3 **WHEREAS,** Mr. Antonio P. Guerrero is the husband of Cecilia T.
4 Guerrero and is the proud parent of five (5) children: Antonio, Dwayne,
5 Christopher, Vincent and Vanessa, and grandparent of five (5); and

1 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Guerrero is an alumnus of the George Washington
2 Senior High School Class of 1969 and an honorable retiree of the United States
3 Air Force with twenty (20) years service; and

4 **WHEREAS**, in 1969, Mr. Guerrero began his public service career with
5 the Government of Guam at Guam Memorial Hospital and resigned to enlist
6 with the United States Armed Forces in 1970; and

7 **WHEREAS**, he resumed employment as a public servant with the Guam
8 International Airport Authority in 1991 and transferred to the Port Authority
9 as a Security Guard (Armed) in May 28, 1991; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Guerrero was promoted to Port Police II in May 28,
11 1992 and Port Police Supervisor on September 24, 2001; and

12 **WHEREAS**, while he was a supervisor, he was designated, on many
13 occasions, to administer the Port Police Division's daily programs and
14 activities in the absence of the Port Police Chief; and

15 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Guerrero received awards for his dedication to the Port
16 Authority of Guam, including the Supervisor of the Quarter Award for 2004,
17 Supervisor of the Year in 2004 and was a nominee for the 2005 Governor's
18 MagHOPE Award of Excellence Program; and


19 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Guerrero's outstanding performance and commitment

23 efficient and dependable; now, therefore, be it


1 **RESOLVED**, that the Executive Committee of *I Mina'Bente Ocho Na*
