1        **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF I**  
2 ***MINA'BENTE OCHO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3        **WHEREAS,** the Emergency Medical Services team is a vital public  
4 service that provides lifesaving care twenty-four (24) hours every day; and

1           **WHEREAS**, the people of Guam understand that access to quality  
2 emergency care dramatically improves the likelihood of survival and recovery  
3 from sudden illness or injury; and

4           **WHEREAS**, the Emergency Medical Services team consists of  
5 emergency physicians, emergency nurses, emergency medical technicians,  
6 firefighters, educators, administrators, professionals and private individuals  
7 who value life and understand medical services are a priority; and

8           **WHEREAS**, members of the Emergency Medical Services team invest  
9 thousands of hours in specialized training and continuing education to  
10 enhance their lifesaving skills; and

11           **WHEREAS**, the public is encouraged to take part in Emergency Medical  
12 Services Week and learn about injury prevention, safety awareness,  
13 emergency preparedness, and to recognize an emergency when it occurs; and

14           **WHEREAS**, May 17, 2006 is 'Emergency Medical Services for Children  
15 Day' with the theme 'EMS: Serving on Health Care's Front Line' focusing on  
16 specialized emergency care for children so that every child in the nation  
17 receives the highest quality of emergency care ranging from primary  
18 prevention to acute care and rehabilitation; and

19           **WHEREAS**, Emergency Medical Services for Children promotes a high-  
20 level of emergency care by EMS providers with pediatric emergency skills;  
21 and

22           **WHEREAS**, Emergency Medical Services for Children advocates  
23 training in advanced technical equipment and services in preparation to save  
24 the life of a child; and

1           **WHEREAS**, Emergency Medical Services for Children fosters the  
2 development of training programs and guidelines for emergency care  
3 providers so that children with special health needs receive appropriate and  
4 timely care; and


5           **WHEREAS**, the Emergency Medical Services for Children team works  
6 with physicians, nurses, social workers, psychologists, emergency medical  
7 technicians, firefighters, educators, administrators, and private individuals to  
8 identify and address the issues surrounding the conditions of pediatric care;  
9 now, therefore, be it

10           **RESOLVED**, that the Executive Committee of *I Mina'Bente Ocho Na*  
11 *Lihselaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Lihselaturan Guåhan* and the  
12 people of Guam, recognize the week of May 14 through 20, 2006 as  
13 "Emergency Medical Services Week"; and be it further

14           **RESOLVED** that the Executive Committee of *I Mina'Bente Ocho Na*  
15 *Lihselaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Lihselaturan Guåhan* and the  
16 people of Guam, also recognizes May 17, 2006 as "Emergency Medical  
17 Services for Children Day" with the theme "EMS: Serving on Health Care's  
18 Front Line" and commends Emergency Medical Services providers for their  
19 continued support; and be it further
