1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF I**

3           **WHEREAS,** the late Honorable Joseph R. Reyes was born on  
4 September 2, 1953 to Felisa R. Francisco and the late Jose B. Guevara; and

5           **WHEREAS,** in 1971, Joseph R. Reyes graduated from George  
6 Washington High School; and

7           **WHEREAS,** in 1975, Joseph R. Reyes earned an Associates Degree in  
8 Physical Education from the University of Guam; and

9           **WHEREAS,** in January 12, 1981, Joseph R. Reyes was sworn into office  
10 having the honor and privilege to serve as Assistant Commissioner for the  
11 people of Agat; and

12           **WHEREAS,** in January 14, 1985, Joseph R. Reyes was sworn in to serve  
13 a second term as Assistant Commissioner for the people of Agat; and

14           **WHEREAS,** Joseph R. Reyes served as an active Assistant  
15 Commissioner and participated in various organizations for the betterment  
16 of the island community; and

17           **WHEREAS,** because of Joseph R. Reyes' passion for baseball, he  
18 shaped Guam's Youth by being a participant in the Guam Little League and  
19 the Bambino *Hafa Adai* League and prepared many youngsters for the next  
20 level of Guam baseball; and

21           **WHEREAS,** Joseph R. Reyes' participation in Guam's Youth baseball  
22 has helped many advance to the Guam Amateur Baseball League and the  
23 Guam Major League Baseball; and

1           **WHEREAS**, Joseph R. Reyes was instrumental in assisting the  
2 Department of Youth Affairs for the welfare of Guam’s troubled youth; and

3           **WHEREAS**, Joseph R. Reyes was actively and spiritually involved in  
4 the Agat Parish Council bringing faith in the Lord to the community; and

5           **WHEREAS**, Joseph R. Reyes was an active participant in the  
6 Awareness of Cancer in Guam for the American Cancer Society; and

7           **WHEREAS**, Joseph R. Reyes was a member of the Anderson Air Force  
8 Base Community Council working closely with the military community; and

9           **WHEREAS**, Joseph R. Reyes was a member of the Legislative  
10 Committee under the Mayor’s Council, working with law makers for the  
11 betterment of Guam’s community; and

12           **WHEREAS**, Joseph R. Reyes is survived by his mother Felisa R.  
13 Francisco and his siblings Antonio R. Charfauros, Florence R. Anderson,  
14 Clarita R. Babauta, Jeanette R. Peckich, John R. Reyes, Annie F. Abrenilla,  
15 George Guevara (Vallejo, California), Connie Febres (Vallejo, California),  
16 and Helen Vegas (Vallejo, California); now, therefore, be it


17           **RESOLVED**, that the Executive Committee of *I Mina’Bente Ocho Na*

23 people of Guam, recognize the outstanding contributions, and services of the


1 late former Assistant Commissioner Joseph R. Reyes, and extends its humble
