**Relative to commending and congratulating Police Officer II
Chris Anthony M. Dangan for being named the Guam
Police Department's "2006 Police Officer of the Year".**

1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF I**

3 **WHEREAS, Mr. Chris Anthony M. Dangan attended high school and**
4 **graduated from Guam Community College in 1996; and**

1 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Chris Anthony M. Dangan graduated from the 37th
2 Police Cycle in November 1997 and was assigned as a Patrol Officer in the
3 Patrol Division of the Guam Police Department; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Chris Anthony M. Dangan, offered his services to
5 fellow law enforcement officers and the community in the *Hagåtña*, Dededo,
6 and Tamuning-Tumon Precincts, where he is currently assigned; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Police Officer II Chris Anthony M. Dangan has taken on
8 numerous high profile cases through which he recovered Sixty-Five Thousand
9 Dollars (\$65,000) worth of stolen property and cash; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Police Officer II Chris Anthony M. Dangan was later
11 assigned to the Tamuning-Tumon Precinct Command where he proved his
12 compassion and dedication, evidenced by his selection as the “Police Officer
13 of the Quarter” from January to March 2005; and

14 **WHEREAS**, during May 2005, Officer Chris Anthony M. Dangan and
15 Officer Yi responded to a call for distressed swimmers off Ypao Beach during
16 which the officers managed to swim out and successfully escorted the family
17 to safety; and


18 **WHEREAS**, on June 15, 2005, Officer Chris Anthony M. Dangan was
19 awarded the “Above the Call of Duty for Life Saving” by the Guam Hotel &
20 Restaurant Association (GHRA) for saving the lives of the distressed
21 swimmers; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Police Officer II Chris Anthony M. Dangan continues to
2 distinguish himself by demonstrating his ability, efficiency, hard work and
3 loyalty to the Guam Police Department and the island; now, therefore, be it


4 **RESOLVED**, that the Executive Committee of *I Mina'Bente Ocho Na*
5 *Lihselaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Lihselaturan Guåhan* and the
6 people of Guam, commend and congratulate Police Officer II Chris Anthony
7 M. Dangan "2006 Police Officer of the Year", bestowed upon him on May
8 18th, 2006; and be it further
