1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF I**
2 ***MINA'BENTE OCHO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***
3 **WHEREAS,** National Police Week will be celebrated nationwide from
4 May 15 through 20, 2006 as a tribute to dedicated police officers that protect
5 our communities; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the brave men and women of the Guam Police Department,
2 Port Authority of Guam Police and the A. B. Won Pat Guam International
3 Airport Authority Police enforce the laws of Guam every hour of every day,
4 placing their lives at risk to ensure our island community is protected and
5 safe; and

6 **WHEREAS**, during the month of November 2005, the Guam Police
7 Department and the Department of Corrections joined forces for an island-
8 wide manhunt to apprehend a man suspected of kidnapping and sexually
9 assaulting a young female; and

10 **WHEREAS**, many civilian, unsworn personnel at the Guam Police
11 Department, the Port Authority Police, and the Guam International Airport
12 Authority Airport Police perform vital functions in support and furtherance of
13 uniformed officers, which contributes greatly to the apprehension of offenders
14 and delivery of justice; and

15 **WHEREAS**, many police officers and peace officers, have perished in
16 the line of duty while protecting our freedom and giving their lives to save the
17 life of another—universally acknowledged as the ultimate sacrifice—and our
18 island will remember those devoted and courageous souls at the *Hagåtña*
19 Police Memorial Monument on ‘Peace Officers Memorial Day’ on Monday,
20 May 15, 2006; and

1 **WHEREAS**, men and women of law enforcement often forgo their
2 scheduled days off and time with their families, as have many retired police
3 officers who previously served our community and are worthy of public
4 recognition for their unsurpassed service to our people and our island; now,
5 therefore, be it


6 **RESOLVED**, that the Executive Committee of *I Mina' Bente Ocho Na*

21 enforcement of law; and be it further


22 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairman of the Executive
