16 **WHEREAS**, the Territorial College of Guam, which was founded in
17 1952, offering limited classes at the old George Washington High School
18 campus in Mongmong, developed from a two (2) year teacher training
19 institution to a Land Grant University that offers a full range of
20 undergraduate programs and graduate studies, relocated to its present one
21 hundred (100) acre campus over-looking Pago Bay in Mangilao in 1961; and

22 **WHEREAS**, the Territorial College of Guam was renamed the
23 “University of Guam” by the ninth (9th) Guam Legislature after being
24 accredited for the maximum period by the Western Association of Schools
25 and Colleges (“WASC”) in 1968; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the University of Guam’s first Charter Day was proclaimed
2 on December 17, 1968, by the Honorable Governor Manuel F.L. Guerrero
3 through Executive Order 74-09; and

4 **WHEREAS**, while the University pursues its mission of providing
5 resident instruction and research to the people of Guam, it also provides our
6 neighbors throughout Micronesia the opportunity to achieve higher
7 education; and

8 **WHEREAS**, the University of Guam, in its quest to maintain its
9 tradition of excellence, continues to contribute to the Island’s social, cultural,
10 political and economic advancement; and


11 **WHEREAS**, the theme for this year "*Inina yan Sinaonao: Lini’e Todu I*
12 *Tano’*", ("To Enlighten and Involve: Global Perspectives") reflects the vision
13 and revised mission of the University’s governing Board of Regents and the
14 President to provide higher education and opportunities for the people of
15 Guam, the islands of the Western Pacific, and the Asian Pacific Rim nations;

17 **WHEREAS**, the 2006 Charter Day activities will showcase Guam’s
18 cultural, social, educational and recreational activities by inviting the People
19 of Guam, to visit the Mangilao campus during the week and share in these
20 experiences; now, therefore, be it

24 Defensor, President, UOG Student Government Association; to Dr. Harold L.


