3        **WHEREAS, Mr. John F. Taitano attended high school and graduated**  
4        **from Orange Glen High School, Escondido, California in 1979; and**

5        **WHEREAS, Mr. John F. Taitano has been employed with the Guam**  
6        **Police Department since June 1989, starting his career with the Records and**  
7        **Identification Section; and**

1           **WHEREAS**, Mr. John F. Taitano was later transferred to the Evidential  
2 Control Section and was assigned as a Property Custodian while still an  
3 auxiliary worker in 1995; and

4           **WHEREAS**, in 2004, Mr. John F. Taitano was promoted to his present  
5 position as Property Control Officer where he is currently the only civilian  
6 employee within the Evidential Control Section; and

7           **WHEREAS**, Mr. John F. Taitano's duties as a Property Control Officer  
8 include maintaining the integrity of evidence, transmitting evidence,  
9 testifying in court, updating the evidence system, bar coding of evidence, and  
10 other responsibilities; and

11           **WHEREAS**, Mr. John F. Taitano has received several awards, including  
12 Distinguished Service Medals, a Unit Citation for Excellence, letters of  
13 commendation, letters of appreciation and letters of recognition; and

14           **WHEREAS**, Mr. John F. Taitano continues to improve his expertise  
15 through additional training such as Property and Evidence Room  
16 Management held in Burbank, California; and

17           **WHEREAS**, Mr. John F. Taitano is currently attending the second phase  
18 of the International Association of Property and Evidence course and, upon  
19 completion, he will be nationally certified as a Property Handling Specialist;  
20 now, therefore, be it
