BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF I

- WHEREAS, the 1224th Engineer Detachment ("the 1224th") is a Unit of
- 4 fifty-four (54) of Guam's finest soldiers in the Guam Army National Guard
- 5 who have dedicated their lives to serving our country, protecting our people
- 6 and standing up for freedom and justice throughout the world; and

WHEREAS, the 1224th has spent the last year deployed in Afghanistan 1 2 in support of the soldiers, sailors, airmen and marines in the Regional 3 Command East; and WHEREAS, the 1224th supported more than ten (10) base camps in the 4 5 Regional Command East in Afghanistan by constructing improvements such as housing, force protection improvements, roads, landing zones, airfields, 6 7 plumbing and electrical work; and 8 WHEREAS, the Unit was the tip of the spear to support democracy in Afghanistan during the Afghanistan Parliamentary Elections, building from 9 the ground up two (2) fully functional camps equipped with billeting, 10 showers, burn-out latrines, force protection perimeter, guard towers and 11 12 bunkers in less than two (2) months; and WHEREAS, forty-three (43) soldiers in the Unit were awarded the 13 14 "Combat Action" badge for being engaged by direct and indirect enemy fire at various locations and times throughout the deployment; and 15 WHEREAS, the Unit played a major role in the upgrade of the FOB 16 Salerno Airfield, emplacing six hundred fifty (650) feet of AM2 matting on the 17 18 runway touchdown points in just under five (5) days, allowing the runway to remain open after major rain storms; and 19 WHEREAS, the 1224th managed a Five Hundred Thousand Dollar 20 21 (\$500,000) heavy equipment contract that required over twenty (20) pieces of

rolling stock and over twenty-five (25) local employees; and

WHEREAS, the 1224th managed a Three Hundred Thousand Dollar 1 2 (\$300,000) concrete batching plant capable of producing over three hundred 3 (300) cubic meters of concrete per day; and WHEREAS, the Unit built five (5) major culverts on FOB Salerno that 4 5 greatly improved the drainage problem that existed on the FOB; and 6 WHEREAS, the Unit led the effort to construct the FOB Salerno Basic 7 Load Ammunition Holding Area (BLAHA) that required in the movement of 8 over seventy thousand (70,000) cubic yards of dirt and the creation of fifteen (15) cells of store ammunition, thus creating in a storage area that meets safety 9 10 standards; and WHEREAS, the 1224th has displayed a dedication to duty and a bravery 11 in combat that are worthy of recognition and honor from our country and our 12 13 island; now, therefore, be it 14 **RESOLVED**, that the Executive Committee of I Mina'Bente Ocho Na 15 Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby, on behalf of I Liheslaturan Guåhan and the people of Guam, commend and honor the soldiers of the 1224th Engineer 16 17 Detachment for their Valor, Dedication and Service to our Island and our 18 Country; and be it further 19 **RESOLVED**, that the Executive Committee of I Mina'Bente Ocho Na 20 Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby, on behalf of I Liheslaturan Guåhan and the people of Guam, welcome home our soldiers after an outstanding tour of 21 22 duty; and be it further 23 RESOLVED, that the Speaker and the Chairman of the Executive

Committee certify, and the Secretary of the Legislature attest to, the adoption
