1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF I**

3 **WHEREAS,** Master Henry Ray Torres Conway III is the 14 year old son
4 of retired Sergeant Major Henry Rivera Conway and Eileen Torres Conway,
5 formerly of Yona and Yigo, now residing in Live Oak, Texas; and

1 **WHEREAS**, young Henry Ray Torres Conway III is a freshman at
2 Judson High School and a member of the Judson Varsity Competitive
3 Marching Band; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Henry Ray Torres Conway III is a member of the Boy
5 Scouts of America Troop 512, Schertz, Texas, of the Alamo Area Council of
6 San Antonio; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Henry Ray Torres Conway III was examined by an Eagle
8 Scout Board of Review on October 26, 2006 and found to have completed all
9 leadership, service and outdoor skill requirements of the Boy Scouts of
10 America to be considered worthy of advancement to the highest formal rank
11 of achievement, namely, "Eagle Scout"; and

12 **WHEREAS**, the rank of Eagle Scout is earned by about five percent 5%
13 of all Boy Scouts, conferred only upon those who demonstrate the highest
14 levels of citizenship training, character development, and personal fitness, as
15 determined by review processes in his Scouting District, Local and National
16 Council Levels; and

17 **WHEREAS**, attainment of Eagle Scout rank signifies great promise for
18 exemplary leadership in and service to every community where its bearer will
19 reside and work throughout his life; and

20 **WHEREAS**, Master Henry Ray Torres Conway III will be formally
21 elevated to the rank of Eagle Scout at an Eagle Court of Honor Ceremony, to
22 be conducted in his honor on December 23, 2006 at VFW Post 8315 in Schertz,
23 Texas; and


1 **WHEREAS**, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* wishes to publicly acknowledge
2 exemplary achievement by our youth, who, through individual determination
3 and support of family and caring adults, have demonstrated a lasting
4 commitment to constructive influence on the lives of people around them;

9 occasion of his elevation to the rank of Eagle Scout; and be it further


10 **RESOLVED**, that the *I* Executive Committee of *I Mina'Bente Ocho Na*
