The Committee on Rules, Federal, Foreign and Micronesian Affairs; Human and Natural Resources, Election Reform, and Capitol District convened a public hearing on Thursday, January 21, 2016 at 2:00 P.M. in the Public Hearing Room of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration of on the appointment of **Mr. William T. Detry to serve as a Member of the Guam Environmental Protection Agency Board [Length of Term (3) Three Years]** whose appointment history is as follows:

- Appointed by Governor Eddie Baza Calvo on April 3, 2015;
- Appointment packet forwarded to *I Liheslatura* on April 6, 2015;
- Packet forwarded to this committee for public consideration on April 7, 2015.

Chairman Rory J. Respicio called the public hearing on the appointment of **Mr. William T. Detry to serve as a Member of the Guam Environmental Protection Agency Board [Length of Term (3) Three Years]** to order at 2:00 P.M.

Chairman Senator Rory J. Respicio called the panel to testify.

Mr. Robert Perron

I am here in support of the confirmation of Mr. William T. Detry and Mr. Erning Zhou for another term as members to the EPA Board. They both have been active members of the Board provided valuable insight in their experiences in their careers and in their personal experiences. They have been very instrumental in the Board deliberation and to come up with policies and ways of doing things for the Agency. I really enjoy working with both of them and the entire Board. It's a good, deliberative Board. Everyone has independent opinions and shares them and shows disagreement when they have a

Chairman Respicio

Thank you three for your willingness to serve on a very difficult Board and that is because your task is very great and that is to protect our environment at all costs. To what extent does the Board get involved to what the Administrator's decisions, which he has made public? Such as allowing asbestos to be dumped into the landfill, moving forwarding on certain purchases on the Recycling Revolving Fund, and say that its environmentally acceptable to divert the flooding into Tumon Bay?

Mr. Perron

Was not brought to the Board and it was not not a Board decision. I personally gave the Administrator his opinion. It would be good if these decisions were discussed in advance with the Board.

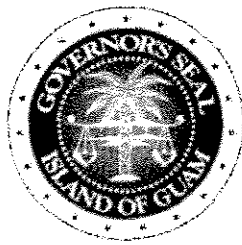
