16 contributions he has made as an active member of the organization; and


17           **WHEREAS,** Mr. Robert Kao, together with his lovely wife, Mrs. Annie

4 health, and emotional support; now, therefore, be it


5           **RESOLVED**, that the Executive Committee of *I Mina'Bente Ocho Na*
