances are very very significant. I'm not sure the level that I could apply for that is something I need to look at. Obviously the need for land is pretty important. I was looking at a report that Director Duenas had sent to me a presentation and there are roughly 749 units right now and the waiting list is 1700. Between funding and the opportunity to get land is a pretty major challenge. I'm looking forward to the opportunity to work towards that. The mission statement is to work and help one family at a time and hopefully we could do that as quickly as possible. Those are the things I look forward to.

<u>Chairperson:</u> I want to say Un Dangkulo Na Si Yu'os Ma'ase once again for stepping up to the plate. It feels good to know that you are already in contact with Mr. Duenas and that you're engaged with board issues. Thank you to you and your family! Mr. Sablan if you could please come forward, I would like to ask a question regarding the board. I know we recently had an appointment to the board however we received a notice that she had to rescind. So, are we currently short a few members?



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Mr. David Sablan: Yes, Madam Chair. There are actually four (4) members that have expired, myself, Rosie, Deanne and Annabelle. The only one current is Mr. Leon Guerrero and he is the resident manager. We have agreed to all continue to serve until the Governor replaces or reappoints us.

<u>Chairperson:</u> I will write a letter to the Governor to request for his new members and to reappoint the current members as well. With this said, I will call this confirmation hearing of Mr. Thomas E.B. Borja, publicly heard. This hearing is now adjourned at 9:34 a.m.




