1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF I**
2 ***MINA'BENTE OCHO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS,** the Honorable Paul McDonald Calvo and Mrs. Rosa Baza
4 Calvo were married on July 28, 1956 by Father Kieran Hickey, OFM Cap. at St.
5 Jude Thaddeus Catholic Church in Sinajana; and

6 **WHEREAS,** the Honorable Paul McDonald Calvo and Mrs. Rosa Baza
7 Calvo have been blessed with eight (8) children, twenty-three (23)

1 grandchildren, and one (1) great grandchild: Vera Calvo and Fabian Garces
2 (Pablo, Fabian, and Julia); Kathy Calvo and Peter Sgro (Christopher, Matthew,
3 Katarina, and Maria); Paul Calvo, Jr. (Paul and Joy Calvo and son Pauly);
4 Eddie Calvo and Christine Sonido (Eddie, Vinson, Rosae, Paul Jerome, Melva,
5 and Celine); Barbara Calvo and Mark Damron (Matthew, Shannon, and Rose
6 Elyse); Marie Calvo and Mike Benito (Aubrey, Alyssa, Brianna, and Michael
7 Jake); Reyna Calvo; and Clare Calvo; and

8 **WHEREAS**, the Honorable Paul McDonald Calvo served as Governor of
9 Guam from 1979 to 1983; was elected by the people of Guam for three (3)
10 terms as a Senator of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* in 1964, 1970, and 1972, serving as
11 Minority Leader in the Eleventh (11th) and Twelfth (12th) Guam Legislatures;
12 Chairman of the Committee on Finance and Taxation and Vice-Chairman of
13 the Committee on Crime and Corruption; and as a member of the Committee
14 on Rules, Committee on Economic Development, and the Committee on
15 Water and Utilities; and

16 **WHEREAS**, as a married couple and active members of our community,
17 the Honorable Paul McDonald Calvo and Mrs. Rosa Baza Calvo have and
18 continue to contribute to the prosperous growth of our Island; the Honorable
19 Paul McDonald Calvo and Mrs. Rosa Baza Calvo are successful local
20 entrepreneurs who have and continue to operate a variety of businesses that
21 employ hundreds of local residents while providing essential consumers,
22 healthcare, and financial services to the people of Guam, including Payless
23 Supermarkets, Calvo's Insurance Underwriters, Pacific Construction
24 Company, Mid-Pacific Distributing Company, Pepsi Cola Bottling Company
25 of Guam, and Calvo Financing Company; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the Honorable Paul McDonald Calvo served three (3)
2 terms as Chairman of the Association of Chief Executives of the Pacific Basin,
3 whose members include the respective Governors of Guam, Commonwealth
4 of the Northern Marianas Islands, Ponape, Kosrae, Yap, Chuuk, as well as the
5 Presidents from the Republics of Belau and of the Marshall Islands; the
6 Honorable Paul McDonald Calvo also served as a member and Vice-
7 Chairman of the Pacific Basin Development Council, whose membership
8 includes respective Governors from the State of Hawaii, American Samoa,
9 Commonwealth of the Northern Marianas Islands, and Guam; and

10 **WHEREAS**, the Honorable Paul McDonald Calvo is also a member of
11 various civic and business associations, including the Elks Lodge, Rotary Club
12 of Guam, Guam Jaycees, Young Men’s League of Guam, Knights of
13 Columbus, Holy Name Society, Guam Chamber of Commerce, and Civilian
14 Advisory Council for Andersen Air Force Base; and

15 **WHEREAS**, the Honorable Paul McDonald Calvo’s loving wife and
16 lifelong partner, Mrs. Rosa Baza Calvo, has and continues to provide
17 immeasurable support to her husband throughout their personal and
18 professional lives; Mrs. Rosa Baza Calvo understood that her husband’s active
19 involvement in our island’s political and social sectors were rooted in their
20 family’s belief that Guam’s future rested on a foundation of responsibility,
21 character and family commitment; and

22 **WHEREAS**, as an active member of the Guam Memorial Hospital
23 Volunteers Association and other charitable and philanthropic organizations,
24 Mrs. Rosa Baza Calvo, through the gift of time, talent, and personal interest,
25 has assisted the professional staff in caring for the comfort and welfare of

1 patients at the Guam Memorial Hospital by raising thousands of dollars for
2 equipment, furnishings, and related healthcare services; and

3 **WHEREAS**, throughout their fifty (50) years of marriage and in both
4 their personal and professional lives, the Honorable Paul McDonald Calvo
5 and Mrs. Rosa Baza Calvo have assiduously stressed integrity and respect for
6 others and have served as a source of inspiration to their colleagues, friends,
7 and family, to whom they have always encouraged spiritual, personal, and
8 professional growth; and

9 **WHEREAS**, as people who have and continue to devote their lives to
10 nurturing a caring and loving family, the Honorable Paul McDonald Calvo
11 and Mrs. Rosa Baza Calvo have also spent much of their time helping the
12 people of Guam through their contributions to numerous civic, community,
13 and religious activities; now, therefore, be it

14 **RESOLVED**, that the Executive Committee of *I Mina'Bente Ocho Na*
15 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the
16 people of Guam, honor the Honorable Paul McDonald Calvo and Mrs. Rosa
17 Baza Calvo on their Fiftieth (50th) Anniversary Celebration of Matrimony and
18 further extend to them a sincere appreciation for their outstanding
19 contributions to the betterment of our Island Community; and be it further
