3 **WHEREAS**, Sanctuary, Inc. was established in 1971 by Father Robert
4 Phelps and Mr. Luis Martinez, who recognized the importance of providing
5 youth-oriented programs and services on island; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the primary mission of Sanctuary is “Helping Youth and
7 Families Help Themselves”; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Sanctuary, working together with the Department of
2 Youth Affairs, assists troubled youth and their families who have experienced
3 abuse—be it physical, emotional or sexual, and of substance abuse, gang
4 involvement and negative peer pressure; and

5 **WHEREAS**, in 1987, the Board of Directors of Sanctuary, Inc. worked
6 enthusiastically to provide support programs that now include a twenty-four
7 (24) hour Crisis Hotline, Co-ed Emergency Shelter Facilities, a Transitional
8 Living Program, a Parent Support Group, Parenting Skills Classes, a
9 Community Outreach Prevention Education & Development (COPEd), Drug
10 & Alcohol Support Groups, Tobacco Cessation and Self-Esteem Groups for
11 Youth, Youth & Adult Anger Management Groups, the *Fan Macho'cho*
12 Economic Development Project, the AmeriCorps Program and *Sagan*
13 *Na'Homlo'*, the only residential drug and alcohol treatment program for youth
14 in the Western Pacific; and

15 **WHEREAS**, Sanctuary has instilled values, built character and provided
16 education for the youth and their families; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Sanctuary encourages island residents to join in various
18 seminars and conferences throughout the month of November to help educate
19 others about Sanctuary's services; and

20 **WHEREAS**, November 2006 will mark the Thirty-Fifth (35th)
21 Anniversary of Sanctuary, Incorporated; now, therefore, be it


22 **RESOLVED**, that the Executive Committee of *I Mina'Bente Ocho Na*
