1           **WHEREAS**, Lt. Alan L. Stricoff was born on October 7, 1966 in New  
2 York, New York; and

3           **WHEREAS**, Lt. Stricoff graduated from Stuyvesant High School, New  
4 York, New York in 1984; and

5           **WHEREAS**, Lt. Stricoff received his undergraduate degree in Arts and  
6 Economics from State University of New York at Binghamton in 1988; and

7           **WHEREAS**, Lt. Stricoff obtained his Post-baccalaureate premedical  
8 program from State University of New York at Binghamton in 1995; and

9           **WHEREAS**, Lt. Stricoff received his Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine  
10 from New York College of Osteopathic Medicine, Old Westbury in 2000; and

11           **WHEREAS**, Lt. Stricoff completed his postgraduate training in Internal  
12 Medicine as an intern/resident from Albert Einstein College of Medicine,  
13 Jacobi Medical Center, Bronx, New York; and

14           **WHEREAS**, from 1988 to 1993, Lt. Stricoff was the Senior Analyst for  
15 the Insurance Services Office, Inc., in New York, New York; and

16           **WHEREAS**, from 1993 to 1995, Lt. Stricoff was the Residence Hall  
17 Director of the State University of New York at Binghamton; and

18           **WHEREAS**, from September 2003 to July 2005, Lt. Stricoff was the  
19 Internal Medicine Department Head at the United States Naval Hospital,  
20 Guam; and

21           **WHEREAS**, as Department Head of Internal Medicine of the United  
22 States Naval Hospital, Guam, Lt. Stricoff provided adult medical care for the  
23 aging and aged, most of whom were retirees; and

1           **WHEREAS**, Lt. Stricoff also provided inpatient services to many  
2 Veterans Administration beneficiaries especially those placed in the Intensive  
3 Care Unit; and

4           **WHEREAS**, Lt. Stricoff served as co-medical advisor for a team of  
5 Seabees stationed in Palau; and

6           **WHEREAS**, Lt. Stricoff helped provide medical assistance to indigent  
7 patients in Palau; and

8           **WHEREAS**, Lt. Stricoff served as chairman of the hospital's Guam SARS  
9 Committee from 2003 to 2004 helping Guam prepare for a potential SARS  
10 outbreak; and

11           **WHEREAS**, Lt. Stricoff served as Chairman of the Palliative Care  
12 Committee in providing compassionate end-of-life care to patients with  
13 terminal illnesses; and

14           **WHEREAS**, Lt. Stricoff achieved Board Certification from the American  
15 Board of Internal Medicine in 2004; and

17 Commander during Fiscal Year 2006; now, therefore, be it


18           **RESOLVED**, that the Executive Committee of *I Mina'Bente Ocho Na*
