1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF I**
2 ***MINA'BENTE OCHO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS,** Ms. Janice “Jan” H. Milligan was born in Indiana,
4 Pennsylvania, and is the proud mother of two (2) children, son, Jeff, married
5 to Stacey, and daughter, Jennifer, married to David Hogg; she is also the
6 proud grandmother of Vera Ann; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Milligan received her Bachelor of Science degree in
2 Business Education, with a minor in English Literature/Composition, from
3 Pennsylvania State University, University Park, Pennsylvania in 1957, and a
4 Master's degree in Counseling Leadership, with Honors, from Saint Mary's
5 College of California, Moraga, California in 1992; and

6 **WHEREAS**, her academic background includes post-graduate courses
7 for Teacher Certification from the State of California, issued through the
8 University of California Extension, University of California, Santa Barbara
9 University of California at Los Angeles and California State University,
10 Northridge; and

11 **WHEREAS**, in 1973, Ms. Milligan began her public service career on
12 Guam as a Teacher V with the Department of Education at the John F.
13 Kennedy High School in Tamuning, and within a month's time was promoted
14 to Teacher VI with the Department of Education at the Guam Vocational
15 Technical High School. In 1976, Ms. Milligan took on the role of Teacher VI,
16 Co-Operative Education Coordinator at Simon Sanchez Jr. High, and Guam
17 Vocational Technical High through 1978; and

18 **WHEREAS**, in 1977, Ms. Janice Milligan joined the Guam Community
19 College as one of four (4) Chartered Faculty Members, and in the summer of
20 1978 transferred to GCC as a Teacher VI; in 1979 she was promoted to the
21 rank of Associate Professor and was assigned to the Vocational High School
22 program, and beginning in 1984 Associate Professor Milligan worked with the
23 Placement Center at GCC and the Co-Operative Extension through 1985. After
24 a brief relocation to the continental United States, from 1985 to 1993, Ms. Jan

1 Milligan returned to GCC as the Post Secondary Services Coordinator; in 1994,
2 she began working with the college's Project Aim TriO which provides
3 counseling services to students from disadvantaged backgrounds, a position
4 she holds today; and

5 **WHEREAS**, in her current position from which she will retire from on
6 September 30, 2006, Associate Professor Milligan's evaluations have been
7 continuously rated as Outstanding, or Exceeding in Expectations; and

8 **WHEREAS**, with Project AIM, Ms. Jan Milligan provides yearly services
9 to approximately one hundred seventy five (175) participants from Guam,
10 remote Pacific Islands, the Philippines, and Asia; and

11 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Milligan has held positions that include: General
12 Equivalency Diploma (GED) Chief Examiner; Disability Services Coordinator,
13 College ADA Compliance Officer; and has taught classes for the Business
14 Technology Department among her other duties; and

15 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Milligan remained current in the latest developments
16 in vocational and continuing education by partaking in professional
17 development opportunities and attending conferences and workshops, on and
18 off-island; and

19 **WHEREAS**, honors and awards earned by Ms. Janice Milligan include,
20 an honorary induction into the Phi Theta Kappa Honor Society, where she
21 was named the "2006 Advisor of the Year"; Phi Theta Kappa "Outstanding
22 Faculty Member of the Year, 2001"; and was listed in the 1999, "Who's Who
23 Among America's Teachers", and was nominated for "Who's Who Among
24 America's Teachers" in the 1998, 1999, 2003 academic years; and

1 **WHEREAS**, her professional and civic affiliations include membership
2 in the American Vocational Association, Cooperative Education Association,
3 Guam Advisory Council on Vocational Education, the Guam Business
4 Education Association, Phi Delta Kappa, National Educational Fraternity, the
5 American Cancer Society, and the American Heart Association; and


6 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Milligan is held in high regard by current and former

12 it


13 **RESOLVED**, that the Executive Committee of *I Mina'Bente Ocho Na*
