5 two (2) brothers, Ryan Lee and Rolly Jay, two (2) sisters, Roshelle Marie and
6 Reeana Lynn, and three (3) reared brothers, Frankie Francisco, Jr., Jacob
7 Francisco and Shawn Dela Cruz; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Specialist Richard Degracia Naputi, Jr., enlisted in the
9 United States Army and was assigned to the 1st Battalion 15th Infantry
10 Regiment, 3rd Brigade, 3rd Infantry Division, Fort Benning, Georgia; and

12 dedicated man, who on December 20, 2005 at the age of twenty-four (24)
13 became the eleventh (11th) son of the Micronesia region who have made the
14 ultimate sacrifice in military combat in Iraq; and


15 **WHEREAS**, Specialist Richard Degracia Naputi, Jr., will forever be

24 demonstrating his dedication through making the ultimate sacrifice in


1 military combat while serving in the United States Armed Forces in December
