WHEREAS, the Port is the lifeline to our island and critical to our country's national security. It is essential for the continued development of our economy and the survival of the people of Guam due to our dependence on imported goods including food, fuel, medical supplies, equipment and raw materials; and

WHEREAS, in 2005, the Port moved about two million (2,000,000) revenue tons of cargo and about eighty four thousand three hundred twenty one (84,321) containers; and

WHEREAS, the Port's three hundred fourteen (314) dedicated and hardworking employees work as stevedores, cargo checkers, equipment operators, accountants, tariff specialists and managers on the five (5) cargo handling piers, a container yard, two (2) fuel piers, three (3) marinas and a harbor of refuge; and

WHEREAS, our Port services ships from around the world, over five hundred (500) cargo vessels and more than one thousand (1,000) foreign-flagged fishing vessels annually; and

WHEREAS, the Port has successfully completed the quadrennial Occupational Safety and Health Administration inspection of its cargo handling equipment; and

WHEREAS, over the past Fiscal Year, the Port has made significant progress with the purchase of eight (8) new yard tractors, the expected purchase of a used mobile harbor crane, the issuance of an invitation to bid for
