17	effective, reducing illegal drugs use by nearly half; and
18	WHEREAS, treatment reduces criminal activity by eighty percent,
19	(80%), increases employment, decreases homelessness, and curbs risky sexual
20	behavior while substantially improving physical and mental health; and
