1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF I**  
2 ***MINA'BENTE OCHO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3           **WHEREAS,** the Guam Bayanihan Sports Association (GBSA) was  
4 incorporated in 1974 as a non-profit organization. The organization promoted  
5 basketball for the Filipino Community, and created the "Philippine  
6 Independence Basketball Tournament"; and

7           **WHEREAS,** to participate in this prestigious basketball league, the  
8 individual had to have at least thirty percent (30%) Filipino blood; and

9           **WHEREAS,** the organization, through the basketball league, served as  
10 a source of pride for many in the island's Filipino Community, and has done  
11 much to help newcomers to the island feel at home; and

12           **WHEREAS,** the Guam Bayanihan Sports Association has exhibited  
13 positive ideals to its members, players and the community, and has  
14 encouraged support, goodwill and good sportsmanship throughout the years;

16           **WHEREAS,** in the early 1980's, the Philippine Independence  
17 Basketball Tournament became recognized as the Philippine Amateur  
18 Basketball League (PABL); and

19           **WHEREAS,** for the last decade, the organization, which now consists  
20 of the following Board Members for 2005: Ebbs Baldoz, Cynthia Moises,  
21 Connie Toledo, Fe Singh, Lody Saitanan, Precy Dauglash, Nelia Pascual,  
22 Annie Tanedo and Shirley Trinidad, along with the Officers: Bobby Zamora,

5 Singh, Assistant Business Manager; and Peace Officers, Dan Romulo, Mar  
6 Moises, Lody Saitanan, and Precy Dauglash, decided that the league will give  
7 an opportunity and lend support to all the sportsmen on Guam and help  
8 foster a better relation between all races that live on Guam; and


9       **WHEREAS**, the PABL is now open to people of various ethnic  
10 backgrounds that want to play competitive basketball, and has become the  
11 island’s biggest varsity league. The PABL’s goals will continue to be to excel  
12 at basketball and to promote brotherhood and friendship among the  
13 participants and among the people of Guam; now, therefore, be it

14       **RESOLVED**, that the Executive Committee of *I Mina’Bente Ocho Na*  
15 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the  
16 people of Guam, honor, commend and congratulate the Guam Bayanihan  
17 Sports Association on its 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary and for its dedication, support and  
18 contribution to creating a sports environment for the Filipino Community and  
19 promoting brotherhood and friendship; and further extends *un dångkolo na si*  
20 *Yu’os ma’åse* and *maraming salamat po* for its continuing dedication to the  
21 Filipino Community of Guam and the people of Guam; and be it further
