3 **WHEREAS, Hit Radio 100 and the Agana Shopping Center**
4 **teamed up with other local sponsors to host a "Kid-Care Photo ID"**

1 event as part of a national effort to provide parents with free personal
2 safety identifications of their children throughout 2005; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the National Center for Missing and Exploited
4 Children (NCMEC) and the Polaroid Corporation have developed
5 the “Kid-Care Photo ID” as part of the national campaign to increase
6 awareness about missing children and to educate parents about steps
7 they can take to help protect their children; and

8 **WHEREAS**, the “Kid-Care Photo ID” is a NCMEC approved
9 form of standardized identification for children, used to help locate
10 missing children from all over the United States; and

11 **WHEREAS**, Guam is very fortunate not to have a high
12 incidence of kidnapping, but the Kid-Care ID is very useful should
13 children become separated from their parents at places such as
14 shopping malls, baseball games, theme parks, and airports while
15 visiting large cities off-island; and

16 **WHEREAS**, while the full extent of the missing children
17 problem is unknown, one study conducted by the United States is
18 Department of Justice found that over one million (1,000,000)
19 children are reported missing each year; and


20 **WHEREAS**, the NCMEC points out that most of the children
21 abducted are taken by a family member who does not generally have
22 the child’s best interests in mind; and

23 **WHEREAS**, experts at the NCMEC advise that many crimes
24 against children can be prevented through education; now, therefore,
25 be it


1 **RESOLVED**, that the Executive Committee of *I Mina'Bente*
