5 and User Services Association (RUSA); and

6           **WHEREAS**, Ms. Arlene Cohen co-founded “FreeShare”, a cross regional  
7 DOCLINE library group whose members agree to interlibrary loan requests  
8 free of charge; and

9           **WHEREAS**, Ms. Arlene Cohen mentors FreeForAll, a coalition of  
10 libraries providing free interlibrary loans to libraries in the developing world;

12           **WHEREAS**, the award recognizes Ms. Arlene Cohen’s efforts regarding  
13 the ILL and document delivery; and

14           **WHEREAS**, colleagues in the ALA note that Ms. Arlene Cohen  
15 exemplifies excellence in interlibrary loan services and that her outstanding  
16 accomplishments include initiating cooperative interlibrary services  
17 throughout the Pacific Islands, a distinguished record of publications and  
18 presentations on resource sharing and creating access to information  
19 resources and tireless advocacy for library services to underdeveloped  
20 regions; now, therefore, be it


21           **RESOLVED**, that the Executive Committee of *I Mina’Bente Ocho Na*
