5 WHEREAS, in June 1992, he was transferred to HHC, 1-294th Infantry

6 Battalion; in October 1993, he was transferred to the Service Detachment, 1-

7 294th Infantry Battalion as a vehicle driver (88M); and he is currently assigned

8 to Foxtrot Company, 297th BSB, 207th IBCT as a vehicle mechanic; and

9 WHEREAS, SPC Abian was deployed to Iraq from October 7, 2004

10 through December 21, 2005 in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom; during

11 this deployment, he was attached to 778th Transportation Company (CBT

- 3 WHEREAS, on April 21, 2005, SPC Abian was traveling south from
- 4 Baghdad towards Camp Scania when an ambush of multiple Improvised
- 5 Explosive Devices, mortars, and small arms fire hit near and around his
- 6 vehicle; and
- WHEREAS, with small arms fire coming from both sides of the road,
- 8 SPC Robert B. Abian and SPC Christopher Leon Guerrero returned
- 9 suppressive fire through their vehicle windows in the direction of enemy fire,
- 10 and both suffered injuries; and
- 11 WHEREAS, as a result of their bravery, SPC Abian and SPC Leon
- 12 Guerrero received the Purple Heart Award, which is given to members of the
- 13 U.S. Armed Forces who are wounded by an instrument of war in the hands of
- 14 the enemy and posthumously to the next of kin in the name of those who are
- 15 killed in action or die of wounds received in action; now, therefore, be it
- 16 **RESOLVED**, that the Executive Committee of I Mina' Bente Ocho Na
- 17 Liheslaturan Guåhan does hereby, on behalf of I Liheslaturan Guåhan and the
- 18 people of Guam, commend SPC Roberto B. Abian for his bravery while
- 19 serving our country in Iraq, for earning the Purple Heart Award, and for
- 20 making the people of Guam proud; and be it further
