18 Lions Club at this inaugural moment; and


19 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Ciony Viray will be installed and assume her duties as

24 people of Guam, congratulate Ms. Ciony Viray on the occasion of her


1 installation as a "Guiding Lion" of the newly Chartered Guam Spirit Lions
