- 2 WHEREAS, Roger married Elizabeth Quito and had one son, Brian; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Roger graduated from Owensboro (KY) School of Practical
- 4 Nursing in 1974; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Roger received his Associates Degree in Applied Science
- 6 from Madisonville (KY) Community College in 1977; and
- 7 **WHEREAS**, Roger served as Head Nurse at Owensboro Daviess County
- 8 Hospital in Kentucky from 1977-1978; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Roger, while serving as Charge Nurse at St. Louis
- 10 University Hospital from 1978-1980, earned his Bachelors Degree in Nursing
- 11 from St. Louis University in 1980; and
- 12 WHEREAS, from 1980-1982, Roger was the Primary Health Care
- 13 Instructor/Coordinator and Liaison Officer for the American Peace Corps
- 14 Volunteer in Yemen and, from 1982-1984, served as the Nursing Supervisor at
- 15 Al-Salam Hospital, also in Yemen; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Roger was the Director of Continuing Education at
- 17 Owensboro Daviess County Hospital and a Registered Nurse at Ohio County
- 18 Hospital, both in Kentucky, from 1985-1987; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Roger served the people of Guam as a Staff Nurse from
- 20 1984-1985 and Nurse Supervisor from 1987-2005 at the Guam Memorial
- 21 Hospital; Nursing Supervisor for the FHP Clinic in 1987; and an Emergency
- 22 Medical Services Instructor at the Guam Community College from 1992-2005,
- 23 while obtaining his Masters Degree in Public Administration at the University
- 24 of Guam in 1995; and
