**Relative to commending and congratulating the U.S. Naval Computer and Telecommunications Station (NCTS), Guam, for being awarded the Community Service/Sister Village Award Worldwide for the thirteenth (13<sup>th</sup>) consecutive year, and to extending sincere gratitude on behalf of the people of Guam to the NCTS personnel for their numerous contributions to improve our community.**

1        **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF I**  
2        ***MINA'BENTE OCHO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3        **WHEREAS, over the years the personnel of the U.S. Naval Computer**  
4        **and Telecommunications Station (NCTS), Guam, have given back to the**

1 community in countless ways, providing more than two thousand (2,000)  
2 hours of community service to the residents of Guam, most especially to the  
3 sister village of Dededo; and

4       **WHEREAS**, among the numerous notable projects NCTS personnel  
5 have participated in are those that have assisted our island youth in northern  
6 villages, including the Department of Youth Affairs' Youth Crime Watch  
7 Programs at Astumbo Elementary, Vicente S.A. Benavente Middle and  
8 DODEA Guam North Elementary schools; the Saturday Scholars tutorial  
9 program at Astumbo Elementary and Vicente S.A. Benavente Middle schools  
10 in the village of Dededo; participating as Science Fair Judges at Astumbo  
11 Elementary and Vicente S.A. Benavente Middle schools; participation in the  
12 site-improvement and maintenance projects at Vicente S.A. Benavente Middle  
13 School in preparation for accreditation; the Adopt-a-School program at  
14 DODEA Guam Northern Elementary/Middle schools, where volunteers  
15 provided sporting activities for students throughout the school year; serving  
16 as chaperones for students during an off-campus event of Vicente S.A.  
17 Benavente Middle School at GameWorks in Tumon; and the donation of  
18 essential school supplies to Astumbo Elementary and Vicente S.A. Benavente  
19 Middle schools; and

20       **WHEREAS**, throughout their active participation in volunteer activities,  
21 NCTS personnel emphasized the importance of good sportsmanship and the  
22 promotion of health and fitness among the school children of our northern  
23 communities as evidenced in their voluntary participation as coaches, referees  
24 and umpires for basketball, baseball, football and soccer games in Youth  
25 Sports' Leagues/Programs; participation in the Sister Village and Adopt-a-

1 School Campaign Drug-Free programs; in assisting Boy Scouts of America  
2 (Pack 38) and Cub Scouts of America (Pack 38) by carrying out the drug-free  
3 message to scouts during weekly meetings and weekend events; and

4 **WHEREAS**, NCTS remains active in the Dededo community as an  
5 honorary member of the Dededo Municipal Planning Council, where a  
6 representative attends monthly meetings and participates in community  
7 service projects coordinated with the Office of the Mayor of Dededo; and

8 **WHEREAS**, NCTS personnel continually contribute to the community  
9 by taking on beautification projects, such as the adoption and painting of two  
10 school bus shelters located outside the main gate of NCTS, volunteers also  
11 maintain and beautify two bus shelters quarterly, and NCTS is part of the  
12 Governor's Council on Guam Beautification and Dededo Mayor's Office  
13 beautification programs, highway clean-up efforts and clearing of debris  
14 along hiking trails; and

15 **WHEREAS**, NCTS supports the Navy's Project Good Neighbor Projects  
16 as shown in its personnel's regular participation in fun-run events throughout  
17 the island, where funds are donated to charitable organizations throughout  
18 the island, and they continue to provide escorts for the Dededo & Astumbo  
19 Senior Citizen Centers *La Rai* Coronation, Dededo Liberation Day Candidate  
20 and Dededo Community's Annual Christmas Tree Lighting Ceremony; and


21 **WHEREAS**, NCTS personnel have given selflessly of themselves using

25 Community Service/Sister Village Award Worldwide; now, therefore, be it


1           **RESOLVED**, that the Executive Committee of *I Mina'Bente Ocho Na*
