

COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

Resolution No. 177-33 (COR) was introduced on September 8, 2015, by Senator Michael F.Q. San Nicolas. The bill was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the primary sponsor on September 9, 2015.

The Committee on Finance & Taxation, General Government Operations, and Youth Development held a public hearing on September 15, 2015, in *I Liheslatura*'s Public Hearing Room. Among the items on the hearing agenda was Resolution No. 177-33 (COR). The hearing convened at 2:05 p.m. and was adjourned at 2:45 p.m.

Public Hearing notices were disseminated via electronic mail to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on September 8, 2015, and again on September 11, 2015. Notice was also posted on *I Liheslatura*'s website beginning on September 8, 2015.

II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Chairman Michael San Nicolas explained the intent of Resolution No. 177-33 (COR). He stated that it would express the support of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* for H.R. 9, the Innovation Act, introduced in the United States House of Representatives. He explained that H.R. 9 would help to make the litigation environment for patents associated with the internet become friendlier for those possessing patents. He stated that he was approached by members of the real estate industry whose websites are being affected by minute patented technologies including drop down menus and link buttons. Chairman San Nicolas spoke about supporting H.R. 9 so that frivolous lawsuits do not arise with regard to patent infringement. The resolution would help to protect Guam's e-commerce environment from being victimized by any type of abusive litigation that is currently a problem stateside. Without any public testimony being offered, the hearing on Resolution No. 177-33 (COR) was adjourned.

III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

WHEREAS, H.R. 9, also known as the Innovation Act, was introduced in
the 114th United States Congress, sponsored by Representative Bob Goodlatte, a
Republican from Virginia's 6th Congressional District and Chairman of the United
States House of Representatives Committee on the Judiciary; and

6 WHEREAS, H.R. 9 has been co-sponsored by a bipartisan coalition of 7 twenty-seven representatives including Rep. Darrell Issa (R-CA), Rep. Lamar 8 Smith (R-TX), Rep. Steve Chabot (R-OH), Rep. Randy Forbes (R-VA) and Rep. 9 Zoe Lofgren (D-CA), Rep. Jerrold Nadler (D-NY), Del. Pedro Pierluisi (D-PR), 10 Rep. Hakeem Jeffries (D-NY) who are all senior members of the United States 11 House of Representatives Committee on the Judiciary; and 12 WHEREAS, H.R. 9 has been endorsed by the leading technology groups

WHEREAS, H.R 9 has been endorsed by the leading technology groups such as the Electronic Frontier Foundation, United for Patent Reform and the Biotechnology Industry Association, leading companies like Yahoo!, Eli Lily, and Salesforce.com as well as groups representing small businesses throughout the

3 WHEREAS, under the current patent system many broad and basic 4 technological protocols have been issued vague patents including the use of drop 5 down menus, shopping carts and hyper-linking on websites. Companies have 6 bought up these patents with the intent of using them offensively against 7 unsuspecting businesses, making broad claims of infringement based upon patents 8 of questionable validity; and

9 WHEREAS, the most frequent target of patent lawsuits have been small
10 businesses because of their inability to spend the money necessary for a defense
11 and therefore their increased likelihood to settle; and

WHEREAS, any business on Guam could be targeted with these costly patent lawsuits which create an environment which stifles Guam's economic development and prosperity by creating a chilling effect on businesses which seek to create an internet presence for the benefit of the business and the people of Guam; and

WHEREAS, local business owners in the real estate community on Guam have sought *I Liheslatura*'s support for H.R. 9, the Innovation Act, because many use websites with search functions, drop down menus and other internet protocols which may be the subject of abusive litigation and affect critical business and community functions; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that *I Mina Trentai Tres Na Lihesturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, implore the 114th U.S. Congress to duly pass H.R. 9, the Innovation Act, for the benefit of all businesses which wish to contribute to the positive economic growth of their community; and be it


