1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF I**

1 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Lillian Q. Perez-Posadas was born on May 7, 1955 and
2 is married to Antonio Posadas, with whom she has two (2) children: Christian
3 and Aubrey; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Lillian Q. Perez-Posadas attended George Washington
5 Senior High in Mangilao, Guam from September 1971 to May 1973 and
6 subsequently received an Associate's Degree from the University of Guam's
7 School of Nursing and Allied Health in 1975; and

8 **WHEREAS**, from September 1985 to May 1989, Mrs. Lillian Q. Perez-
9 Posadas attended the University of Guam and received a Bachelor of Science
10 in Nursing from the School of Nursing and Allied Health; and

11 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Lillian Q. Perez-Posadas received a Master of Nursing
12 from Washington State University, Intercollegiate College for Nursing
13 Education, in July 1993; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Lillian Q. Perez-Posadas first obtained employment as
15 a Licensed Practical Nurse I at the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority
16 (GMHA) in 1976 and was promoted to Staff Nurse I in 1977; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Lillian Q. Perez-Posadas was employed in various
18 positions at GMHA including Staff Nurse II, Staff Nurse III, Associate
19 Administrator of Clinical Services, Hospital Nurse Supervisor II and most
20 recently served as Administrator of Hospital Nursing Services; and

21 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Lillian Q. Perez-Posadas has also worked as a Staff
22 Nurse at Mission Bay Memorial Hospital and American River Hospital in
23 California as well as a Staff Nurse at U. S. Naval Hospital (Guam) and as

1 Community Health Nurse I and II at the Department of Public Health and
2 Social Services (DPHSS) on Guam; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Lillian Q. Perez-Posadas has served as an
4 Assistant/Clinical Instructor, Instructor, Assistant Professor and
5 Unit/Department Chairperson at the University of Guam's College of
6 Nursing and Health Sciences and as a Legislative Consultant for the Office of
7 Senator Lou Leon Guerrero during *I Mina'Bente Tres Na Liheslaturan Guåhan*;
8 and

9 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Lillian Q. Perez-Posadas has held membership in
10 various professional organizations and committees, some of which are the
11 Guam Nurses Association (GNA), where she served as President, the GNA
12 Commission of Nurse Leaders, the American Nurses Association, the GMHA
13 Ethics Committee, where she serves as Chairperson, and the GMHA
14 Institutional Review Board; and


15 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Lillian Q. Perez-Posadas received the DPHSS
16 Meritorious Award in 1988 and the World Health Organization (WHO) and
17 DPHSS Fellowship Award in 1988. She was named as one of the Outstanding
18 Young Women of America in 1989 and for the President's List in 1989 and was
19 a nominee for the Who's Who in Nursing in 1991, received GNA Nurse
20 Educator Award in 1996 and GNA Nurse of the Year Award in 1997; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Lillian Q. Perez-Posadas has served the government of
2 Guam and the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority for a total of twenty-nine
3 (29) years and six (6) months, thus demonstrating her commitment to the
4 health and well-being of the people of Guam; now, therefore, be it


5 **RESOLVED**, that the Executive Committee of *I Mina'Bente Ocho Na*
