Relative to memorializing the contributions and accomplishments of the late Mr. Juan Castro Guerrero for his many years of service to the people of Guam, and to expressing the heartfelt condolences of the people of Guam and *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to his family.

1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF I**  
2 ***MINA'BENTE OCHO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Juan Castro Guerrero was born on February 11, 1935 to  
4 Nicolasa Castro and Jose Pangelinan Guerrero; and

5           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Guerrero graduated from George Washington High  
6 School in 1955; and

1           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Guerrero married Teresita Cruz and together they are  
2 the proud parents of their daughter Evelyn, son John, Jr. and youngest  
3 daughter Eloise Guerrero, and are blessed with eleven (11) grandchildren and  
4 one (1) great-grandchild; and

5           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Guerrero served his country in the United States Army  
6 from October 17, 1955 through October 13, 1958, in Company D of the 370<sup>th</sup>  
7 Armed Infantry Battalion in the 11<sup>th</sup> Airborne Division, serving in Munich,  
8 Germany, under the European Command of the Overseas Service and rising  
9 to the rank of Specialist (E-4); and

10           **WHEREAS**, on November 9, 1959, upon Mr. Guerrero's honorable  
11 discharge from the United States Army, he entered the Police Academy of the  
12 Department of Public Service, Government of Guam; and

13           **WHEREAS**, Mr. Guerrero became a Department of Public Safety  
14 Patrolman on May 10, 1960; and

15           **WHEREAS**, in 1961, Mr. Guerrero received a "Good Conduct Medal"  
16 during his service in the Army Reserves; and

17           **WHEREAS**, on September 9, 1968, Patrolman Juan C. Guerrero was  
18 promoted to the rank of Sergeant I in the Department of Public Safety; and

19           **WHEREAS**, on July 8, 1969, Sergeant Guerrero began service as a  
20 Detective Sergeant in the Detective Bureau of the Department of Public Safety;  
21 and

22           **WHEREAS**, on February 2, 1975, Sergeant Guerrero was promoted to  
23 Sergeant II in the Department of Public Safety, Detective Bureau; and

24           **WHEREAS**, on December 17, 1976, Sergeant Guerrero received a

1 Certificate of Completion from the University of Guam for Police Supervisory  
2 Training; and

3         **WHEREAS**, on April 21, 1977, Sergeant Guerrero completed the Hawaii  
4 City Police Department’s Law Enforcement Officer’s Training for Gambling  
5 Technology in Hilo, Hawaii; and

6         **WHEREAS**, Sergeant Guerrero was duly recognized by the Department  
7 of Public Safety for his dedication and commitment to duty through the  
8 presentation of certificates in 1978 and 1982; and

9         **WHEREAS**, Juan C. Guerrero retired, after twenty-six (26) years of  
10 service, from the Department of Public Safety and the Guam Police  
11 Department as a Lieutenant in 1986; and

12         **WHEREAS**, after his retirement from public service, Juan C. Guerrero  
13 continued to serve his community as an entrepreneur in the agricultural sector  
14 of our island’s economy; and

15         **WHEREAS**, in tribute and appreciation of Juan Castro Guerrero,  
16 affectionately known as “Sarge” by his innumerable subordinates over the  
17 course of his distinguished career, his legacy of leadership; service to his  
18 country and our Island; and innumerable contributions to the betterment of  
19 lives to people on Guam, it is only proper and fitting that the people of Guam  
20 also recognize the family of the late Mr. Juan Castro Guerrero for their  
21 unselfish support and sacrifice during Mr. Guerrero’s years of service to our  
22 community; now, therefore, be it


23         **RESOLVED**, that the Executive Committee of *I Mina’Bente Ocho Na*
